#### First Pitch...

The Oklahoma baseball team returns home for its final three-game series of the regular season as Kansas State visits L. Dale Mitchell Field. The Sooners and Wildcats open the series on Friday at 6:30 p.m. CT. OU will celebrate seniors Kyle Mendenhall and Devon Perez on Sunday for Senior Day.

#### About the Sooners...

No. 18 Oklahoma is 28-18 overall and fourth place in the Big 12 with a 10-8 record. The Sooners are hitting .283 as a team, including a .288 mark in conference games to rank third in the league. Junior right fielder **Steele Walker** leads the way with a .364 average, hitting a league-best .418 in 17 conference games, and slugging .614 with 11 home runs and 44 RBI. Junior third baseman **Brylie Ware** is second on the team with a .333 batting average and is tied for second with 32 RBI. The OU pitching staff owns a 3.99 earned run average on the season, which ranks third in the conference. In league play, the Sooners boast a 4.65 ERA and are second in the conference with a .253 batting average against. Junior right-handed pitcher **Jake Irvin**, the Sooners' Friday night starter, is 5-1 with a 3.33 ERA and 78 strikeouts in 67.2 innings worked. Irvin became the 21st OU pitcher in school history to record at least 200 career strikeouts, picking up 10 punch outs in his last start at Oklahoma State. Sophomore right-hander **Nathan Wiles** is 4-3 with a 4.04 ERA, including a 3.25 mark in league games; ranking sixth in the Big 12. He has struck out 42 and walked only eight in 55.2 innings.

Voice of the Sooners **Toby Rowland** will call the series across the Sooner Sports Network and locally on Sportstalk 99.3 FM/1400 AM. The games can also be streamed online at Sportstalk1400.com or on the TuneIn mobile app. SoonerSports.tv will stream Friday night's game, while Saturday and Sunday's contest will air on Fox Sports Oklahoma + with Chad McKee (pvp) and George Frazier (analyst) on the call.

#### Leading Off

• OU has won its last four series against Kansas State, dating back to 2014. The Sooners are 73-17 all-time against K-State in Norman.

• The Sooners are 22-7 at home this season and 7-2 against Big 12 foes at L. Dale Mitchell Field.

• In two career starts against K-State, Jake Irvin is 2-0 with a 2.77 ERA in 13 innings pitched. Cade Harris is a .333 (6-for-18) hitter against the Wildcats with a home run and three RBI.

• Levi Prater is scheduled to start Saturday's game against Kansas State. He would be the first freshman left-hander to make a start for the Sooners on the mound since Jordan Johns vs. Kansas (May 8, 2011).

• Steele Walker hit his 11th home run of the season at Texas Tech (4/22) to homer in back-to-back games and push his career total to 22. Walker and Texas Tech's Grant Little are the only two Big 12 hitters in the top five in the league in hits, runs, home runs, RBI and slugging.

• OU matched its 2017 season total with its fourth shutout of the season vs. Texas (4/15). The Sooners have not recorded more than four shutouts in a season since seven in 2013.

### HEAD COACH SKIP JOHNSON

Skip Johnson was introduced as the 10th head coach of the OU baseball program on June 19, 2017.

Johnson served as the Sooners' pitching coach in 2017 after a 25-year coaching career in the state of Texas, including the most recent 10 years as an assistant and associate head coach at the University of Texas. In his lone season in Norman, he helped OU to its first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2013.

Johnson made an immediate impact on the Sooner pitching staff last season. Oklahoma pitchers surrendered the least amount of home runs in the Big 12 in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. The Sooners' 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions.

Johnson was hired as the pitching coach at Texas for the 2007 season under Augie Garrido. In 10 seasons, Johnson helped the Longhorns to seven NCAA Regional appearances, four Super Regionals and three CWS.

During his tenure in Austin, 32 pitchers were selected in the MLB Draft, including 14 in the first 10 rounds and three first-round picks. Johnson oversaw the development of six UT pitchers to make it to the majors. The Texas pitching staff produced a team ERA below 3.00 on five occasions and struck out better than 7.5 per-nine-innings in five of his last eight seasons.

Prior to his time in Austin, Johnson was the head coach at Navarro College of the NJCAA's Texas Eastern Athletic Conference. From 1994-2006, he guided the Bulldogs to 13 NJCAA Regionals, nine TEAC championships and four regional titles, while compiling 450 wins.

A standout baseball player at Denton High School, Johnson began his collegiate playing career at Ranger (Texas) College. After a two-year career there, Johnson moved on to play baseball at the University of North Texas in 1988 before the school dropped its baseball program. He completed his collegiate playing career at UT-Pan American, lettering for the Broncs in 1989 and receiving his bachelor's degree in 1990. Johnson earned a master's degree in education from UT-Tyler in 1993.

A native of Denton, Texas, Johnson and his wife, Cathy, have two sons, Tyler and Garrett.

### Scouting the Wildcats...

Kansas State was swept by Baylor at home last weekend and had its midweek contest with Wichita State canceled due to rain. The Wildcats enter the series at 18-26 overall and 3-12, in ninth place, in the Big 12. Outfielder **Will Brennan** leads the Wildcats and ranks fourth with a .358 batting average. Brennan is also tied for fifth with 17 stolen bases. Outfielder **Drew Mount** leads K-State with nine home runs and five triples, while hitting .268. Senior **Justin Heskett** has made 11 starts for the Wildcats this season, and has a 2-6 record with a 6.92 ERA.

### All-Time vs. Kansas State...

Oklahoma leads the series against Kansas State with a 158-60 all-time record, including a 73-17 advantage in Norman. The Sooners won the first six games of the series and own the series' longest win streak at 27 games. In the last five seasons, the two sides have met in the Big 12 Championship four times with OU winning three, including elimination games in 2015 and 2016.

### Last Time They Met...

**Devon Perez** tossed 6.2 shutout innings to pick up his fifth win of the year to help the Sooners to a 3-0 win in Manhattan on May 7, 2017. The victory allowed the Sooners to clinch the series as OU's pitching staff combined to shut out Kansas State. **Austin O'Brien** homered and finished 2-for-3 at the plate with a run scored and RBI, while **JB Olsen** picked up his eighth save of the year with a perfect ninth inning.

### By The Numbers: The Sooners vs. K-State...

**Cade Harris:** .333/.500/.600 in six games, five starts... 2-for-4 with two RBI and a home run (5/5/17). **Jake Irvin:** Two starts, 2-0, 2.77 ERA, 11 K, 13.0 IP in two starts ... Earned the win with one earned run in seven innings of work (5/7/16). **Ryan Madden:** Two relief appearances, allow no runs in 2.2 innings of work. **Steele Walker:** Hit two home runs and drove in four during last year's series win in Manhattan. **Brylie Ware:** .333/.500/.778 ... Hit a three-run homer in a 11-5 road win against Kansas State (5/5/17).

### Seniors Recognized This Weekend...

The Sooners will honor senior second baseman **Kyle Mendenhall** and senior right-hander **Devon Perez** on Sunday for Senior Day. Mendenhall ranks third on the team this season with a .316 average with three home runs and 32 RBI. During his four-year career, Mendenhall has made 158 starts and appeared in 186 career games. Perez has a 10-4 career record with a 3.95 ERA. As a junior, Perez posted a 6-2 record to earn a spot on the All-Big 12 honorable mention team.

### Power Surge...

Oklahoma went 30 games between multi-home run games having gone yard three times opening day vs. Indiana (2/16) and **Kyler Murray's** two long balls at TCU (4/6). The Sooners then homered in six consecutive games; marking the first stretch of five or more games since 2010 and the first in the BBOR (2011-present) era. **Steele Walker** hit two vs. TCU (4/8) and Little Rock (4/10) as the Sooners matched their season-high with three. Oklahoma added two more vs. Oral Roberts (4/11) and another Walker home run vs. Texas (4/13). The Sooners have hit 18 of their 30 home runs in the last 16 games. Walker has homered nine times over that stretch, while Murray has homered three times.

### Up Next...

The Sooners get a week off from Big 12 play and head to Orlando, Fla., to face UCF for a three-game non-conference set. The series opens next Friday at 5:30 p.m. CT.

## 11-Hit Weekend...

**Steele Walker** hit .688 (11-for-16) at Texas Tech (4/20-22). He notched at least three hits in every game; matching his career-high with four twice. Walker is a career .512 (22-for-43) hitter against the Red Raiders. In game two, he homered and doubled in a 4-for-5, two-RBI performance. In the finale, Walker went 4-for-6 against a variety of Tech defensive shifts; twice beating the defensive alignment for singles to center and right and finally with all four infielders on the right side he blasted a two-run home run in the eighth. Walker owned a .706 on-base percentage and slugged 1.188 for an astounding 1.894 OPS.

## Friday Ace...

**Jake Irvin** has started all 11 series openers for Oklahoma this season and 11 of 13 weekend game ones as a sophomore in 2017. He is 11-2 in those 22 starts with 13 starts of six innings or more. When Irvin won the series opener, the Sooners have won 10 of 11 series. When Irvin took a loss, no-decision or did not start game one, OU has won five of 12 series.

## Free Bases...

**Cade Harris** drew the 100th base on balls on his career vs. Texas (4/15) to become the 14th player in program history to reach that mark, the first since **Casey Bookout** (1996-99). He currently ranks tied for sixth all-time at OU with 108. Harris needs just 21 more walks to move into the top-5 all-time at Oklahoma. **Damon Minor** (1993-36) is the program's all-time leader with 139 walks.

## Double Take...

As a freshman, **Steele Walker** was one shy of the Sooner rookie record with 17 doubles. His 11 this season has pushed his career total to 44. Walker cracked the top-20 list in the OU record book vs. Oral Roberts (4/11). He is tied for 13th all-time at Oklahoma with **Aaron Baker** (2007-09) and **Ray Hayward** (1980-83).

## Spring Cleaning...

Oklahoma brought out the brooms on back-to-back weekends to start conference play with sweeps of West Virginia and Baylor. The Sooners swept back-to-back three-game conference series for the first time since beating Missouri and winning at Texas Tech in 2006. Overall, OU moved to 8-0 in the Big 12 for the first time in the 22-year history of the league and to start conference play since 1984 in the Big Eight following two wins at TCU. The Sooners last swept back-to-back three-game series to start conference play in 1974 with Big Eight wins over Kansas and at Nebraska.

## Turn Down the Horns...

Oklahoma salvaged its series with Texas (4/15) behind sophomore right-hander **Nathan Wiles'** 7.2-scoreless innings. The Sooners' 6-0 win marked their first shutout of the Longhorns since March 16, 1957. Wiles was named Big 12 Pitcher of the Week (4/16) after scattering five hits and issuing just one walk, which came in his final inning of work. He did not allow a runner to reach third and saw only four runners in scoring position; all with two outs.

## Reaching the Charts...

Oklahoma, which was up to No. 11 by *CBN* (4/9), became ranked for the first time in 2018 peaking at No. 19 in the *Baseball America* and *Collegiate Baseball News* (4/2) polls. The Sooners were last ranked No. 23 by *D1Baseball.com* and No. 24 by *BA* on May 22, 2017 entering the Big 12 Championship. Oklahoma was ranked for 11 weeks, consecutively, in 2017, including five weeks in all five polls. OU is ranked in every poll for the second week in a row. Last season, the Sooners peaked at No. 9 by *Baseball America* (4/3/17) following a series win over No. 2 Texas Tech. Oklahoma went 22-19 as a ranked team last season.

## MLB Opening Day Starters...

Brewers RHP **Chase Anderson** (2008-09), Rockies RHP **Jon Gray** (2012-13) and Angels RHP **Garrett Richards** (2007-09) represented the Sooners as MLB opening day starters for their respective teams. The University of Oklahoma is the first college to have three alumni start at pitcher on MLB's opening day in recorded history. OU pitchers have combined for five opening day starts in the last three years, the longest in that period and tied for the most with Vanderbilt (David Price-3, Sonny Gray-2) since 2014.

## Joining the 100-100 Club...

**Steele Walker** surpassed 100 RBI and runs for his career against West Virginia (3/23). He became the first OU player to reach 100 in each category since **Sheldon Neuse** (2014-16). Beginning with **Jackson Williams** (2005-07), seven Sooners reached the milestone over the next seven years. Walker is just the second to do so playing his entire career in the BBOR era. All-time, 40 players have reached the 100-run, 100-RBI mark as a Sooner. The first to do so was **Keith Drumright** (1974-76) with 147 runs and 114 RBI. Walker's former teammates **Austin O'Brien** (2014-17) and **Hunter Haley** (2013-16) were the most recent Sooners to approach the mark. O'Brien finished his career with 98 RBI and 95 runs, while Haley finished with 99 RBI and 98 runs. Both O'Brien (UCL) and Haley (wrist) suffered major injuries as seniors.

## Big 12 Pitcher of the Week...

**Jake Irvin** was named Big 12 Pitcher of the Week (4/2) after a career-high eight innings to beat Baylor (3/29). He faced the minimum through five; erasing the first two baserunners of the night on double plays Irvin did not allow a hit until there were two gone in the sixth. He allowed two runs on two hits and two walks to go with seven strikeouts. It was the second weekly Big 12 honor of his career; previously earning the same award following an opening day win over No. 17 Long Beach State (2/17/17).

## Left to Right...

The Sooners have started **Cade Harris**, **Kyler Murray** and **Steele Walker** from left to right in the outfield in 38 games this season and all but three since opening weekend. The unit's total starts together surpassed the Walker-**Ben Hollas-Blake Brewster** unit's 15 from last year. Beginning with opening day 2014 through the 2015 Big 12 Championship, **Hunter Haley-Craig Aikin-Taylor Alspaugh** patrolled the Sooner outfield together for 82 games. Walker, who has started all but two games in his entire career at OU, is the only true outfielder of the group. Harris moved to left field last season to solidify a position that had been started by six different players, including 14 starts by Murray, until Harris started the last 17 games of the season. Murray, a high school All-American middle infielder, did not play in the outfield until 2017 and had previously not played baseball in the spring of 2016.

### Deep Threat in Center or Under Center...

Sooner quarterback and outfielder **Kyler Murray** has made the adjustment to center field in his second year on the diamond. Murray, who threw three touchdown passes in only 21 attempts in 2017, has found his knack for the long ball this spring. He is tied for the team lead with three home runs. Murray hit his third of the season vs. Texas A&M Corpus Christi (3/9) for his first career grand slam. The grand slam capped a five-run seventh, that was tied 6-6 when the Sooners came to bat, and stood as the difference in an 11-7 Oklahoma victory.

### Senior Leader...

**Kyle Mendenhall** has the distinction of being the only four-year senior on the OU roster; a position that has been held by just one player in each of the last three seasons. **Hunter Haley** was the only four-year player in 2016 and **Austin O'Brien** the only one in 2017. Mendenhall is building on his junior campaign, which was his best offensive season through three years at OU. A .250 career hitter, he is currently hitting .329 and driven in 31 runs, the highest total of his career.

### Big 12 Player of the Week...

**Brylie Ware** earned his second career weekly honor from the Big 12 as the Player of the Week (3/26). He hit a team-leading .562 (9-for-16), including .500 (6-for-12) with nine RBI in a series win over WVU. Ware went 3-for-4 in each of the first two games of the week, including a six-RBI game vs. the Mountaineers; the most by a Sooner since **Craig Aikin's** six vs. Little Rock (3/3/15).

### Scoring Early...

OU scored in the first inning for the 19th time this season against UT Arlington (4/24). The Sooners are 16-3 when scoring in the first inning this season; outscoring opponents 38-17 in the first. OU took over the opposition for a 61-56 lead on runs scored in the second and third innings combined. OU is also 20-7 on the year when pushing across the first run of the game.

### Two-Way Player...

**Cade Cavalli** has started 37 games in the field or at DH and vs. TAMCC (3/10) got his first start on the mound. He is hitting .228 at the plate with 26 runs and 21 RBI. He hit a home run on just the second pitch he saw in his career vs. Indiana (2/16). Cavalli earned his first win in relief against Valparaiso (2/25). He is the first OU player to homer and win a game in a season since All-American **Sheldon Neuse** hit 10 home runs and went 4-1 as the Sooner closer in 2016. **Jacob Evans** also won six games and hit one home run in 2015; having hit a walk-off jack as the winning pitcher vs. Kansas (4/2/15).

### Behind the Dish...

Three catchers have started four games or more for the Sooners this season. **Brady Lindsly** has started 27 and **Justin Mitchell** has started 10, while **Domenic DeRenzo** has started five. Mitchell's nine are the most by a freshman since DeRenzo started 33 in 2016. OU has not had three catchers start four games since **Mac James**, **Anthony Hermelyn** and **Dylan Neal** in 2014.

### Winning Comparison...

In 39 games, including 33 starts, **Jake Irvin** owns a 17-6 record. His career 17 wins, the last of which came in his 29th start, tied **Andrew Doyle** (2008-09) for fourth most by a Sooner to take the mound in the last 10 years; surpassing **Jacob Evans** (2013-15). **Michael Rocha** (2008-11) won the most games over that period with 27 followed by **Dillon Overton** (2011-13) with 23. Overton won his 17th in his 48th game and 26th start, while Rocha's came in his 60th game and 24th start.

## Midweek Summary...

The latest walk-off win started with a two-out single by **Kyler Murray**, who got into scoring position by swiping second. **Brady Lindsly** then delivered Murray home with a double to the track in right-center.

## Keepin' it 100...

In national rankings, Oklahoma peaks in the charts at 13th with 26 sacrifice-flies. Individually, **Cade Harris** is in the top-10 in three categories; second in the country with 46 walks, ranking 10th with 51 runs and 25th with 17 doubles.

**No-Decision vs. Texas:** Pitched six innings and left after a leadoff-triple in the top of the seventh with a 5-2 lead. Wound up with a no-decision as he allowed three runs on seven hits and no walks with six strikeouts.

**Career Night:** Pitched a career-high eight innings to earn his fifth win of the season in a 4-2 decision over Baylor (3/29). Faced the minimum through five; erasing the first two baserunners of the night on double plays. Did not allow a hit until two outs in the sixth. Struck out seven and walked just two in the longest outing by a Sooner since 2015.

**2018 Big 12 Opener:** Matched his then career-high with seven innings to defeat West Virginia (3/23). Allowed only one baserunner through five innings. A sixth-inning error opened the door for four unearned runs to score. Totaled nine strikeouts and went a second start in a row without issuing a walk.

**No-Strikeout Night:** First career start without a strikeout. Lasted 4.1 innings against Texas A&M Corpus Christi (3/9). Allowed five runs on four hits and five walks. Walked and hit a batter before being pulled with one out in the fifth.

**Vs. Bama:** Racked up 11 strikeouts for the second start in a row. Kept Alabama (3/2) scoreless through five innings before a two-out double scored a runner from first in the sixth.

**Home Opener:** Tossed six-scoreless vs. Holy Cross (2/24) and struck out 11; surpassing double digits for the fourth time in his career. Scattered two hits and two walks; allowing only two runners to reach scoring position.

**2018 Opening Day:** Won on opening day for the second year in a row. Threw 86 pitches in five innings of work with seven strikeouts to beat No. 20 Indiana (2/16). Overcame an early deficit after allowing two first-inning runs.

**Summer Ball:** Invited to Team USA Collegiate National Team tryouts. Pitched three-scoreless with five strikeouts in an exhibition start. Invited back to Team USA roster for exhibition start against the Futures League All-Stars (7/11/17).

**Regional Recap:** Held Louisville (6/3/17) scoreless through five against National Player of the Year Brendan McKay and allowed just one run in the first seven innings. Gave up two runs in the eighth before being relieved and took the loss in a winner's bracket contest.

**14-K Night:** Irvin struck out 14 batters in a six-inning start to beat Central Connecticut (3/3), 3-0. It marked the most strikeouts by a Sooner since Michael Rocha's 13 vs. Texas A&M in 2011.
