#### First Pitch...

The Oklahoma baseball team travels to Orlando, Fla., for its final non-conference series of the regular season this weekend. The Sooners will face the UCF Knights for a three-game series starting Friday at 5:30 p.m. CT.

#### About the Sooners...

Oklahoma is 31-18 overall and third place in the Big 12 with a 13-8 record. The Sooners are hitting ,282 as a team, including a .286 mark in conference games to rank third in the league. Junior right fielder Steele Walker leads the way with a .355 average, hitting .390 in 20 conference games, and slugging .608 with 11 home runs and 47 RBI this season. Junior third baseman Brylie Ware is second on the team with a .344 batting average and is fourt on the team with 33 RBI. Ware has a team-best nine-game hitting streak heading into this weekend's series and was 5-for-9 (.556) during last week's series against Kansas State. The OU pitching staff owns a 3.80 earned run average on the season, which ranks third in the conference. In Big 12 play, the Sooners boast a 4.12 ERA and lead the conference with a .241 batting average against. Junior right-handed pitcher Jake Irvin, the Sooners' Friday night starter, is 6-1 with a 3.05 ERA and 88 strikeouts in 73.2 innings worked. Irvin was named Big 12 Co-Pitcher of the Week on Monday after tossing six-shutout innings with 10 strikeouts against Kansas State (5/4). Sophomore right-hander **Nathan** Wiles is 4-3 with a 3.98 ERA, including a 3.27 mark in league games; ranking fifth in the Big 12. He has struck out 43 and walked only 10 in 61.0 innings.

#### **HEAD COACH SKIP JOHNSON**

Skip Johnson was introduced as the 10th head coach of the OU baseball program on June 19, 2017.

Johnson served as the Sooners' pitching coach in 2017 after a 25-year coaching career in the state of Texas, including the most recent 10 years as an assistant and associate head coach at the University of Texas. In his lone season in Norman, he helped OU to its first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2013.

Johnson made an immediate impact on the Sooner pitching staff last season. Oklahoma pitchers surrendered the least amount of home runs in the Big 12 in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. The Sooners' 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions.

Johnson was hired as the pitching coach at Texas for the 2007 season under Augie Garrido. In 10 seasons, Johnson helped the Longhorns to seven NCAA Regional appearances, four Super Regionals and three CWS.

During his tenure in Austin, 32 pitchers were selected in the MLB Draft, including 14 in the first 10 rounds and three first-round picks. Johnson oversaw the development of six UT pitchers to make it to the majors. The Texas pitching staff produced a team ERA below 3.00 on five occasions and struck out better than 7.5 per-nine-innings in five of his last eight seasons.

Prior to his time in Austin, Johnson was the head coach at Navarro College of the NJCAA's Texas Eastern Athletic Conference. From 1994-2006, he guided the Bulldogs to 13 NJCAA Regionals, nine TEAC championships and four regional titles, while compiling 450 wins.

A standout baseball player at Denton High School, Johnson began his collegiate playing career at Ranger (Texas) College. After a two-year career there, Johnson moved on to play baseball at the University of North Texas in 1988 before the school dropped its baseball program. He completed his collegiate playing career at UT-Pan American, lettering for the Broncs in 1989 and receiving his bachelor's degree in 1990. Johnson earned a master's degree in education from UT-Tyler in 1993.

A native of Denton, Texas, Johnson and his wife, Cathy, have two sons, Tyler and Garrett.

#### Scouting the Knights...

UCF fell in a midweek contest to Florida Atlantic, 11-8, on Tuesday night in West Palm Beach, Fla. In its last AAC series, UCF took two out of three from Houston to move to 11-10 in the league. **Rylan Thomas** leads UCF with a .368 batting average and 12 home runs this season. Thomas is tied with **Tyler Osik** for the team lead with 53 RBI. Osik is hitting .324 with nine home runs. UCF's pitching staff is limiting opponents to a .214 average this season and has a 3.14 ERA as a staff. **Cre Finfrock** has made five starts for the Knights this season, and has a 5-0 record with a 3.46 ERA.

#### Last Time They Met...

In the previous meeting, UCF topped the Sooners, 4-1, in Orlando. It was a pitcher's duel between UCF right-hander Spencer Davis and the OU bullpen. The Knights totaled six hits, while the Sooners managed just five. Davis tossed 6.2 innings and allowed one unearned run on three hits and four walks, while striking out four. For Oklahoma, left-hander **Adam Choplick** ran into trouble in the fourth inning and was credited for all four runs, all earned, on five hits, three hit batsmen and a walk in 3.2 innings. For OU, **Hunter Haley** was 2-for-5 with one run scored.

#### Irvin Named Big 12 Pitcher of the Week Again

Jake Irvin earned his second weekly conference honor of the season and was named Big 12 Co-Pitcher of the Week, the league office announced on Monday. The junior right-hander led the Sooners to a 12-0 shutout win over Kansas State on Friday night. The Bloomington, Minn., native shared the weekly award with TCU's Haylen Green. Irvin pitched six-scoreless innings as OU claimed its fifth shutout of the season. Irvin along with **Ryan Madden** and **Zack Matthews** combined for a three-hitter to open the series against Kansas State. Irvin struck out 10 in Friday's victory, marking the fourth time this season the junior has picked up at least 10 strikeouts in a start. It also marked the first time Irvin has recorded back-to-back starts against a conference opponent with 10-plus strikeouts in his OU career. The award is the second of the year for Irvin and the third earned by a Sooner pitcher this season.

#### Pitching Dominates Against K-State

OU's pitching staff was dominant in its three-game series sweep over Kansas State, posting a 1.00 ERA with two shutouts. In Friday's night 12-0 win over K-State, **Jake Irvin**, **Ryan Madden** and **Zack Matthews** combined for a three-hit shutout and recorded 14 strikeouts. The Sooners tossed another three-hitter on Saturday to earn a 2-0 victory, using seven different pitchers to clinch the series over the Wildcats.

#### **Power Surge**

Oklahoma went 30 games between multi-home run games having gone yard three times opening day vs. Indiana (2/16) and **Kyler Murray's** two long balls at TCU (4/6). The Sooners then homered in six consecutive games; marking the first stretch of five or more games since 2010 and the first in the BBCOR (2011-present) era. **Steele Walker** hit two vs. TCU (4/8) and Little Rock (4/10) as the Sooners matched their season-high with three. Oklahoma added two more vs. Oral Roberts (4/11) and another Walker home run vs. Texas (4/13). The Sooners have hit 20 of their 32 home runs in the last 19 games. Walker has homered nine times over that stretch, while Murray has homered four times.

#### Up Next...

The Sooners wrap up Big 12 play next weekend with a three-game series at Kansas. OU and the Jayhawks begin the series on Thursday at 6:05 p.m. CT. Kansas won the series last year in Norman.

#### Big 12 Newcomer of the Week

#### 11-Hit Weekend...

**Steele Walker** hit .688 (11-for-16) at Texas Tech (4/20-22). He notched at least three hits in every game; matching his careerhigh with four twice. Walker is a career .512 (22-for-43) hitter against the Red Raiders. In game two, he homered and doubled in a 4-for-5, two-RBI performance. In the finale, Walker went 4-for-6 against a variety of Tech defensive shifts. Walker owned a .706 on-base percentage and slugged 1.188 for an astounding 1.894 OPS.

#### Friday Ace...

**Jake Irvin** has started all 12 series openers for Oklahoma this season and 10 of 12 weekend game ones as a sophomore in 2017. He is 12-2 in those 24 starts with 14 starts of six innings or more. When Irvin won the series opener, the Sooners have won 11 of 12 series. When Irvin took a loss, no-decision or did not start game one, OU has won five of 12 series.

#### Free Bases...

**Cade Harris** drew the 100th base on balls on his career vs. Texas (4/15) to become the 14th player in program history to reach that mark, the first since **Casey Bookout** (1996-99). He currently ranks sixth all-time at 0U with 111. Harris needs just 17 more walks to move into the top-5 all-time at Oklahoma. **Damon Minor** (1993-36) is the program's all-time leader with 139 walks.

#### Double Take...

As a freshman, **Steele Walker** was one shy of the Sooner rookie record with 17 doubles. His 12 this season has pushed his career total to 45. Walker cracked the top-20 list in the OU record book vs. Oral Roberts (4/11). He is tied for 13th all-time at Oklahoma with **Aaron Baker** (2007-09) and **Ray Hayward** (1980-83).

#### Spring Cleaning...

Oklahoma has sweep three Big 12 series this season (West Virginia, at TCU and Kansas State), marking the first time the Sooners have accomplished that feat since 2004. OU brought out the brooms on back-to-back weekends to start conference play with sweeps of West Virginia and Baylor. The Sooners swept back-to-back three-game conference series for the first time since beating Missouri and winning at Texas Tech in 2006. Overall, OU moved to 8-0 in the Big 12 for the first time in the 22-year history of the league and to start conference play since 1984 in the Big Eight following two wins at TCU. Last weekend, OU outscored K-State, 18-3.

#### Turn Down the Horns...

Oklahoma salvaged its series with Texas (4/15) behind sophomore right-hander **Nathan Wiles'** 7.2-scoreless innings. The Sooners' 6-0 win marked their first shutout of the Longhorns since March 16, 1957. Wiles was named Big 12 Pitcher of the Week (4/16) after scattering five hits and issuing just one walk, which came in his final inning of work.

#### Reaching the Charts...

Oklahoma, which was up to No. 11 by *CBN* (4/9), became ranked for the first time in 2018 peaking at No. 19 in the *Baseball America* and *Collegiate Baseball News* (4/2) polls. The Sooners were last ranked No. 23 by D1Baseball.com and No. 24 by BA on May 22, 2017 entering the Big 12 Championship. Oklahoma was ranked for 11 weeks, consecutively, in 2017, including five weeks in all five polls. OU is ranked in every poll for the second week in a row. Last season, the Sooners peaked at No. 9 by *Baseball America* (4/3/17) following a series win over No. 2 Texas Tech. Oklahoma went 22-19 as a ranked feam last season.

#### MLB Opening Day Starters...

Brewers RHP **Chase Anderson** (2008-09), Rockies RHP **Jon Gray** (2012-13) and Angels RHP **Garrett Richards** (2007-09) represented the Sooners as MLB opening day starters for their respective teams. The University of Oklahoma is the first college to have three alumni start at pitcher on MLB's opening day in recorded history. OU pitchers have combined for five opening day starts in the last three years, the longest in that period and tied for the most with Vanderbilt (David Price-3, Sonny Gray-2) since 2014.

#### Joining the 100-100 Club...

Steele Walker surpassed 100 RBI and runs for his career against West Virginia (3/23). He became the first OU player to reach 100 in each category since **Sheldon Neuse** (2014-16). Beginning with **Jackson Williams** (2005-07), seven Sooners reached the milestone over the next seven years. Walker is just the second to do so playing his entire career in the BBCOR era. All-time, 40 players have reached the 100-run, 100-RBI mark as a Sooner. The first to do so was **Keith Drumright** (1974-76) with 147 runs and 114 RBI. Walker's former teammates **Austin O'Brien** (2014-17) and **Hunter Haley** (2013-16) were the most recent Sooners to approach the mark. O'Brien finished his career with 98 RBI and 95 runs, while Haley finished with 99 RBI and 98 runs. Both O'Brien (UCL) and Haley (wrist) suffered major injuries as seniors.

#### Big 12 Pitcher of the Week...

**Jake Irvin** was named Big 12 Pitcher of the Week (4/2) after a career-high eight innings to beat Baylor (3/29). He faced the minimum through five; erasing the first two baserunners of the night on double plays Irvin did not allow a hit until there were two gone in the sixth. He allowed two runs on two hits and two walks to go with seven strikeouts. It was the second weekly Big 12 honor of his career; previously earning the same award following an opening day win over No. 17 Long Beach State (2/17/17).

#### Left to Right...

The Sooners have started **Cade Harris, Kyler Murray** and **Steele Walker** from left to right in the outfield in 41 games this season and all but three since opening weekend. The unit's total starts together surpassed the Walker-**Ben Hollas-Blake Brewster** unit's 15 from last year. Beginning with opening day 2014 through the 2015 Big 12 Championship, **Hunter Haley-Craig Aikin-Taylor Alspaugh** patrolled the Sooner outfield together for 82 games. Walker, who has started all but two games in his entire career at OU, is the only true outfielder of the group. Harris moved to left field last season to solidify a position that had been started by six different players, including 14 starts by Murray, until Harris started the last 17 games of the season. Murray, a high school All-American middle infielder, did not play in the outfield until 2017 and had previously not played baseball in the spring of 2016.

#### Deep Threat in Center or Under Center...

Sooner quarterback and outfielder **Kyler Murray** has made the adjustment to center field in his second year on the diamond. Murray, who threw three touchdown passes in only 21 attempts in 2017, has found his knack for the long ball this spring. He is second on the team with seven home runs. Murray hit his seventh home run of the season last Friday against Kansas State (5/4), finishing 2-of-4 at the plate and tying his career high with four RBI.

#### Senior Leader...

**Kyle Mendenhall** has the distinction of being the only four-year senior on the OU roster; a position that has been held by just one player in each of the last three seasons. **Hunter Haley** was the only four-year player in 2016 and **Austin O'Brien** the only one in 2017. Mendenhall is building on his junior campaign, which was his best offensive season through three years at OU. A .249 career hitter, he is currently hitting .317 and driven in 34 runs, the highest total of his career.

#### Big 12 Player of the Week...

**Brylie Ware** earned his second career weekly honor from the Big 12 as the Player of the Week (3/26). He hit a team-leading .562 (9-for-16), including .500 (6-for-12) with nine RBI in a series win over WVU. Ware went 3-for-4 in each of the first two games of the week, including a six-RBI game vs. the Mountaineers; the most by a Sooner since **Craig Aikin's** six vs. Little Rock (3/3/15).

#### Scoring Early...

OU scored in the first inning for the 20th time this season against Kansas State (5/4). The Sooners are 17-3 when scoring in the first inning this season; outscoring opponents 39-17 in the first. OU took over the opposition for a 65-56 lead on runs scored in the second and third innings combined. OU is also 22-7 on the year when pushing across the first run of the game.

**Cade Cavalli** has started 40 games in the field or at DH and vs. TAMCC (3/10) got his first start on the mound. He is hitting .226 at the plate with 26 runs and 23 RBI. He hit a home run on just the second pitch he saw in his career vs. Indiana (2/16). Cavalli earned his first win in relief against Valparaiso (2/25). He is the first OU player to homer and win a game in a season since All-American **Sheldon Neuse** hit 10 home runs and went 4-1 as the Sooner closer in 2016. **Jacob Evans** also won six games and hit one home run in 2015; having hit a walk-off jack as the winning pitcher vs. Kansas (4/2/15).

#### Behind the Dish...

Three catchers have started four games or more for the Sooners this season. **Brady Lindsly** has started 30 and **Justin Mitchell** has started 10, while **Domenic DeRenzo** has started five. Mitchell's nine are the most by a freshman since DeRenzo started 33 in 2016. OU has not had three catchers start four games since **Mac James, Anthony Hermelyn** and **Dylan Neal** in 2014.

#### Winning Comparison...

In 40 games, including 34 starts, **Jake Irvin** owns a 18-6 record. His career 18 wins, the last of which came in his 34th start, ranks as the third most by Sooner on the mound in the last 10 seasons. **Michael Rocha** (2008-11) won the most games over that period with 27 followed by **Dillon Overton** (2011-13) with 23. Overton won his 17th in his 49th game and 27th start, while Rocha's came in his 61th game and 25th start. Irvin needs two more victories to break into OU's all-time wins list.

#### Midweek Summary...

The Sooners went 7-3 in the midweek this season; averaging 9.0 runs per game. Oklahoma was 1-2 against ranked opponents, 5-1 at home and 2-2 on the road. Following OU's 11-5 win at UT Arlington, its final midweek of the season, the average RPI of the Sooners' seven midweek opponents was 102. As a whole, Oklahoma's non-conference RPI is 61.

#### Sundays Are For Walk-Offs...

Since the 2016 season, Oklahoma has walked off a winner 12 times; all at home. Seven of those wins have come on Sundays. The Sooners added to their list of recent walk-offs this season vs. Valparaiso (2/25), Alabama (3/2) and Baylor (3/30). The latest walk-off win started with a two-out single by **Kyler Murray**, who got into scoring position by swiping second. **Brady Lindsly** then delivered Murray home with a double to the track in right-center.

#### Keepin' it 100...

In national rankings, Oklahoma peaks in the charts at fourth with 31 sacrifice-flies. Individually, **Cade Harris** is in the top-35 in three categories; third in the country with 50 walks, ranking 17th with 53 runs and 32nd with 17 doubles. Kyle Mendenhall's seven sacrifice flies this year rank seventh in the country.

**Last Start:** Threw six-shutout innings against Kansas State and struck out 10 for the second consecutive start to earn his sixth win of the season. Surrendered two hits as OU's staff combined to toss a three-hit shutout against the Wildcats.

**No-Decision vs. Texas:** Pitched six innings and left after a leadoff-triple in the top of the seventh with a 5-2 lead. Wound up with a no-decision as he allowed three runs on seven hits and no walks with six strikeouts.

**Career Night:** Pitched a career-high eight innings to earn his fifth win of the season in a 4-2 decision over Baylor (3/29). Faced the minimum through five; erasing the first two baserunners of the night on double plays. Did not allow a hit until two outs in the sixth. Struck out seven and walked just two in the longest outing by a Sooner since 2015.

**2018 Big 12 Opener:** Matched his then career-high with seven innings to defeat West Virginia (3/23). Allowed only one baserunner through five innings. A sixth-inning error opened the door for four unearned runs to score. Totaled nine strikeouts and went a second start in a row without issuing a walk.

**No-Strikeout Night:** First career start without a strikeout. Lasted 4.1 innings against Texas A&M Corpus Christi (3/9). Allowed five runs on four hits and five walks. Walked and hit a batter before being pulled with one out in the fifth.

**Vs. Bama:** Racked up 11 strikeouts for the second start in a row. Kept Alabama (3/2) scoreless through five innings before a two-out double scored a runner from first in the sixth.

**Home Opener:** Tossed six-scoreless vs. Holy Cross (2/24) and struck out 11; surpassing double digits for the fourth time in his career. Scattered two hits and two walks; allowing only two runners to reach scoring position.

**2018 Opening Day:** Won on opening day for the second year in a row. Threw 86 pitches in five innings of work with seven strikeouts to beat No. 20 Indiana (2/16). Overcame an early deficit after allowing two first-inning runs.

**Summer Ball:** Invited to Team USA Collegiate National Team tryouts. Pitched three-scoreless with five strikeouts in an exhibition start. Invited back to Team USA roster for exhibition start against the Futures League All-Stars (7/11/17).

**Regional Recap:** Held Louisville (6/3/17) scoreless through five against National Player of the Year Brendan McKay and allowed just one run in the first seven innings. Gave up two runs in the eighth before being relieved and took the loss in a winner's bracket contest.

**14-K Night:** Irvin struck out 14 batters in a six-inning start to beat Central Connecticut (3/3), 3-0. It marked the most strikeouts by a Sooner since Michael Rocha's 13 vs. Texas A&M in 2011. He struck out three in an inning in the second, fourth and sixth and struck out five in a row for the second time in his career between the fourth and fifth innings.


