#### First Pitch...

Oklahoma enters the 22nd Big 12 Championship as the No. 4 seed. The Sooners open the double-elimination tournament on Wednesday against No. 5 seed Baylor at 9 a.m. from Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark in Oklahoma City. OU and Baylor are the only two Big 12 teams to appear in all 22 Big 12 Championships.

#### About the Sooners...

Oklahoma is 34-21 overall and finished in fourth place in the Big 12 with a 14-10 record. The Sooners are hitting .277 as a team, including a .284 mark in conference games to rank third in the league. Junior right fielder **Steele Walker** leads the way with a .352 average, hitting .370 in 23 conference games, and slugging .606 with 13 home runs and 53 RBI this season. Redshirt sophomore center fielder **Kyler Murray** ranks second on the team with 10 home runs and 46 RBI, while hitting .292 this year. In the month of May, Murray has homered four times and driven in 14, while recording a .364 batting average. The OU pitching staff owns a 3.87 earned run average on the season, which ranks third in the conference. In Big 12 play, the Sooners boast a 4.12 ERA and rank second the conference with a .241 batting average against. Junior right-handed pitcher **Jake Irvin**, the Sooners' Friday night starter, is 6-1 with a 3.01 ERA and 103 strikeouts in 86.2 innings worked. Sophomore right-hander **Nathan Wiles** is 6-3 with a 4.03 ERA, including a 3.91 mark in league games; ranking sixth in the Big 12. He has struck out 55 and walked only 13 in 73.2 innings.

#### Leading Off

- Oklahoma is 3-3 against Baylor all-time at the Big 12 Championship. The teams last met in the first round of 2013 Big 12 Championship with the Sooners defeating the Bears, 2-0.
- The Sooners recorded three Big 12 sweeps this season (Baylor, Kansas State and West Virginia). It was the first time for the Sooners to sweep three conference series since 2004.
- Jake Irvin is the first OU pitcher to record 100 K's in one season since Jonathan Gray in 2013 (147).
- Steele Walker was one named a semifinalist for the Golden Spikes Award, joining Texas' Kody Clemens and Texas Tech's Josh Jung on the list from the Big 12.
- Conner Berry and Austin Hansen have combined to record 13 saves this season. OU's pitching staff has 15 save this season, which ranks second in the Big 12.
- The Sooners are 25-7 at home this season; their first 25-win season at home since going 25-6 in 2013.
- Cade Harris' 57 walks are the most by an OU player in the Big 12 era and currently rank second in Division I. Harris has 58 runs, 58 hits and 57 walks this season.

#### HEAD COACH SKIP JOHNSON

Skip Johnson was introduced as the 10th head coach of the OU baseball program on June 19, 2017.

Johnson served as the Sooners' pitching coach in 2017 after a 25-year coaching career in the state of Texas, including the most recent 10 years as an assistant and associate head coach at the University of Texas. In his lone season in Norman, he helped OU to its first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2013.

Johnson made an immediate impact on the Sooner pitching staff last season. Oklahoma pitchers surrendered the least amount of home runs in the Big 12 in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. The Sooners' 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions.

Johnson was hired as the pitching coach at Texas for the 2007 season under Augie Garrido. In 10 seasons, Johnson helped the Longhorns to seven NCAA Regional appearances, four Super Regionals and three CWS.

During his tenure in Austin, 32 pitchers were selected in the MLB Draft, including 14 in the first 10 rounds and three first-round picks. Johnson oversaw the development of six UT pitchers to make it to the majors. The Texas pitching staff produced a team ERA below 3.00 on five occasions and struck out better than 7.5 per-nine-innings in five of his last eight seasons.

Prior to his time in Austin, Johnson was the head coach at Navarro College of the NJCAA's Texas Eastern Athletic Conference. From 1994-2006, he guided the Bulldogs to 13 NJCAA Regionals, nine TEAC championships and four regional titles, while compiling 450 wins.

A standout baseball player at Denton High School, Johnson began his collegiate playing career at Ranger (Texas) College. After a two-year career there, Johnson moved on to play baseball at the University of North Texas in 1988 before the school dropped its baseball program. He completed his collegiate playing career at UT-Pan American, lettering for the Broncs in 1989 and receiving his bachelor's degree in 1990. Johnson earned a master's degree in education from UT-Tyler in 1993.

A native of Denton, Texas, Johnson and his wife, Cathy, have two sons, Tyler and Garrett.

#### Scouting the Bears...

Baylor enters the postseason with a 32-19 record overall, and finished with a 13-11 mark in league play under third-year head coach **Steve Rodriguez**. The Bears come in following a road series win at West Virginia. The Baylor lineup is led by junior outfielder **T.J. Raguse** who is batting .372. Sophomore first baseman **Andy Thomas**, who is fourth on the team in RBI with 31, is hitting .347. On the hill, Baylor is guided by sophomore **Cody Bradford** who boasts a 6-5 record and a 2.60 ERA in 83.0 innings. In his last start (5/16), Bradford took the loss at West Virginia, allowing one earned run on four hits with five strikeouts. In league play, Bradford led the Big 12 in ERA (1.88) and posted a 4-3 record with two complete games. Senior **Troy Montemayor** ranks second in the conference with 11 saves this season.

#### Last Time They Met...

Oklahoma completed the sweep of Baylor with a 6-1 win at L. Dale Mitchell Park on March 31. The victory marked the first time that Sooners swept their first two Big 12 series to begin conference play during the Big 12 era. **Nathan Wiles** pitched five innings, allowing one run, not earned, with three strikeouts. **Dylan Grove** qualified for the save, pitching the final four innings. **Cade Cavalli** and **Steele Walker** both homered and finished with two RBI. The win gave OU its third consecutive series win over Baylor.

#### Against Baylor...

Oklahoma leads the all-time series over Baylor, 45-37, and swept the Bears in Norman, March 29-31. OU has won eight out of its last 10 matchups with the Bears dating back to 2015. OU and Baylor have faced off six times at the Big 12 Championship with the Sooners winning three in a row. The Sooners topped Baylor twice in 2012 and opened the tournament against the Bears in 2013. **Jonathan Gray** tossed a three-hit shutout in OU's Big 12 Tournament opening win over Baylor.

#### By the Numbers: The Sooners vs. Baylor...

**Cade Cavalli**: .364/.417/.636 in three games against Baylor. Homered in series finale against Baylor (3/31/18). **Kyle Mendenhall**: Seven starts at 2B with a three-run game (3/24/17) and three-RBI game (3/26/17). **Jake Irvin**: 8.0 IP, allowed two hits and two earns runs to pick up the win at home (3/29/18). **Brylie Ware**: Hit .455 (5-for-11) in last year's series; played first base. **Brandon Zaragoza**: Has a career .280 average (7-for-25) against Baylor.

#### Sooners Tournament History...

All-time, Oklahoma is 36-35 in the Big 12 Championship. The Sooners and Baylor are the only two teams to qualify for all 22 championships in the league's history. The series is tied 3-3 in the Big 12 Championship; though the two teams have not met in a postseason game since 2013. Joining OU and Baylor in the bracket are No. 1 seed Texas and No. 8 seed Kansas. Oklahoma faced the Longhorns in last year's 2017 Big 12 Championship and last played Kansas in 2013; winning the championship game, 7-2. The Sooners went undefeated in 2013 to win the title. OU won the league's first championship in 1997 and overcame a game one loss to Texas A&M before winning four in a row, including a 19-17 decision vs. Texas Tech in the final.

#### 2017 Tournament Recap...

The Sooners went 0-2 at the 2017 Big 12 Championship, failing to win a game at the event for the first time since 2005. No. 3 seed Oklahoma fell to No. 6 seed Texas, 8-4, in the opener. The Sooners then eliminated No. 2 seed TCU, 9-4. OU has won at least one game at the Big 12 Championship in 19 of 21 appearances.

## Walker Named Golden Spikes Semifinalist

**Steele Walker** was named a semifinalist to the Golden Spikes Award on Monday. Walker leads the Sooners with 13 home runs and 53 RBI to go along with 13 doubles. He is the first Sooner to make the semifinalist cut since **Sheldon Neuse** in 2016.

## Catching Connection...

Oklahoma sophomore catcher **Brady Lindsly** and Baylor sophomore catcher **Shea Langeliers** were high school teammates at Keller (Texas) High School from 2013-16. Langeliers was the primary catcher, while Lindsly moved to shortstop. As a freshman, Langeliers was a Freshman All-American and member of the All-Big 12 Second Team as a .313 hitter with 10 home runs and 38. RBI. Lindsly hit .271 in just 14 starts behind **Renae Martinez**; another All-Big 12 Second Team member. This season, Langeliers is hitting .235 with nine home runs and 37 RBI, while Lindsly is hitting .276 with one home run and 26 RBI.

## Kyler Knows...

**Kyler Murray** shined in OU's series win at UCF, blasting a pair of go-ahead three-run home runs in the Sooners' victories on May 12 and 13. Murray drove in four and finished 2-for-4 with a home run and double in game two of the series. He followed up with a pair of walks, had three RBI and finished 1-for-3 in the series final. Murray is hitting .364 with four home runs and 14 RBI in the month of May, hitting three home runs in the last five games.

## Power Surge ...

Oklahoma went 30 games between multi-home run games having gone yard three times opening day vs. Indiana (2/16) and **Kyler Murray's** two long balls at TCU (4/6). The Sooners then homered in six consecutive games; marking the first stretch of five or more games since 2010 and the first in the BBCOR (2011-present) era. **Steele Walker** hit two vs. TCU (4/8) and Little Rock (4/10) as the Sooners matched their season-high with three. Oklahoma added two more vs. Oral Roberts (4/11) and another Walker home run vs. Texas (4/13). The Sooners homered eight times during their series at Kansas, hitting four long balls in Sunday's win at Kansas (5/19). Walker and **Cade Cavalli** each homered twice at KU.

## 11-Hit Weekend...

**Steele Walker** hit .688 (11-for-16) at Texas Tech (4/20-22). He notched at least three hits in every game; matching his career-high with four twice. Walker is a career .512 (22-for-43) hitter against the Red Raiders. In game two, he homered and doubled in a 4-for-5, two-RBI performance. In the finale, Walker went 4-for-6 against a variety of Tech defensive shifts. Walker owned a .706 on-base percentage and slugged 1.188 for an astounding 1.894 OPS.

## Friday Ace...

**Jake Irvin** has started all 14 series openers for Oklahoma this season and 10 of 12 weekend game ones as a sophomore in 2017. He is 12-2 in those 26 starts with 16 starts of six innings or more. When Irvin won the series opener, the Sooners have won 11 of 12 series. When Irvin took a loss, no-decision or did not start game one, OU has won six of 14 series.

## Free Bases...

**Cade Harris** drew the 100th base on balls of his career vs. Texas (4/15) to become the 14th player in OU history to reach that mark, the first since **Casey Bookout** (1996-99). He currently ranks sixth all-time with 118. Harris needs just 11 more walks to move into the top-5 all-time at Oklahoma. **Damon Minor** (1993-36) is the program's all-time leader with 139 walks. Harris' 58 walks this year are the third-most OU single-season history.

## Double Take...

As a freshman, **Steele Walker** was one shy of the Sooner rookie record with 17 doubles. His 14 this season has pushed his career total to 47. Walker cracked the top-20 list in the OU record book vs. Oral Roberts (4/11) and currently ranks 13th all-time.

## Spring Cleaning...

Oklahoma has sweep three Big 12 series this season (West Virginia, at TCU and Kansas State), marking the first time the Sooners have accomplished that feat since 2004. OU brought out the brooms on back-to-back weekends to start conference play with sweeps of West Virginia and Baylor. The Sooners swept back-to-back three-game conference series for the first time since beating Missouri and winning at Texas Tech in 2006. Overall, OU moved to 8-0 in the Big 12 for the first time in the 22-year history of the league and to start conference play since 1984 in the Big Eight following two wins at TCU. OU outscored K-State, 18-3.

## Turn Down the Horns...

Oklahoma salvaged its series with Texas (4/15) behind sophomore right-hander **Nathan Wiles'** 7.2-scoreless innings. The Sooners' 6-0 win marked their first shutout of the Longhorns since March 16, 1957. Wiles was named Big 12 Pitcher of the Week (4/16) after scattering five hits and issuing just one walk, which came in his final inning of work..

## MLB Opening Day Starters...

Brewers RHP **Chase Anderson** (2008-09), Rockies RHP **Jon Gray** (2012-13) and Angels RHP **Garrett Richards** (2007-09) represented the Sooners as MLB opening day starters for their respective teams. The University of Oklahoma is the first college to have three alumni start at pitcher on MLB's opening day in recorded history. OU pitchers have combined for five opening day starts in the last three years, the longest in that period and tied for the most with Vanderbilt (David Price-3, Sonny Gray-2) since 2014.

## Joining the 100-100 Club...

**Steele Walker** surpassed 100 RBI and runs for his career against West Virginia (3/23). He became the first OU player to reach 100 in each category since **Sheldon Neuse** (2014-16). Beginning with **Jackson Williams** (2005-07), seven Sooners reached the milestone over the next seven years. Walker is just the second to do so playing his entire career in the BBCOR era. All-time, 40 players have reached the 100-run, 100-RBI mark as a Sooner. The first to do so was **Keith Drumright** (1974-76) with 147 runs and 114 RBI. Walker's former teammates **Austin O'Brien** (2014-17) and **Hunter Haley** (2013-16) were the most recent Sooners to approach the mark. O'Brien finished his career with 98 RBI and 95 runs, while Haley finished with 99 RBI and 98 runs. Both O'Brien (UCL) and Haley (wrist) suffered major injuries as seniors.

### Left to Right...

The Sooners have started **Cade Harris**, **Kyler Murray** and **Steele Walker** from left to right in the outfield in 44 games this season and all but three since opening weekend. The unit's total starts together surpassed the Walker-**Ben Hollas-Blake Brewster** unit's 15 from last year. Beginning with opening day 2014 through the 2015 Big 12 Championship, **Hunter Haley-Craig Aikin-Taylor Alspaugh** patrolled the Sooner outfield together for 82 games. Walker, who has started all but two games in his entire career at OU, is the only true outfielder of the group. Harris moved to left field last season to solidify a position that had been started by six different players, including 14 starts by Murray, until Harris started the last 17 games of the season. Murray, a high school All-American middle infielder, did not play in the outfield until 2016 and had previously not played baseball in the spring of 2016.

### Deep Threat in Center or Under Center...

Sooner quarterback and outfielder **Kyler Murray** has made the adjustment to center field in his second year on the diamond. Murray, who threw three touchdown passes in only 21 attempts in 2017, has found his knack for the long ball this spring. He is second on the team with 10 home runs and 46 RBI. During the month of May, Murray is eighth in the Big in RBI this season and has hit four home runs during the month of May. He also is second on the team with nine stolen bases.

### Senior Leader...

**Kyle Mendenhall** has the distinction of being the only four-year senior on the OU roster; a position that has been held by just one player in each of the last three seasons. **Hunter Haley** was the only four-year player in 2016 and **Austin O'Brien** the only one in 2017. Mendenhall is building on his junior campaign, which was his best offensive season through three years at OU. A .252 career hitter, he is currently hitting .316 and driven in 38 runs, the highest total of his career.

### Big 12 Player of the Week...

**Brylie Ware** earned his second career weekly honor from the Big 12 as the Player of the Week (3/26). He hit a team-leading .562 (9-for-16), including .500 (6-for-12) with nine RBI in a series win over WVU. Ware went 3-for-4 in each of the first two games of the week, including a six-RBI game vs. the Mountaineers; the most by a Sooner since **Craig Aikin's** six vs. Little Rock (3/3/15).

### Scoring Early...

OU scored in the first inning for the 22nd time this season at Kansas (5/19). The Sooners are 18-4 when scoring in the first inning this season; outscoring opponents 45-20 in the first. OU took over the opposition for a 82-68 lead on runs scored in the second and third innings combined. OU is also 25-8 on the year when pushing across the first run of the game.

### Two-Way Player...

**Cade Cavalli** has started 46 games in the field or at DH and vs. TAMCC (3/10) got his first start on the mound. He is hitting .217 at the plate with 27 runs and 24 RBI. He hit a home run on just the second pitch he saw in his career vs. Indiana (2/16). Cavalli earned his first win in relief against Valparaiso (2/25). He is the first OU player to homer and win a game in a season since All-American **Sheldon Neuse** hit 10 home runs and went 4-1 as the Sooner closer in 2016. **Jacob Evans** also won six games and hit one home run in 2015; having hit a walk-off home run as the winning pitcher vs. Kansas (4/2/15). Cavalli has homered three times in the last six games, recording two homers and four RBI at Kansas last week.

## Winning Comparison...

In 42 games, including 36 starts, **Jake Irvin** owns a 18-6 record. His career 18 wins, the last of which came in his 34th start, ranks as the third most by Sooner on the mound in the last 10 seasons. **Michael Rocha** (2008-11) won the most games over that period with 27 followed by **Dillon Overton** (2011-13) with 23. Overton won his 17th in his 49th game and 27th start, while Rocha's came in his 61th game and 25th start. Irvin needs two more victories to break into OU's all-time wins list.

## Keepin' it 100...

In national rankings, Oklahoma peaks in the charts at seventh with 33 sacrifice-flies. Individually, **Cade Harris** is in the top-40 in three categories; second in the country with 57 walks, ranking 19th with 55 runs and 21st with 20 doubles. Brandon Zaragoza leads the Big 12 and is eighth nationally with 14 sacrifice bunts. **Kyle Mendenhall's** eight sacrifice flies this year rank ninth in the country.

**Combined Shutout:** Threw six-shutout innings against Kansas State and struck out 10 for the second consecutive start to earn his sixth win of the season. Surrendered two hits as OU's staff combined to toss a three-hit shutout against the Wildcats. Named Big 12 Co-Pitcher of the Week.

**No-Decision vs. Texas:** Pitched six innings and left after a leadoff-triple in the top of the seventh with a 5-2 lead. Wound up with a no-decision as he allowed three runs on seven hits and no walks with six strikeouts.

**Career Night:** Pitched a career-high eight innings to earn his fifth win of the season in a 4-2 decision over Baylor (3/29). Faced the minimum through five; erasing the first two baserunners of the night on double plays. Did not allow a hit until two outs in the sixth. Struck out seven and walked just two in the longest outing by a Sooner since 2015.

**2018 Big 12 Opener:** Matched his then career-high with seven innings to defeat West Virginia (3/23). Allowed only one baserunner through five innings. A sixth-inning error opened the door for four unearned runs to score. Totaled nine strikeouts and went a second start in a row without issuing a walk.

**No-Strikeout Night:** First career start without a strikeout. Lasted 4.1 innings against Texas A&M Corpus Christi (3/9). Allowed five runs on four hits and five walks. Walked and hit a batter before being pulled with one out in the fifth.

**Vs. Bama:** Racked up 11 strikeouts for the second start in a row. Kept Alabama (3/2) scoreless through five innings before a two-out double scored a runner from first in the sixth.

**Home Opener:** Tossed six-scoreless vs. Holy Cross (2/24) and struck out 11; surpassing double digits for the fourth time in his career. Scattered two hits and two walks; allowing only two runners to reach scoring position.

**2018 Opening Day:** Won on opening day for the second year in a row. Threw 86 pitches in five innings of work with seven strikeouts to beat No. 20 Indiana (2/16). Overcame an early deficit after allowing two first-inning runs.

**Regional Recap:** Held Louisville (6/3/17) scoreless through five against National Player of the Year Brendan McKay and allowed just one run in the first seven innings. Gave up two runs in the eighth before being relieved and took the loss in a winner's bracket contest.

**14-K Night:** Irvin struck out 14 batters in a six-inning start to beat Central Connecticut (3/3), 3-0. It marked the most strikeouts by a Sooner since Michael Rocha's 13 vs. Texas A&M in 2011. He struck out three in an inning in the second, fourth and sixth and struck out five in a row for the second time in his career between the fourth and fifth innings.
