THREE POINTERS

► Senior guard **Christian James** ranks fourth in the Big 12 in both scoring (16.8 points per game) and rebounding (7.7 boards). With 983 career points, James is 17 shy of becoming the 45th Sooner to eclipse 1,000 points in an Oklahoma uniform. He would also become the eighth Sooner to reach 1,000 points during the **Lon Kruger** era, joining: **Buddy Hield** (2,291), **Jordan Woodard** (1,440), **Stephen Pledger** (1,392), **Isaiah Cousins** (1,326), **Cameron Clark** (1,284), **Ryan Spangler** (1,087) and **Andrew Fitzgerald** (1,086).

► Junior forward **Kristian Doolittle** enters Wednesday's matchup coming off of a 24-point performance against TCU that included the game-winning bucket with 2.8 seconds remaining. Doolittle has been dominant through four games of conference play, boasting Big 12 averages of 15.3 points, 8.5 rebounds and 1.8 steals while shooting .537 from the field. Doolittle has scored in double figures in five of the last six games.

► The Sooners are one of only three Big 12 teams who are undefeated at home this season. OU has won 21 of its last 23 games inside Lloyd Noble Center and 23 of its last 25 "home" games (includes victories in OKC and Tulsa). The Sooners have won seven straight games at the LNC, last losing at home on Feb. 17, 2018 to Texas.

GAME OVERVIEW

Jumping three spots in the latest AP Top 25 poll, **No. 20/19 Oklahoma (13-3, 2-2 Big 12)** remains at home when it hosts **RV/RV Kansas State (12-4, 2-2 Big 12)** on Wednesday at Lloyd Noble Center. The Wildcats, picked to finish second in the Big 12 in the league's preseason poll, expect to come into Norman with a healthy roster after being without Big 12 Preseason Player of the Year **Dean Wade** for six recent games. The Sooners also aim to be at full strength as senior center **Jamuni McNeace** returned to the starting lineup in Saturday's win over No. 25 TCU. Oklahoma and K-State are two of the most experienced teams in the Big 12, as OU boasted a league-high average age of 21.1 on opening night while K-State's was close behind at 20.4. The Wildcats returned all of their starters from the 2017-18 squad that reached the Elite Eight. The Big 12 matchup will air on the Sooner Radio Network (107.7 FM The Franchise in Oklahoma City; KTBZ 1430 AM in Tulsa; Tune In Radio App) with **Toby Rowland** and **Kevin Henry** announcing. **Mark Neely** and **Chris Spatola** will call the action on ESPN2. Fans with proper cable verification can also stream the game on the Watch ESPN app.

SERIES HISTORY: OKLAHOMA VS. KANSAS STATE

- The Sooners lead the all-time series, 108-99, and hold a 63-27 lead over the Wildcats in Norman. The Sooners have won four of their last five contests with K-State in Norman. The home team has won the last seven meetings.
- OU head coach **Lon Kruger** is 6-8 against his alma mater while coaching the Sooners.
- Kruger played for Kansas State from 1970-74 and was named the Big Eight Player of the Year in 1973 and 1974. He later coached the Wildcats from 1986-90, racking up an 81-46 (.638) record. Each of his K-State squads qualified for the NCAA Tournament, and the 1988 team was one of the best in the school's history with 24 wins and a trip to the Elite Eight. Kruger's No. 12 hangs in the rafters of Bramlage Coliseum.

- In the most recent meeting, the Sooners topped Kansas State, 86-77, at Lloyd Noble Center on Feb. 27, 2018. The Sooners shot 29-of-55 (.527) from the field and sunk 11 3-pointers to outpace the Wildcats.

- **Trae Young** led the Sooners with 28 points on 7-of-11 shooting and went 8-of-10 from behind the arc. **Christian James** added 15 points and three steals.

- Oklahoma scored 22 points off the bench, led by **Brady Manek** with 10 points.

- After surrendering 16 made 3-pointers to Kansas earlier in the week, the Sooner defense responded by holding Kansas State to 4-of-21 shooting from 3-point range.

NEXT UP: TEXAS

- The Sooners hit the road for consecutive rivalry games in hostile territory. Oklahoma faces Texas on Saturday at 7 p.m. CT inside Frank Erwin Center on Longhorn Network. Oklahoma leads the all-time series, 54-39, with UT holding a narrow lead (22-18) for games played in Austin.

- The Sooners are 7-7 against Texas under **Lon Kruger**. The Longhorns have won four of the past five meetings.

- After facing the Longhorns on Saturday, the Sooners then travel to Stillwater on Wednesday, Jan. 23 to face Oklahoma State. This is just the fourth time in program history that the Sooners have played on the road against Texas and OSU in consecutive games.

► In the Sooners' first home top-25 matchup of the season, the Sooners snuck past No. 25 TCU on a game-winner from **Kristian Doolittle** with 2.8 seconds remaining. The back-and-forth battle featured 21 lead changes.

► Doolittle racked up 24 points and 10 rebounds, his second highest point total of his career. Doolittle scored 20 of his points in the second half on 7-of-8 shooting.

► The Sooners saw a significant turnaround between the first and second half. TCU shot .405 from the field in the first frame and entered the break with a 53-37 lead. The Sooners held the Horned Frogs to .267 shooting in the second. Offensively, Oklahoma shot .438 in the first half and .565 in the second.

► Additionally, OU was out-rebounded 30-14 in the first half but flipped the script in the second, winning the rebound battle by a 22-12 clip.

► Oklahoma turned the ball over only nine times – its lowest turnover total since Nov. 23 against Dayton (eight).

► **Christian James** stuffed the stat sheet with 15 points, eight rebounds, four assists and a career-high four steals.

QUICK HITS

► Tonight's matchup with Kansas State, paired with Saturday's win over TCU, marks the first two game stretch this season where OU plays back-to-back games at Lloyd Noble Center.

► Oklahoma is the only school in the country with a win over a team from every major conference (Power Five + Big East).

► The Sooners are 11-1 when outrebounding their opponents. In its 13 wins, Oklahoma is winning the rebounding margin by an average of 6.2 boards.

► OU opponents are shooting 37.7 percent from the field – the second lowest opponent field goal percentage in the conference and ninth nationally.

► Oklahoma leads the nation in defensive rebounding with 32.0 defensive boards per game. OU's 42.7 total rebounds per game rank eighth in the country.

► The Sooners have three players ranked in the top 10 in rebounding in the Big 12: **Christian James** (fourth, 7.7), **Brady Manek** (sixth, 7.4) and **Kristian Doolittle** (ninth, 6.5).

► In the months of December and January, OU is holding its foes to 60-of-218 (.275) from 3-point range - the 15th lowest in the nation during that time.

► **Christian James** failed to record a double-double in his first 104 collegiate games, but has produced at least 10 points and 10 rebounds in six of his nine games since. His six double-doubles are the second most in the Big 12.

► James also ranks fourth in the conference for made 3-point field goals (2.3 per game). He is the only Big 12 player averaging over 2.0 made 3-pointers and 7.0 rebounds.

► Sophomore forward **Brady Manek** ranks sixth in the Big 12 in rebounding with 7.4 boards per game. Manek averaged only 5.2 rebounds last season, but put on 20 pounds over the offseason to improve his physical presence in the paint. He has put together four double-doubles this season (had none his freshman year).

► Manek has scored at least 13 points in five of his last six games.

► The Sooners almost always have team success on nights that Manek is rolling. During his career, OU is 20-6 when Manek scores in double figures, 12-1 when he scores at least 15 points and 8-0 when he hit four or more 3-pointers.

► Freshman guard **Jamal Bieniemy** has dished out 12 assists off the bench over his last three games. The only scholarship freshman on the Oklahoma roster, Bieniemy boasts an assist/turnover ratio of 3.13. He is just outside the conference and national rankings, which require at least 3.0 assists per game (Bieniemy averages 2.9). Despite only scoring 3.5 points per game, Bieniemy contributes with his composure as a ball handler/distributor and as one of the toughest defenders in the Sooner lineup.

► Graduate guard **Miles Reynolds** continues to make the most of his lone season with the Sooners, earning Big 12 Newcomer of the Week for games played Dec. 17-25. Reynolds averaged 12.0 points, 4.5 rebounds and 3.0 assists in Oklahoma's two most recent wins (Creighton and at Northwestern) to earn the honor for the first time. Reynolds is Oklahoma's third-leading scorer with season averages of 10.6 points, 2.9 rebound and 1.4 assists. He has reached double-digit scoring in six of his last nine outings.

► Graduate point guard **Aaron Calixte** ranks ninth in the conference in assists with 3.3 dimes per game. Calixte is averaging 8.9 points per game and has totaled 1,2567 points in his career (1,125 came at Maine).

► The Sooners have completely shifted their style of play from 2017-18 to 2018-19. Head coach **Lon Kruger** has shown the flexibility to adjust his style of play to the personnel on his roster. Last season, the Sooners played a fast-tempo, high-scoring style through national rookie of the year **Trae Young**. As the first player to lead the country in scoring and assists, Young drove the Sooners offense to score 84.9 points per game – the fifth most of any team last season and the eighth most in program history. The Sooners' 2017-18 tempo was the second fastest among major-conference teams with an average possession of only 14.0 seconds. Due to the speed of play and emphasis on free-flowing offense, the Sooners gave up an average of 81.7 points per game on the defensive end.

► This season, the Sooners are focusing much more on the defensive side – using their athleticism and length to force opponents deep into the shot clock and showing improvement in contesting shots. OU opponents are averaging 66.7 points per game and shooting 37.7 percent from the field (ranks second in the Big 12, ninth in the nation).

► Oklahoma's defense has been especially disruptive late in the game. In OU's 13 wins, its opponents are shooting a combined 33.0 percent (25.0 percent from 3) in the final 15 minutes of the game.

► OU has held its opponent to 60 or fewer points in four games.

► The Sooners have held their opponents to 30 or fewer points in the first half on six occasions this season (did so zero times last season).

► OU opponents have shot under 32 percent in five games this season.

DIFFERENT GUY EVERY NIGHT

► Oklahoma head coach **Lon Kruger** has said all season that for the Sooners to be successful, they'll need contributions from different guys each night. The Sooners have seen just that through 16 games as their roster features six players averaging at least six points.

► Eight of the nine Sooners in Kruger's main rotation have at least three games of 10-or-more points.

► The Sooners have had at least three players reach double-digit scoring in all 13 of their wins. Oklahoma is averaging 3.5 players in double figures per game.

► Four different Sooners have led the team in scoring over OU's last seven games.

ZERO HAS BEEN THE HERO

► Senior guard **Christian James** has been the Sooners' go-to scorer through the first two months of the season. James entered the season as Oklahoma's top returning scorer (averaged 11.9 points per game in 2017-18) and has shown improvement in nearly all assets of his game. Through 16 games, James has scored at least 10 points in all but one contest – including four games of reaching 20 points.

► James failed to produce a double-double in his first 104 collegiate games, but has totalled at least 10 points and 10 rebounds in six of the nine games since.

► With an average of 16.8 points per game, James is fourth in the Big 12 scoring race. Seeing a Sooner on top of the conference's scoring list is nothing new for Oklahoma, as an OU player has led the Big 12 in scoring in three of the previous four seasons (Trae Young in 2017-18; Buddy Hield in 2015-16 and 2014-15).

► While playing in Battle 4 Atlants, James averaged 19.0 points (shooting .500), 4.7 rebounds and went 11-of-23 (.478) from 3-point range to help lead OU to a 2-1 showing. His 57 total points at Battle 4 Atlantis were the second most among participating players and aided him in being named to the event's all-tournament team.

TOUGH SCHEDULING...AGAIN

► In each of the past three seasons, ESPN's College Basketball Power Index has ranked the Sooners' strength of schedule as one of the top-five toughest in the country, and the Sooners have another chance to add to that in 2018-19, facing a gruelling double round-robin schedule in the Big 12 along with non-conference matchups against Florida, Wisconsin, Dayton, Wichita State, USC, Creighton, Northwestern and Vanderbilt.

► Eight of OU's nine Big 12 opponents (Baylor, Kansas, Kansas State, Oklahoma State, TCU, Texas, Texas Tech and West Virginia) qualified for the 2018 NCAA Tournament or NIT.

SENIOR-HEAVY SOONERS

► Last season's Sooner squad was one of the youngest teams in both the Big 12 and the country. With nine freshmen and sophomores and only one senior, Oklahoma was the second least-experienced team in the conference, according to KenPom.com. The analytics website's formula, based on age and collegiate playing experience, ranked the Sooners 304 out of 351 Division I teams in experience. It will be a different story for Oklahoma this season, as its roster now features eight seniors or graduate students and only one scholarship freshman. Using the same KenPom experience metric, Oklahoma is No. 24 in experience this season and No. 1 among teams from major conferences.

► Through the combination of time and targeting experienced transfers in recruiting, the Sooners now boast the most seniors and graduates of any team in the Big 12. With seven more seniors/graduates than 2017-18, Oklahoma owns the largest-known increase of seniors in NCAA Division I this season.

► The Sooners' average age on opening night in 2017 was 19.9. On the day of OU's 2018 season opener (Nov. 9), the Oklahoma roster was an average age of 21.1 and the oldest in the Big 12.

► **Christian James, Rashard Odomes** and **Jamuni McNeace** form the core group of OU seniors, as all three have spent at least three years in the Sooners' program. The trio combines for 312 games of collegiate experience and 130 starts. Both James and Odomes have been consistent members of OU's starting lineup over the past three seasons, while McNeace continued to see his role expanded as the 2017-18 season progressed. James' 11.9 points per game last season are the most among returning players while McNeace led Sooner returners in rebounds (5.4) and blocked shots (1.4). With a 7-foot-4 wingspan and one of the most athletic builds on the team, McNeace is gearing towards having a breakout senior season as the Sooners' starting center.

► Oklahoma also installed significant experience and leadership into its roster through the addition of two graduate transfer guards: **Aaron Calixte** and **Miles Reynolds**. An experienced point guard from the University of Maine, Calixte averaged 16.9 points per game and shot 61-of-158 (.386) from 3-point range in 2017-18. Calixte faces the challenge of filling OU's point guard role, left open by **Trae Young**'s top-five selection in the 2018 NBA Draft, but will rely on his own experience at the position along with veteran players surrounding him.

► Reynolds joins the Sooners after two seasons at Pacific, where he scored 13.3 points a game last season. The guard has experience at both the point guard position and playing off the ball and aims to lend a veteran voice to the court and locker room. In the team's annual player poll, Reynolds' teammates voted him the best vocal leader and one of OU's best leaders by example.

► The Sooner seniors also feature JUCO transfer **Ty Lazenby**, now in his second year at OU, and walk-ons **Patrick Geha** and **Luke Stephenson**.

THE OTHER STAR FRESHMAN

► Last season, freshman sensation **Trae Young** catapulted himself into the national spotlight by becoming the first college player to lead the country in points and assists. While Young's dominating success garnished the headlines, fellow freshman **Brady Manek** quietly put together a solid rookie season of his own. The forward ranked in the top 10 among Big 12 freshmen in points (10.2), rebounds (5.2), blocks (0.7), 3-point field goal percentage (.383) and made 3-pointers (59). Manek's 312 points were the 12th-most by a freshman in OU history and his 59 3-pointers rank fourth-most ever by a Sooner rookie. He was one of three Big 12 freshmen to average over 10 points and 5 rebounds and one of only nine Division I freshmen to produce at least 160 rebounds and 50 3-pointers over the 2017-18 season.

► Manek proved to be a crucial component in the Sooners' winning recipe. In Oklahoma's 18 victories last season, Manek averaged 12.4 points and 5.1 rebounds while shooting 46-of-91 (.505) from 3-point range. OU was 11-4 when Manek scored in double figures and 7-0 when he hit four or more 3-pointers.

► Now entering his sophomore season, Manek will continue to be a key piece for the Sooners to succeed. He is one of two returning Sooners to average double-digit scoring in 2017-18 and his 26 starts are the second most among returners.

► Manek displayed a strong start to his sophomore season. Entering the year with no career double-doubles and only one game of over 10 rebounds, Manek produced double-doubles in each of his first three games as a sophomore. The forward became the first Sooner to open a season with three straight double-doubles since **Blake Griffin** in 2008-09.

IT'S NOT WHERE YOU START...

► Oklahoma was voted eighth in the Big 12 Conference's 2018-19 preseason poll. OU has finished as well or better in the conference standings than predicted in five of its seven previous seasons under Kruger. Kruger's OU teams have surpassed their win total from each subsequent season in six of the last seven years.

► With **Trae Young**'s selection as the fifth overall pick in 2018 NBA Draft, he became the fourth Sooner to be drafted in the Kruger era and the third OU guard to hear his name called on draft night in the past three years. Over the past 10 seasons, Oklahoma boasts seven NBA Draft selections, including three lottery picks.

Blake Griffin was selected as the No. 1 overall pick in 2009 and **Buddy Hield** was taken with the sixth choice in 2016.

► OU is the only school with multiple guards (Hield and Young) selected in the top six over the last three NBA Drafts.

► Oklahoma and Duke are the only schools with multiple top-six picks over the last three drafts.

► Griffin, Hield and Young were all drafted in the top six of their respective drafts. Over the past decade, only Kentucky (eight), Duke (six) and Kansas (four) have more top-six draft picks than Oklahoma.

► Over the last three drafts, Oklahoma has as many top-10 draft picks (two) as the rest of the Big 12 combined (Kansas' Josh Jackson in 2017 as Texas' Mo Bamba in 2018).

► Oklahoma's three top-10 NBA Draft picks in the last 10 years are the second most in the Big 12 and fifth most in the nation during that stretch.

► The NBA trio of Griffin, Hield and Young have gotten off to a hot start in the 2018-19 season. Oklahoma and Kentucky are the only schools with three NBA players who averaged over 18 points in the month of October.

► Young was named the Eastern Conference Rookie of the Month for October/November after leading all first-year players in the East with 15.6 points and 7.6 assists per game during first two months of the season, compiling an NBA rookie-best seven point/assist double-doubles. He strung together three consecutive contests with at least 10 points and 10 assists from Nov. 1-6, becoming the first rookie with three straight point/assist doubles within his first 10 career games since John Wall in 2010.

► In total, Oklahoma has seen 49 Sooners selected into the NBA Draft, including 10 first-round picks and seven lottery selections.

MARCH TO MADNESS

► Oklahoma aims to continue its trend of dancing in March under head coach Lon Kruger. Since 2013 (Kruger's second season at OU), the Sooners have reached the NCAA Tournament on five occasions. Oklahoma is one of only three Big 12 programs to have its name called on five of the last six Selections Sundays. Under Kruger, the Sooners have reached the Sweet 16 twice along with a trip to the 2016 Final Four.

► Oklahoma has reached the Big Dance 26 times in the past 35 years. The Sooners' 26 NCAA Tournament appearances since 1984 are the 10th most in the nation during that span, behind only Kansas, Duke, North Carolina, Arizona, Connecticut, Kentucky, Michigan State, Syracuse and UCLA.

KRUGER INKS TOP-10 RECRUITING CLASS

► Oklahoma men's basketball head coach **Lon Kruger** announced the Sooners' highly-anticipated 2019 recruiting class on Nov. 15. The Sooners' recruiting class is listed in the top 10 nationally by both ESPN (No. 8) and 247Sports (No. 9) and is ranked No. 11 by Rivals. Both ESPN and 247 also list Oklahoma's incoming class as the best in the Big 12.

► The class is comprised of three high school seniors all ranked in the top 100 nationally along with two experienced junior college transfers. Making up the signing class are guards **De'Vion Harmon** (Denton, Texas) and **Alondes Williams** (River Grove, Ill.), forwards **Jalen Hill** (Las Vegas, Nev.) and **Victor Iwuakor** (Sulphur Springs, Texas) and center **Corbin Merritt** (Tallahassee, Fla.).

THEM BOYS UP TO SOMETHING...

► Jordan Brand continues to expand both on the court and on the field. On Nov. 9, 2017, the brand welcomed the University of Oklahoma to the family, making it just the fifth collegiate basketball program and third football program to represent the Jumpman. The Sooners' uniforms are now in their first season of featuring the iconic Jumpman logo. The partnership includes the football team and the men's and women's basketball teams. Oklahoma joins Florida, Michigan and North Carolina as the only schools to wear the Jumpman on its football and basketball uniforms.

COACHING LEGEND

► In his 33 seasons as a collegiate head coach, **Lon Kruger** has built his career on the foundation of hard work, humility, integrity and service. From becoming the first Division I coach to guide five different schools to the NCAA Tournament to his dedicated work with Coaches vs. Cancer, Kruger has established a reputation as a genuine leader, winning coach and community champion. The John R. Wooden Award has recognized Kruger's accolades both on and off the court by selecting him as this season's recipient of its Legends of Coaching Award. The honor was announced in October by Nan Wooden, daughter of Hall of Fame coach John Wooden.

► Created in 1999, the Legends of Coaching honor recognizes college coaches who exemplify Coach Wooden's high standard of coaching success and personal integrity. The honorees are selected based on character, success on the court, graduation rate of student-athletes in their basketball program, coaching philosophy and identification with the goals of the John R. Wooden Award. As this year's recipient, Kruger joins a prestigious list of previous honorees that includes Geno Auriemma, Jim Boeheim, Jim Calhoun, Billy Donovan, Tom Izzo, Mike Krzyzewski, Lute Olson, Bill Self, Dean Smith, Pat Summit and Roy Williams. Kruger will be awarded the honor during the fifth annual ESPN College Basketball Awards on April 12, 2019.

► Entering his eighth season as the Sooners' head coach, Kruger is the first Division I coach to take five different schools to the NCAA Tournament and the only coach to win an NCAA Tournament game with five different programs. In 2015 he became the first coach since the NCAA Tournament expanded to 64 teams in 1985 to take four programs to the Sweet 16 or beyond. He has reached the Final Four in 1994 (Florida) and 2016 (Oklahoma) and owns the 10th-most victories (619) among active Division I head coaches.

► Kruger's success at Oklahoma has been evident throughout the country, taking a Sooners team that went 27-36 (.429) in the two seasons prior to his arrival to reaching the Final Four just five years into the job. Since 2011, Kruger has racked up five NCAA Tournament appearances, coached four NBA Draft picks, a national player of the year (**Buddy Hield**), a national freshman of the year (**Trae Young**) and was named the 2014 AP Big 12 Coach of the Year.

► Kruger has also shown a passion for community leadership, particularly in the fight against cancer. This summer, he was named council chair of Coaches vs. Cancer, a nationwide program partnering with the American Cancer Society and the NABC. Kruger has been a member of the Coaches vs. Cancer Council since 2007 and has been a longtime supporter of the American Cancer Society. As founder and chairman of the Coaches vs. Cancer Las Vegas Golf Classic, Kruger's leadership has helped the event raise over \$3.5 million over the last 11 years.

GRIFFIN GIVES BACK

► The Griffin Family Performance Center is an 18,400-gross-square foot training center located just south of the men's and women's basketball's two existing practice gyms. The performance center, which opened this past summer, was designed to help enhance the strength and conditioning training facilities for both men's and women's programs, as well other Sooner student-athletes. The center was primarily financed through a generous gift from Oklahoma alum **Blake Griffin** – the 2009 consensus national player of the year and the No. 1 overall pick in that year's NBA Draft.

LON KRUGER

18 NCAA TOURNAMENT APPEARANCES • TWO FINAL FOURS • FIVE SWEET SIXTEENS
ONLY COACH TO LEAD FIVE DIFFERENT PROGRAMS TO AN NCAA TOURNAMENT WIN
NINTH MOST WINS AMONG ACTIVE DIVISION I HEAD COACHES

In his 33rd season as a collegiate head coach, Lon Kruger has built his career on the foundation of hard work, humility, integrity and service. From becoming the first Division I coach to guide five different schools to the NCAA Tournament to his dedicated work with Coaches vs. Cancer, Kruger has established a reputation as a genuine leader, winning coach and community champion.

Kruger is in his eighth campaign as head coach at Oklahoma. After inheriting a program that went 27-36 (.429) in the two seasons prior to his arrival, Kruger has coached the Sooners to a 153-94 (.619) record in his eight years in Norman and has reached the NCAA Tournament in five of the past six seasons.

One of Kruger's signature accomplishments has been the rebuilding stamp he's put on college basketball programs throughout his career. He was the first Division I coach to take five different schools to the NCAA Tournament and is the only coach to win an NCAA Tournament game with five programs. In 2015, he became the first and only coach since the NCAA Tournament expanded to 64 teams in 1985 to take four programs to the Sweet 16 or beyond. He is one of only three head coaches to ever lead four schools to multiple NCAA Tournament wins.

Entering the 2018-19 season with a career record of 619-395 (.611), Kruger boasts the 10th-most career wins among active coaches and is the 33rd head coach to win 600 Division I games in the history of college basketball. Kruger owns a 20-18 record in NCAA Tournament games and has compiled 16 20-plus-win seasons, including nine in his last 13 years.

Oklahoma wasn't the first rapid turnaround under Kruger. When Kruger took over the Florida job in 1990, the Gators were coming off of a 7-21 season. Four years into the role, Kruger guided UF to the 1994 Final Four. Kruger is one of just two head coaches (also Rick Pitino with Kentucky and Louisville) to inherit two teams coming off a sub-.500 year and take both to the Final Four within the first five seasons as head coach.

A staple of the NCAA postseason, Kruger has taken five different schools to the Big Dance. His collegiate teams have made postseason appearances in 22 of the last 29 years. He has guided teams to 18 NCAA Tournaments, five Sweet 16s and two Final Fours.

As hard as Kruger works to achieve excellence on the hardwood, he is just as committed to his role as a community leader in the fight against cancer. Kruger is in his first year as council chair of Coaches vs. Cancer, a nationwide program partnering with the American Cancer Society and the National Association of Basketball Coaches. Kruger has been a member of the Coaches vs. Cancer Council since 2007 and has been a longtime supporter of the American Cancer Society.

Kruger's accolades both on and off the court have earned him multiple recognitions over recent years. In 2017, Kruger was honored with the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Metropolitan Award for long and outstanding service to men's college basketball.

Before the start of the 2018-19 campaign, the John R. Wooden Award selected him as the 2019 recipient of its Legends of Coaching Award. Created in 1999, the Legends of Coaching honor recognizes college coaches who exemplify Coach Wooden's high standard of coaching success and personal integrity. The honorees are selected based on character, success on the court, graduation rate of student-athletes in their basketball program, coaching philosophy and identification with the goals of the John R. Wooden Award.

Kruger rebuilt the Sooners upon his arrival in Norman. His 111 wins in the first five seasons are the second most through the first five seasons of coaching at OU (Billy Tubbs went 115-49 from 1980-85). He was the first coach in OU history to win six NCAA tournament games within his first five seasons. Following the 2013-14 season, he was voted the AP Big 12 Coach of the Year.

Under Kruger, Sooner players have earned First-Team All-Big 12 selections on four occasions and racked up 20 Academic All-Big 12 honors. Buddy Hield, who played four seasons for Kruger (2012-16), was named the winner of the 2016 Wooden Award, Naismith Trophy and the Oscar Robertson Trophy as the national player of the year (first consensus player of the year for OU since Blake Griffin in 2009). Hield was named Big 12 Player of the Year in both 2015 and 2016 (second player in conference history to win the award twice) and exited OU as the Big 12's all-time leading scorer.

This past season, Kruger mentored Trae Young – the first player in college basketball history to lead the country in both points and assists. Oklahoma's 11th Consensus All-America First Team selection, Young set program, conference and NCAA records throughout his lone season with the Sooners.

Four Sooners have been drafted into the NBA during Kruger's tenure, including two in the top six. Young was taken as the fifth overall pick in the 2018 NBA Draft while Hield was selected as the sixth overall choice 2016. Isaiah Cousins (2016) and Romero Osby (2013) were chosen in the second round of their respective drafts.
