THREE POINTERS

- Two seasons ago, **Kristan Doolittle** put on a career performance of 29 points and 10 rebounds against Texas in Austin. A freshman at the time, Doolittle showed what he was capable of producing. He scored in double figures only three more times that season and never as a sophomore. Recently, Doolittle has gotten into a rhythm and is showing off the flash of talent OU saw in him two years ago in Austin. Entering tonight's game, Doolittle has scored in double digits in five of his last seven games, including a 24-point performance that featured the game-winning shot over TCU on Saturday. Five games into conference play, Doolittle is second on the team in both scoring and rebounding in Big 12 games with 13.6 points and 7.8 boards.
- ▶ Senior guard **Christian James** is the newest member of Oklahoma's 1,000-point club after scoring 20 against Kansas State on Wednesday. He is the eighth Sooner coached by Lon Kruger to score 1,000 points in an OU uniform and the 45th in program history. With 1,003 career points, James ranks 43rd on OU's all-time scoring list. Teammate **Aaron Calixte** also boasts over 1,000 career points with 1,273 points in his career (1,125 came at Maine). **Miles Reynolds** is approaching the milestone with 922 (767 came at Saint Louis and Pacific).
- ▶ Oklahoma is coming of a home loss against Kansas State on Wednesday. The Sooners are 3-0 in games after losses this season. In their three previous "bounce back" games (Dayton, Oklahoma State, TCU), the Sooners limited opponents to 33.7 percent shooting and winning by an average of 7.7 points.
