HEAD COACH SKIP JOHNSON

In his two seasons in Norman, Skip Johnson has made an immediate impact on the Oklahoma baseball program. He was named the 10th head coach in program history in June 2017 after serving one year as the Sooners' pitching coach.

The OU pitching staffs in Johnson's two seasons have posted two of the top five strikeout totals in program history and lowered the team ERA each season.

In 2018, Johnson coached OU to the program's 38th NCAA Regional appearance and posted the program's highest win total (38) since 2013. The Sooners reached the finals of the Tallahassee Regional, and set a school record with 608 strikeouts. Nine players were drafted, including five in the first 10 rounds.

In 2017, Oklahoma pitchers surrendered the fewest home runs in the Big 12 Conference in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. The Sooners' 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions.

Prior to coming to Oklahoma, Johnson spent a 25-year coaching career in the state of Texas, including the most recent 10 years as an assistant and associate head coach at the University of Texas.

Prior to his time in Austin, Johnson was the head coach for 13 years at Navarro College of the NJCAA's Texas Eastern Athletic Conference. From 1994-2006, he guided the Bulldogs to 13 NJCAA Regionals, nine TEAC championships and four regional titles while compiling 450 wins.

Johnson has also mentored a number of players outside of those he coached at Navarro and UT. Johnson regularly works with three-time Cy Young Award winner Clayton Kershaw of the Los Angeles Dodgers and Homer Bailey of the Kansas City Royals. He's also worked with Chris Davis of the Baltimore Orioles, among others.

A standout baseball player at Denton High School, Johnson began his collegiate playing career at Ranger (Texas) College. After a two-year career there, Johnson moved on to play baseball at the University of North Texas in 1988 before the school dropped its baseball program. He completed his collegiate playing career at UT-Pan American, lettering for the Broncs in 1989 and receiving his bachelor's degree in 1990. Johnson earned a master's degree in education from UT-Tyler in 1993.

A native of Denton, Texas, Johnson and his wife, Cathy, have two sons, Tyler and Garrett.

About the Sooners...

- OU is in its second year under the direction of head coach **Skip Johnson**. Johnson holds a 42-25 record as head coach, and led the Sooners to an NCAA regional appearance last season.
- 0U pitchers have posted a 1.50 ERA in four games so far this season, ranking 14th nationally. The group has allowed six earned runs, scattered 30 hits and nine walks and totaled 32 strikeouts in 36.0 innings.
- Through the first week, sophomore Levi Prater is 1-0 with a 1.42 ERA, freshman Ben Abram is 1-0 with a 1.80 ERA, sophomore Cade Cavalli is 0-0 with a 2.08 ERA and junior Nathan Wiles is 1-0 with a 2.57 ERA.
- The OU bullpen has allowed one run and tallied 16 strikeouts in 13.1 innings of work.
- Sophomore catcher **Justin Mitchell** leads the team with a .444 batting average and four runs scored while junior catcher **Brady Lindsly** is hitting .333 with two doubles and two runs. Junior second baseman **Conor McKenna**, sophomore first baseman **Tyler Hardman** and freshman center fielder **Milan Walla** each have a team-high three RBIs.
- Eight players have made their OU debuts this season: freshman pitchers **Ben Abram**, **Jaret Godman** and **Wyatt Olds**, junior transfers **Conor McKenna** and **Jason Ruffcorn**, sophomore transfers **Tanner Tredaway** and **Jordan Vujovich** and freshman outfielder **Milan Walla**. Walla recorded his first career hit in his initial at bat on Friday.
- McKenna, Ware and Zaragoza have combined for 50 fielding assists and 12 putouts. The Sooners have turned four double plays, including two of the 6-3 variety by Zaragoza.

About the Toreros...

- San Diego is coached by Rich Hill, who is in his 20th season at the school. He has posted a 647-445-4 record at USD.
- San Diego swept a three-game series over Wagner last weekend, defeated Long Beach State 4-0 Tuesday and lost to Arizona State 12-2 on Wednesday.
- The Toreros are hitting .316 as a team, led by Max Jung-Goldberg (.538 batting average), Kevin Collard (.500), Tora Otsuka (.429), Caleb Ricketts (.375) and Cody Hefferis (.364 and seven RBIs).
- Friday starter Chris Murphy struck out six, walked five and allowed one hit in 5.0 scoreless innings in his first start.

About the Aztecs...

- San Diego State is coached by Mark Martinez, who is in his fifth season as head coach. He has posted a 146-104 record at SDSU.
- The Aztecs won two of three games from San Francisco last weekend, winning 8-4 and 6-3 around a 9-8 loss in the second game. SDSU then beat UC Irvine 9-3 on Tuesday.
- San Diego State is hitting .326, led by Brian Leonhardt's .500 batting average and seven RBIs. Julian Escobedo is batting .467 with nine RBIs and six runs scored.
- Saturday starter Harrison Pyatt pitched 4.0 innings in his first start and allowed two runs on four hits with five strikeouts.

About the Titans...

- Cal State Fullerton is coached by Rick Vanderhook, who is in his eighth season as head coach of the Titans. He has posted a 273-153 record at CSF.
- The Titans played at the MLB Collegiate Tournament in Talking Stick, Ariz., last weekend and defeated TCU 2-0 and Virginia 6-5, and fell 14-9 to Vanderbilt.
- Fullerton is hitting .271 as a team, led by a pair of .400 hitters in Jacob Pavletich (three RBIs and three runs scored) and Jackson Lynch (two RBIs and two runs).
- Sunday starter Michael Knorr allowed two earned runs on four hits with two strikeouts and three walks in 4.0 innings last weekend.

1951 AND 1994 NATIONAL CHAMPIONS

The OU and San Diego Series...

- Oklahoma and San Diego have played six times. OU leads the series, 4-2.
- The Sooners won 7-1 in 2011 in San Diego's tournament.
- The last five meetings have been played in San Diego. Oklahoma is 3-2 in those games.

The OU and San Diego State Series...

- Oklahoma and San Diego State have played 10 times. OU leads the series, 9-1.
- The Sooners won 4-0 and 13-5 in 2011 at San Diego's tournament.
- Oklahoma has won seven in a row in the series, and is 7-1 against SDSU in San Diego.

The OU and Cal State Fullerton Series...

- Oklahoma and Cal State Fullerton have played eight times. The series is tied, 4-4.
- Fullerton won the last meeting, 7-0, in 2005 at the Coca-Cola Classic Spring Tournament in Surprise, Ariz.
- The Sooners won the previous two meetings, 4-3 in 2000 in Oklahoma City, and 5-1 (10 innings) in 2004 in Fullerton.

Replaced Production...

- Oklahoma replaced significant production both offensively and on the mound from 2018 for the 2019 season.
- Included were all three outfield positions held by juniors drafted in 2018, a four-year senior at second base and a total of eight pitchers.
- Oklahoma replaced 60 percent of its innings pitched (339 of 570), 67 percent of its starts (42 of 63), 61 percent of its strikeouts (370 of 608) and 63 percent of wins on the mound (24 of 38).
- Offensively, the Sooners replaced 56 percent of RBIs (197 of 354) and runs scored (215 of 386), 34 of their 47 home runs and 51 percent of hits (300 of 593).

The Newcomers...

- Oklahoma has 19 newcomers to its roster in 2019. Nine of those players are four-year or junior college transfers, and 10 are freshmen
- The new class is versatile and athletic, and several players have the ability to play multiple positions on the field. The group is comprised of eight pitchers, seven players who can play infield, six who can play outfield and one who can catch.
- Two newcomers call Oklahoma home, eight come from Texas, two from California, and one each from Arkansas, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Minnesota, Nevada and Ontario.
- Of the transfers, three began their careers at four-year schools: **Brady Harlan** (Texas), **Jason Ruffcorn** (Texas A&M) and **Jordan Vujovich** (Oregon). Harlan and Ruffcorn transferred directly to OU, while Vujovich came via Delta College in California. Six others came to OU from junior colleges.

Big 12 Preseason Honors...

- Senior Brylie Ware and sophomore Levi Prater were named to the All-big 12 Preseason Team in a vote by the league's head coaches.
- With two preseason selections, Oklahoma tied for the thirdmost preseason all-conference honorees. Texas Tech had five selections, Baylor had four and Texas also had two, while Oklahoma State, Kansas, Kansas State, TCU and West Virginia each had one player on the preseason Big 12 team.
- The Sooners were picked to finish seventh in the preseason coaches poll.

Opening Day Starters...

Right-hander **Cade Cavalli** started on the mound for the Sooners on opening day. He became the fifth sophomore to get the ball in game one in the last eight seasons. He also became the fifth consecutive righty to start on opening day following three years in a row of lefties getting the nod.

Season Openers...

Since 1962, Oklahoma is 39-19 on opening day and 26-3 when playing the first game of the season at home, including 25-2 at L. Dale Mitchell Park. All-time in home openers, the Sooners are 51-6 going back to 1962, including 35-2 at L. Dale Mitchell.

Oklahoma is Home...

The OU roster features 11 players from within the state's borders and nine from Texas. This is the third straight year the Sooners have featured more homegrown players on the roster than from Texas. Prior to the 2017 season, 2006 was the last year OU had more homegrown talent than Texas born players with 13 Sooners claiming Oklahoma as home.

2018 MLB Draft...

- Oklahoma had nine players selected in the 2018 Major League Basebal First-Year Player Draft.
- Five players were selected in the first 10 rounds, including three top-five round draft picks.
- Outfielder Kyler Murray was selected ninth overall by the Oakland Athletics, outfielder Steele Walker was drafted in the seoond round (46th overall) by the Chicago White Sox and pitcher Jake Irvin was taken in the fourth round (131st overall) by the Washington Nationals.
- Pitcher Austin Hansen was selected in the eighth round by the Houston Astros and outfielder Cade Harris was taken in the 10th round by the Colorado Rockies. Additionally, pitchers Kyle Tyler (20th round, Los Angeles Angels), Lane Ramsey (23rd round, White Sox), Devon Perez (26th round, White Sox) and Connor Berry (31st round, Boston Red Sox) were selected in the draft.
