Leading Off

- Oklahoma began the season 6-0 for the first time since 2013.
- OU began a stretch of 10 games in 12 games on Friday in San Diego. The stretch continues with seven games in eight days beginning on Tuesday. That run concludes March 5 at Dallas Baptist.
- A pair of OU players earned Big 12 honors this week. **Tyler Hardman** was named the Big 12 Player of the Week and **Nathan Wiles** was named the Big 12 Pitcher of the Week. It was the first weekly honors of the season for the Sooners.
- The Sooners have allowed just 17 runs this season and posted a 1.86 ERA. OU is tied for 12th nationally in ERA. Junior **Nathan Wiles** and sophomore **Cade Cavalli** lead the way with a 1.29 and 1.59 ERA, respectively.

HEAD COACH SKIP JOHNSON

In his two full seasons in Norman, Skip Johnson has made an immediate impact on the Oklahoma baseball program. He was named the 10th head coach in program history in June 2017 after serving one year as the Sooners' pitching coach.

The OU pitching staffs in Johnson's two seasons have posted two of the top five strikeout totals in program history and lowered the team ERA each season.

In 2018, Johnson coached OU to the program's 38th NCAA Regional appearance and posted the program's highest win total (38) since 2013. The Sooners reached the finals of the Tallahassee Regional, and set a school record with 608 strikeouts. Nine players were drafted, including five in the first 10 rounds.

In 2017, Oklahoma pitchers surrendered the fewest home runs in the Big 12 Conference in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. The Sooners' 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions.

Prior to coming to Oklahoma, Johnson spent a 25-year coaching career in the state of Texas, including the most recent 10 years as an assistant and associate head coach at the University of Texas.

Prior to his time in Austin, Johnson was the head coach for 13 years at Navarro College of the NJCAA's Texas Eastern Athletic Conference. From 1994-2006, he guided the Bulldogs to 13 NJCAA Regionals, nine TEAC championships and four regional titles while compiling 450 wins.

Johnson has also mentored a number of players outside of those he coached at Navarro and UT. Johnson regularly works with three-time Cy Young Award winner Clayton Kershaw of the Los Angeles Dodgers and Homer Bailey of the Kansas City Royals. He's also worked with Chris Davis of the Baltimore Orioles, among others.

A standout baseball player at Denton High School, Johnson began his collegiate playing career at Ranger (Texas) College. After a two-year career there, Johnson moved on to play baseball at the University of North Texas in 1988 before the school dropped its baseball program. He completed his collegiate playing career at UT-Pan American, lettering for the Broncs in 1989 and receiving his bachelor's degree in 1990. Johnson earned a master's degree in education from UT-Tyler in 1993.

A native of Denton, Texas, Johnson and his wife, Cathy, have two sons, Tyler and Garrett.

Big 12 Honors...

- **Tyler Hardman** and **Nathan Wiles** were named the Big 12 Player of the Week and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, on Feb. 25.
- Hardman batted .429 with two home runs and a triple, driving in nine runs at the Tony Gwynn Legacy tournament in San Diego. His seventh-inning grand slam gave the Sooners the lead, and he added a two-run double in the ninth inning. He hit a three-run home run on Sunday against Cal State Fullerton.
- Wiles pitched 7.0 shutout innings in a 1-0 win at San Diego State Saturday night. He allowed just four hits and tied a career high with 10 strikeouts.

About the Sooners...

- OU is in its second year under the direction of head coach **Skip Johnson**. Johnson holds a 44-26 record as head coach, and led the Sooners to an NCAA regional appearance last season.
- OU is tied for 12th nationally with a 1.86 ERA. The Sooners also rank sixth with nine double plays turned. That figure includes four double plays in the game at San Diego on Friday. Hardman ranks 22nd in the nation with his 12 RBIs.
- Sophomore **Cade Cavalli** was excellent over 7.0 innings on Friday night, shutting out the Toreros after the first inning and notching seven strikeouts and allowing just four hits and one walk.
- Sophomore first baseman **Tyler Hardman** drove in nine of Oklahoma's 12 runs over the weekend. He hit two home runs a double and a triple in four games last week.
- Freshman **Ben Abram** made his first career appearance with a five-inning start against Dallas Baptist on Wednesday. He allowed just one earned run, four hits and no walks in five innings of the Sooners' 5-2 victory.
- Sophomore catcher **Justin Mitchell** went 4-for-7 at the plate and scored four runs in two starts last week. Sophomore outfielder **Jordan Vujovich** batted .333 and doubled home two runs on Sunday. Sophomore **Ledgend Smith** pitched 4.2 scoreless relief innings across three appearances last week. He allowed just one hit and two walks in those outings. Sophomore **Zack Matthews** earned his first career save in Wednesday's win over Dallas Baptist and pitched 2.0 scoreless innings in two appearances last week.

About the Golden Lions...

- Arkansas-Pine Bluff is coached by Carlos James, who is in his ninth season at the school. He led the Golden Lions to three straight SWAC Western Division Championships from 2014-16.
- UAPB is 1-6 on the season and coming off of three losses at Abilene Christian last weekend by scores of 16-7, 9-7 and 5-4.
- The Lions are hitting .263 as a team, led by Sergio Esparza's .368 batting average. Nick Kreutzer is hitting .333 with four home runs and 12 RBIs.

The OU and UAPB Series...

- Oklahoma and Arkansas-Pine Bluff have played 14 times. OU leads the series, 14-0.
- This will be the first meeting since 2014.
- All 14 meetings have been played in Norman.
- The schools first met for two games in 2005, and have played twice in 2008, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014.

Replaced Production...

- Oklahoma replaced significant production both offensively and on the mound from 2018 for the 2019 season.
- Included were all three outfield positions held by juniors drafted in 2018, a four-year senior at second base and a total of eight pitchers.
- Oklahoma replaced 60 percent of its innings pitched (339 of

570), 67 percent of its starts (42 of 63), 61 percent of its strikeouts (370 of 608) and 63 percent of wins on the mound (24 of 38).

- Offensively, the Sooners replaced 56 percent of RBIs (197 of 354) and runs scored (215 of 386), 34 of their 47 home runs and 51 percent of hits (300 of 593).

The Newcomers...

- Oklahoma has 19 newcomers to its roster in 2019. Nine of those players are four-year or junior college transfers, and 10 are freshmen.
- The new class is versatile and athletic, and several players have the ability to play multiple positions on the field. The group is comprised of eight pitchers, seven players who can play infield, six who can play outfield and one who can catch.
- Two newcomers call Oklahoma home, eight come from Texas, two from California, and one each from Arkansas, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Minnesota, Nevada and Ontario.
- Of the transfers, three began their careers at four-year schools: **Brady Harlan** (Texas), **Jason Ruffcorn** (Texas A&M) and **Jordan Vujovich** (Oregon). Harlan and Ruffcorn transferred directly to OU, while Vujovich came via Delta College in California. Six others came to OU from junior colleges.

Big 12 Preseason Honors...

- Senior Brylie Ware and sophomore Levi Prater were named to the All-Big 12 Preseason Team in a vote by the league's head coaches.
- With two preseason selections, Oklahoma tied for the third-most preseason all-conference honorees. Texas Tech had five selections, Baylor had four and Texas also had two, while Oklahoma State, Kansas, Kansas State, TCU and West Virginia each had one player on the preseason Big 12 team.
- The Sooners were picked to finish seventh in the preseason coaches poll.

Opening Day Starters...

Right-hander **Cade Cavalli** started on the mound for the Sooners on opening day. He became the fifth sophomore to get the ball in game one in the last eight seasons. He also became the fifth consecutive righty to start on opening day following three years in a row of lefties getting the nod.

Season Openers...

Since 1962, Oklahoma is 39-19 on opening day and 26-3 when playing the first game of the season at home, including 25-2 at L. Dale Mitchell Park. All-time in home openers, the Sooners are 51-6 going back to 1962, including 35-2 at L. Dale Mitchell.

Oklahoma is Home...

The OU roster features 11 players from within the state's borders and nine from Texas. This is the third straight year the Sooners have featured more homegrown players on the roster than from Texas. Prior to the 2017 season, 2006 was the last year OU had more homegrown talent than Texas born players with 13 Sooners claiming Oklahoma as home.

2018 MLB Draft...

- Oklahoma had nine players selected in the 2018 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft.
- Five players were selected in the first 10 rounds, including three top-five round draft picks.
- Outfielder **Kyler Murray** was selected ninth overall by the Oakland Athletics, outfielder **Steele Walker** was drafted in the second round (46th overall) by the Chicago White Sox and pitcher **Jake Irvin** was taken in the fourth round (131st overall) by the Washington Nationals.
- Pitcher **Austin Hansen** was selected in the eighth round by the Houston Astros and outfielder **Cade Harris** was taken in the 10th round by the Colorado Rockies. Additionally, pitchers **Kyle Tyler** (20th round, Los Angeles Angels), **Lane Ramsey** (23rd round, White Sox), **Devon Perez** (26th round, White Sox) and **Connor Berry** (31st round, Boston Red Sox) were selected in the draft.
