First Pitch...

- Oklahoma begins a four-game road swing with a contest at Dallas Baptist Wednesday in Dallas. First pitch is set for 3 p.m. at Horner Ballpark.
- The game was originally scheduled for Tuesday, but was postponed due to forecast cold temperatures in the Dallas area for Tuesday night.
- This is the second of two meetings between OU and DBU this season. The Sooners won the first meeting 4-2 in Norman on Feb. 20.
- Oklahoma and Dallas Baptist were originally scheduled to play Feb. 19 in Dallas and March 5 in Norman, but due to inclement weather in the region two weeks ago, the sites were flipped and OU and DBU played at L. Dale Mitchell Park on Feb. 20, with the return trip set for March 5 in Dallas.
- The Sooners will travel to Houston for a three-game series at Rice this weekend at Reckling Park. Game times for that series are 6:30 p.m. Friday, 2 p.m. Saturday and 1 p.m. Sunday.
- Wednesday's game will be broadcast on SportsTalk 1400AM/99.3 FM in Norman and via the TuneIn mobile app. Live video streaming will be available through DBU Patriots.com, and link to live stats can be found at SoonerSports.com.

Leading Off

- Oklahoma is 11-1 for the second time in three years. Prior to 2017 (13-1 start) – when Skip Johnson joined the Sooners as pitching coach – OU had not started a season 11-1 or better since 2013 when it also began that year 11-1.
- OU ranks fifth in the country with a 1.58 team ERA. The Sooners have allowed just 23 runs this season, 19 of which have been earned. All four OU starting pitchers boast an ERA of 1.80 or lower.
- The Sooners rank second in the country in triples (7), third in shutouts (3) and double plays (14), 17th in WHIP (1.1) and 28th in doubles (25).
- Sophomore first baseman **Tyler Hardman** ranks fifth nationally in RBIs (21), 13th in total bases (36), 23rd in home runs (4) and 28th in hits (19). Junior **Jason Ruffcorn** ranks 10th in saves (3) and 32nd in appearances (6).
- Entering the fourth week of the season, OU is batting .284 as a team and averaging 6.6 runs per game, with 25 doubles, seven triples and six home runs. The Sooners allow opponents 1.9 runs per game .211 batting average.

HEAD COACH SKIP JOHNSON

In his two full seasons in Norman, Skip Johnson has made an immediate impact on the Oklahoma baseball program. He was named the 10th head coach in program history in June 2017 after serving one year as the Sooners' pitching coach.

The OU pitching staffs in Johnson's two seasons have posted two of the top five strikeout totals in program history and lowered the team ERA each season.

In 2018, Johnson coached OU to the program's 38th NCAA Regional appearance and posted the program's highest win total (38) since 2013. The Sooners reached the finals of the Tallahassee Regional, and set a school record with 608 strikeouts. Nine players were drafted, including five in the first 10 rounds.

In 2017, Oklahoma pitchers surrendered the fewest home runs in the Big 12 Conference in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. The Sooners' 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions.

Prior to coming to Oklahoma, Johnson spent a 25-year coaching career in the state of Texas, including the most recent 10 years as an assistant and associate head coach at the University of Texas.

Prior to his time in Austin, Johnson was the head coach for 13 years at Navarro College of the NJCAA's Texas Eastern Athletic Conference. From 1994-2006, he guided the Bulldogs to 13 NJCAA Regionals, nine TEAC championships and four regional titles while compiling 450 wins.

Johnson has also mentored a number of players outside of those he coached at Navarro and UT. Johnson regularly works with three-time Cy Young Award winner Clayton Kershaw of the Los Angeles Dodgers and Homer Bailey of the Kansas City Royals. He's also worked with Chris Davis of the Baltimore Orioles, among others.

A standout baseball player at Denton High School, Johnson began his collegiate playing career at Ranger (Texas) College. After a two-year career there, Johnson moved on to play baseball at the University of North Texas in 1988 before the school dropped its baseball program. He completed his collegiate playing career at UT-Pan American, lettering for the Broncs in 1989 and receiving his bachelor's degree in 1990. Johnson earned a master's degree in education from UT-Tyler in 1993.

A native of Denton, Texas, Johnson and his wife, Cathy, have two sons, Tyler and Garrett.

Last Week...

- OU pitchers posted a 1.20 ERA in five games last week... all four starters lasted 6.0 innings in the weekend series, going 5-0 and allowing just three combined runs, 21 hits and five walks in 28.0 innings.
- Freshman **Ben Abram** went 2-0, striking out 11 batters in 10.0 innings, and allowing just two runs on eight hits and no walks last week.
- Sophomores **Cade Cavalli** and **Levi Prater** each allowed no runs in 6.0 innings in their starts.
- Junior shortstop **Brandon Zaragoza** was on fire at the plate last week, batting .550 (11 for 20) and accounting for 15 of the team's 44 runs scored in the five games. He scored seven runs and tallied eight RBIs, including a two-run single in the finale that gave OU the lead for good.

The OU and DBU Series...

- Oklahoma and Dallas Baptist have played 36 times. OU leads the series, 24-12.
- OU won the first meeting this season, 4-2, in Norman on Feb. 20.
- The Patriots have won four straight meetings in Dallas, dating back to 2012. OU last won against DBU in Dallas in 2010.
- The teams split two games last season. DBU won 5-2 in Dallas and OU won 15-3 in Norman.
- The Sooners won the first 14 meetings in the series, which was first played in 1978, then won six in row between 2007 and 2010. DBU has won 10 of the last 13 meetings.

About the Sooners...

- OU is in its second year under the direction of head coach **Skip Johnson**. Johnson is 49-26 as OU head coach, and led the Sooners to an NCAA regional appearance last season.
- Sophomore first baseman **Tyler Hardman** has hit safely in each of the last 11 games, and over the last six contests is batting .444 (12 for 27) with 12 RBIs, six runs scored, three home runs and a double.
- Hardman, junior shortstop **Brandon Zaragoza** and junior infielder **Conor McKenna** have reached base safely in 12 straight games. Sophomore outfielder **Jordan Vujovich** has reached base in six straight games. McKenna and Zaragoza each have six-game hitting streaks.
- Junior catcher **Brady Lindsly** batted .400 in two starts and hit his first home run and first triple of the season last week. Sophomore catcher **Justin Mitchell** went 5 for 10 at the plate in three games last week. Senior third baseman **Brylie Ware** hit his first home run on Friday and doubled twice last week, driving in five runs and scoring five runs. Freshman center fielder **Milan Walla** batted .364 and scored five runs last week. Senior **Ryan Madden** pitched 4.1 scoreless relief innings across two outings for the Sooners.
- All four starting pitchers went 6.0 innings in the weekend series against Columbia. In five games last week, the starting pitchers combined for: 5-0 record, 28.0 innings, 22 strikeouts, 21 hits, three runs and five walks allowed.
- In four career starts, freshman **Ben Abram** has pitched 15.0 innings and allowed three earned runs, 12 hits and no walks, and has struck out 16 batters.
- Mitchell leads the Sooners with a .458 batting average, Hardman hits .388 and Zaragoza is hitting .372. Zaragoza leads the team with 11 runs scored followed by McKenna's 10 runs scored. Hardman has a team-high 21 RBIs and four home runs while Zaragoza has driven in 10 runs and has drawn a team-high 10 walks. Sophomore outfielder **Tanner Tredaway** leads the team with four stolen bases.
- The OU bullpen has pitched in 39.0 innings this season, allowing just eight runs and 25 hits while striking out 38 batters and posting a 1.85 ERA.

About the Patriots...

- Dallas Baptist is coached by Dan Heefner, who is in his 15th season at the school and 12th as head coach. He has posted a 438-232 record at DBU, and led the Patriots to eight NCAA postseason appearances, including five in a row.
- DBU swept a three-game series from Houston Baptist last weekend in Dallas, winning 7-1, 2-1 and 12-2. The Patriots lost to Baylor last Tuesday in Waco, 10-4.
- The Patriots are hitting .259 as a team, and averaging 6.3 runs and 2.6 extra base hits as a team. Luke Bandy leads the team with a .351 batting average and two home runs, and Jackson Glenn is batting .341 with seven RBIs and three doubles.

Big 12 Honors...

- **Tyler Hardman** and **Nathan Wiles** were named the Big 12 Player of the Week and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, on Feb. 25.
- Hardman batted .429 with two home runs and a triple, driving in nine runs at the Tony Gwynn Legacy tournament in San Diego. His seventh-inning grand slam gave the Sooners the lead, and he added a two-run double in the ninth inning. He hit a three-run home run on Sunday against Cal State Fullerton.
- Wiles pitched 7.0 shutout innings in a 1-0 win at San Diego State Saturday night. He allowed just four hits and tied a career high with 10 strikeouts.

Replaced Production...

- Oklahoma replaced significant production both offensively and on the mound from 2018 for the 2019 season.
- Included were all three outfield positions held by juniors drafted in 2018, a four-year senior at second base and a total of eight pitchers.
- Oklahoma replaced 60 percent of its innings pitched (339 of 570), 67 percent of its starts (42 of 63), 61 percent of its strikeouts (370 of 608) and 63 percent of wins on the mound (24 of 38).
- Offensively, the Sooners replaced 56 percent of RBIs (197 of 354) and runs scored (215 of 386), 34 of their 47 home runs and 51 percent of hits (300 of 593).

The Newcomers...

- Oklahoma has 19 newcomers to its roster in 2019. Nine of those players are four-year or junior college transfers, and 10 are freshmen.
- The new class is versatile and athletic, and several players have the ability to play multiple positions on the field. The group is comprised of eight pitchers, seven players who can play infield, six who can play outfield and one who can catch.
- Two newcomers call Oklahoma home, eight come from Texas, two from California, and one each from Arkansas, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Minnesota, Nevada and Ontario.
- Of the transfers, three began their careers at four-year schools: **Brady Harlan** (Texas), **Jason Ruffcorn** (Texas A&M) and **Jordan Vujovich** (Oregon). Harlan and Ruffcorn transferred directly to OU, while Vujovich came via Delta College in California. Six others came to OU from junior colleges.

Big 12 Preseason Honors...

- Senior Brylie Ware and sophomore Levi Prater were named to the All-Big 12 Preseason Team in a vote by the league's head coaches.
- With two preseason selections, Oklahoma tied for the third-most preseason all-conference honorees. Texas Tech had five selections, Baylor had four and Texas also had two, while Oklahoma State, Kansas, Kansas State, TCU and West Virginia each had one player on the preseason Big 12 team.
- The Sooners were picked to finish seventh in the preseason coaches poll.

Season Openers...

Since 1962, Oklahoma is 39-19 on opening day and 26-3 when playing the first game of the season at home, including 25-2 at L. Dale Mitchell Park. All-time in home openers, the Sooners are 51-6 going back to 1962, including 35-2 at Mitchell Park.

Opening Day Starters...

Right-hander **Cade Cavalli** started on the mound for the Sooners on opening day. He became the fifth sophomore to get the ball in game one in the last eight seasons. He also became the fifth consecutive righty to start on opening day following three years in a row of lefties getting the nod.

Oklahoma is Home...

The OU roster features 11 players from within the state's borders and nine from Texas. This is the third straight year the Sooners have featured more homegrown players on the roster than from Texas. Prior to the 2017 season, 2006 was the last year OU had more homegrown talent than Texas born players with 13 Sooners claiming Oklahoma as home.

2018 MLB Draft...

- Oklahoma had nine players selected in the 2018 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft.
- Five players were selected in the first 10 rounds, including three top-five round draft picks.
- Outfielder **Kyler Murray** was selected ninth overall by the Oakland Athletics, outfielder **Steele Walker** was drafted in the second round (46th overall) by the Chicago White Sox and pitcher **Jake Irvin** was taken in the fourth round (131st overall) by the Washington Nationals.
- Pitcher **Austin Hansen** was selected in the eighth round by the Houston Astros and outfielder **Cade Harris** was taken in the 10th round by the Colorado Rockies. Additionally, pitchers **Kyle Tyler** (20th round, Los Angeles Angels), **Lane Ramsey** (23rd round, White Sox), **Devon Perez** (26th round, White Sox) and **Connor Berry** (31st round, Boston Red Sox) were selected in the draft.
