Friday was just the third loss of the season, but Saturday presented the first challenge of playing the day after a loss. The Sooners fought off the Owls to earn the 17-8 victory, followed by the 6-0 victory Sunday.
- The Sooners scored 13 unanswered runs to win Saturday, then shut out Rice on Sunday, outscoring the Owls 19-0 over the final 13 innings.
- In its nine-run eighth inning on Saturday, OU sent 15 batters to the plate, scoring nine runs on four hits and seven walks in an at bat that lasted close to 45 minutes and broke open a tie game.

- Oklahoma is at least 13-3 to start a season for the second time in three years. In 2017 – when **Skip Johnson** joined OU as pitching coach – the team started the season 14-2.
- Sophomore **Levi Prater** was named the Big 12 Pitcher of the Week after tossing eight shutout innings with nine strikeouts in Sunday's win over Rice.
- OU ranks 15th in the country with a 2.60 team ERA. The Sooners rank 11th in the country in triples (7), third in shutouts (4) and fifth in double plays (19).
- Sophomore first baseman **Tyler Hardman** ranks 15th nationally in RBIs (22), 52nd in total bases (39) and 58th in home runs (4). Junior **Jason Ruffcorn** ranks 39th in saves (3) and 39th in appearances (8).
- OU leads the Big 12 in ERA (2.60) and walks per nine innings (3.36). Hardman is tied for the league lead in RBIs (22) and is third in hits (22). **Brandon Zaragoza** is tied for fifth in the Big 12 in runs scored (16). Prater is fourth in opponent batting average (.198) and tied for fifth in strikeouts (25).

HEAD COACH SKIP JOHNSON

In his two full seasons in Norman, Skip Johnson has made an immediate impact on the Oklahoma baseball program. He was named the 10th head coach in program history in June 2017 after serving one year as the Sooners' pitching coach.

The OU pitching staffs in Johnson's two seasons have posted two of the top five strikeout totals in program history and lowered the team ERA each season.

In 2018, Johnson coached OU to the program's 38th NCAA Regional appearance and posted the program's highest win total (38) since 2013. The Sooners reached the finals of the Tallahassee Regional, and set a school record with 608 strikeouts. Nine players were drafted, including five in the first 10 rounds.

In 2017, Oklahoma pitchers surrendered the fewest home runs in the Big 12 Conference in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. The Sooners' 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions.

Prior to coming to Oklahoma, Johnson spent a 25-year coaching career in the state of Texas, including the most recent 10 years as an assistant and associate head coach at the University of Texas.

Prior to his time in Austin, Johnson was the head coach for 13 years at Navarro College of the NJCAA's Texas Eastern Athletic Conference. From 1994-2006, he guided the Bulldogs to 13 NJCAA Regionals, nine TEAC championships and four regional titles while compiling 450 wins.

Johnson has also mentored a number of players outside of those he coached at Navarro and UT. Johnson regularly works with three-time Cy Young Award winner Clayton Kershaw of the Los Angeles Dodgers and Homer Bailey of the Kansas City Royals. He's also worked with Chris Davis of the Baltimore Orioles, among others.

A standout baseball player at Denton High School, Johnson began his collegiate playing career at Ranger (Texas) College. After a two-year career there, Johnson moved on to play baseball at the University of North Texas in 1988 before the school dropped its baseball program. He completed his collegiate playing career at UT-Pan American, lettering for the Broncs in 1989 and receiving his bachelor's degree in 1990. Johnson earned a master's degree in education from UT-Tyler in 1993.

A native of Denton, Texas, Johnson and his wife, Cathy, have two sons, Tyler and Garrett.

About the Sooners...

- OU is in its second year under the direction of head coach **Skip Johnson**. Johnson is 51-28 as OU head coach, and led the Sooners to an NCAA regional appearance last season.
- OU is batting .278 as a team and averaging 6.6 runs per game, with 29 doubles, seven triples and nine home runs. The Sooners allow opponents 2.9 runs per game .232 batting average.
- The OU bullpen has pitched in 55.0 innings this season, allowing 20 runs and 46 hits while striking out 58 batters.
- The starting pitchers have a 2.22 ERA and have struck out 81 batters and allowed 77 hits in 85.0 innings.

OU Player Notes...

- Senior **Brylie Ware** had a big weekend, driving in five runs on Saturday and batting .474 with four runs scored. His two-run single tied the game 8-8 and his leadoff home run in the eighth inning put the Sooners in front sparking a nine-run frame.
- Sophomore **Levi Prater** was excellent in the series-clinching win on Sunday, matching his career high with nine strikeouts over 8.0 shutout innings. He only allowed two runners to reach second base, and struck out three batters in the seventh and sat down the side in order in the eighth.
- Sophomore **Cade Cavalli** did damage with his bat this weekend, hitting a home run on Saturday and driving in four runs. The solo homer was his first of the season, and he hit a two-run double in the first inning Sunday to set the tone for that game. Cavalli now has a five-game hitting streak and a seven-game reached base streak.
- Junior catcher **Brady Lindsly** hit his second home run of the season Sunday, a three-run shot in the eighth inning that broke open a 5-0 lead. He drove in five runs last week. He hit a sacrifice fly on Wednesday and walked in a run on Saturday.
- Freshman **Jaret Godman** pitched 4.1 innings over two outings and allowed one run, two hits and struck out four batters. He threw two hitless innings in Wednesday's start and pitched another 2.1 on Friday night.
- Sophomore **Jordan Vujovich** has reached base in 10 straight games. He has collected nine walks and seven hits in that span. Junior **Brady Harlan** is on a four-game hitting streak, and is 6-for-14 (.429) in that span.
- In four career starts, freshman **Ben Abram** has pitched 15.0 innings and allowed three earned runs, 12 hits and no walks, and has struck out 16 batters.

About the Mavericks...

- UT Arlington is in its 12th season under head coach Darin Thomas. Thomas is 266-255 as UTA head coach.
- The Mavericks have won six of their last seven games, including a three-game road sweep of Seattle last weekend. UTA is 8-3 on the road this season.
- UTA is hitting .276 as a team, and averaging 5.3 runs and 2.9 extra base hits per game. Conner Aube leads the team with a .380 batting average and nine doubles while Anthony Dominguez has three home runs and hits .353.
- The Mavs have a 3.97 team ERA and 115 strikeouts against 38 walks in 143.0 innings. Tuesday starter Riley Bost is 0-0 with a 2.25 ERA in 4.0 relief innings. He has three strikeouts, no walks and has allowed four hits and three runs (one earned).

The OU and UTA Series...

- Oklahoma and UTA have played 33 times. The Sooners lead the series, 21-12.
- OU won 11-5 last year in Arlington, but the Mavs have won three of the last five meetings. UTA won three of four between 2012-14 before the schools picked the series back up in 2018.
- Between 2005-11, OU won six of seven meetings, and between 2002-04, UTA won six straight.
- The Sooners and Mavs first met in 1972 when OU won twice in Norman.

- **Tyler Hardman** and **Nathan Wiles** were named the Big 12 Player of the Week and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, on Feb. 25. **Levi Prater** was named Pitcher of the Week on March 11.
- Hardman batted .429 with two home runs and a triple, driving in nine runs at the Tony Gwynn Legacy tournament in San Diego. His seventh-inning grand slam gave the Sooners the lead, and he added a two-run double in the ninth inning. He hit a three-run home run on Sunday against Cal State Fullerton.
- Wiles pitched 7.0 shutout innings in a 1-0 win at San Diego State Feb. 23. He allowed just four hits and tied a career high with 10 strikeouts.
- Prater pitched a career-long 8.0 scoreless innings, matching a career high with nine strikeouts and allowing just three hits and one walks in OU's 6-0 win at Rice on March 10.

Replaced Production...

- Oklahoma replaced significant production both offensively and on the mound from 2018 for the 2019 season.
- Included were all three outfield positions held by juniors drafted in 2018, a four-year senior at second base and a total of eight pitchers.
- Oklahoma replaced 60 percent of its innings pitched (339 of 570), 67 percent of its starts (42 of 63), 61 percent of its strikeouts (370 of 608) and 63 percent of wins on the mound (24 of 38).
- Offensively, the Sooners replaced 56 percent of RBIs (197 of 354) and runs scored (215 of 386), 34 of their 47 home runs and 51 percent of hits (300 of 593).

The Newcomers...

- Oklahoma has 19 newcomers to its roster in 2019. Nine of those players are four-year or junior college transfers, and 10 are freshmen.
- The new class is versatile and athletic, and several players have the ability to play multiple positions on the field. The group is comprised of eight pitchers, seven players who can play infield, six who can play outfield and one who can catch.
- Two newcomers call Oklahoma home, eight come from Texas, two from California, and one each from Arkansas, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Minnesota, Nevada and Ontario.
- Of the transfers, three began their careers at four-year schools: **Brady Harlan** (Texas), **Jason Ruffcorn** (Texas A&M) and **Jordan Vujovich** (Oregon). Harlan and Ruffcorn transferred directly to OU, while Vujovich came via Delta College in California. Six others came to OU from junior colleges.

Big 12 Preseason Honors...

- Senior Brylie Ware and sophomore Levi Prater were named to the All-big 12 Preseason Team in a vote by the league's head coaches.
- With two preseason selections, Oklahoma tied for the thirdmost preseason all-conference honorees. Texas Tech had five selections, Baylor had four and Texas also had two, while Oklahoma State, Kansas, Kansas State, TCU and West Virginia each had one player on the preseason Big 12 team.
- The Sooners were picked to finish seventh in the preseason coaches poll.

Season Openers...

Since 1962, Oklahoma is 39-19 on opening day and 26-3 when playing the first game of the season at home, including 25-2 at L. Dale Mitchell Park. All-time in home openers, the Sooners are 51-6 going back to 1962, including 35-2 at Mitchell Park.

Opening Day Starters...

Right-hander **Cade Cavalli** started on the mound for the Sooners on opening day. He became the fifth sophomore to get the ball in game one in the last eight seasons. He also became the fifth consecutive righty to start on opening day following three years in a row of lefties getting the nod.

Oklahoma is Home...

The OU roster features 11 players from within the state's borders and nine from Texas. This is the third straight year the Sooners have featured more homegrown players on the roster than from Texas. Prior to the 2017 season, 2006 was the last year OU had more homegrown talent than Texas born players with 13 Sooners claiming Oklahoma as home.

2018 MLB Draft...

- Oklahoma had nine players selected in the 2018 Major League Basebal First-Year Player Draft.
- Five players were selected in the first 10 rounds, including three top-five round draft picks.
- Outfielder Kyler Murray was selected ninth overall by the Oakland Athletics, outfielder Steele Walker was drafted in the seoond round (46th overall) by the Chicago White Sox and pitcher Jake Irvin was taken in the fourth round (131st overall) by the Washington Nationals.
- Pitcher Austin Hansen was selected in the eighth round by the Houston Astros and outfielder Cade Harris was taken in the 10th round by the Colorado Rockies. Additionally, pitchers Kyle Tyler (20th round, Los Angeles Angels), Lane Ramsey (23rd round, White Sox), Devon Perez (26th round, White Sox) and Connor Berry (31st round, Boston Red Sox) were selected in the draft.

Brewers RHP **Chase Anderson** (2008-09), Rockies RHP **Jon Gray** (2012-13) and Angels RHP **Garrett Richards** (2007-09) represented the Sooners as MLB opening day starters for their respective teams in 2018. The University of Oklahoma was the first college to have three alumni start at pitcher on MLB's opening day in recorded history. OU pitchers have combined for five opening day starts in the last three years, the longest in that period and tied for the most with Vanderbilt (David Price-3, Sonny Gray-2) since 2014.
