Leading Off

- Oklahoma is at least 16-4 to start a season for the second time in three years. In 2017 – when **Skip Johnson** joined OU as pitching coach – the team started the season 17-3.
- OU ranks seventh in the country with a 2.38 team ERA. The Sooners rank 11th in the country in triples (9), fifth in shutouts (4) and 10th in double plays (20).
- Sophomore first baseman **Tyler Hardman** ranks 21st nationally in hits (31), 44th in total bases (49) and 54th in RBIs (22).
- OU leads the Big 12 in ERA (2.38) and walks per nine innings (3.44). Hardman leads the league in hits (31) and is tied for fourth in RBIs (22). Junior shortstop **Brandon Zaragoza** is tied for fourth in runs scored (20) and sophomore outfielder **Jordan Vujovich** is tied for second in walks (17). Sophomore **Levi Prater** is second in innings pitched (31.2), third in strikeouts (40) and fourth in opponent batting average (.168).

HEAD COACH SKIP JOHNSON

In his two full seasons in Norman, Skip Johnson has made an immediate impact on the Oklahoma baseball program. He was named the 10th head coach in program history in June 2017 after serving one year as the Sooners' pitching coach.

The OU pitching staffs in Johnson's two seasons have posted two of the top five strikeout totals in program history and lowered the team ERA each season.

In 2018, Johnson coached OU to the program's 38th NCAA Regional appearance and posted the program's highest win total (38) since 2013. The Sooners reached the finals of the Tallahassee Regional, and set a school record with 608 strikeouts. Nine players were drafted, including five in the first 10 rounds.

In 2017, Oklahoma pitchers surrendered the fewest home runs in the Big 12 Conference in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. The Sooners' 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions.

Prior to coming to Oklahoma, Johnson spent a 25-year coaching career in the state of Texas, including the most recent 10 years as an assistant and associate head coach at the University of Texas.

Prior to his time in Austin, Johnson was the head coach for 13 years at Navarro College of the NJCAA's Texas Eastern Athletic Conference. From 1994-2006, he guided the Bulldogs to 13 NJCAA Regionals, nine TEAC championships and four regional titles while compiling 450 wins.

Johnson has also mentored a number of players outside of those he coached at Navarro and UT. Johnson regularly works with three-time Cy Young Award winner Clayton Kershaw of the Los Angeles Dodgers and Homer Bailey of the Kansas City Royals. He's also worked with Chris Davis of the Baltimore Orioles, among others.

A standout baseball player at Denton High School, Johnson began his collegiate playing career at Ranger (Texas) College. After a two-year career there, Johnson moved on to play baseball at the University of North Texas in 1988 before the school dropped its baseball program. He completed his collegiate playing career at UT-Pan American, lettering for the Broncs in 1989 and receiving his bachelor's degree in 1990. Johnson earned a master's degree in education from UT-Tyler in 1993.

A native of Denton, Texas, Johnson and his wife, Cathy, have two sons, Tyler and Garrett.

About the Sooners...

- OU is in its second year under the direction of head coach **Skip Johnson**. Johnson is 54-29 as OU head coach, and led the Sooners to an NCAA regional appearance last season.
- OU is batting .294 as a team and averaging 6.95 runs per game, with 34 doubles, nine triples and 12 home runs. The Sooners allow opponents 3.1 runs per game and a .221 batting average.
- The OU bullpen has pitched in 67.2 innings this season, allowing 32 runs and 56 hits while striking out 73 batters.
- The starting pitchers have a 1.89 ERA and have struck out 114 batters and allowed 84 hits in 109.1 innings.

OU Player Notes...

- For the second straight week, sophomore **Levi Prater** was outstanding in a rubber game to lead the Sooners to a series win. On Sunday, he posted a career-high 15 strikeouts and allowed one hit and one walk in seven innings. He struck out the side three times and twice struck out five in a row, including the final five batters of his outing.
- Prater's 15 strikeouts tied for the fourth-most in school history. The last OU pitcher to strike out 15 batters in a game was Jared Hoerman in 1999 against Central Oklahoma. Jackson Todd also struck out 15 batters in seven innings against LSU in 1972.
- Prater has allowed one run in his last three starts, spanning 21 innings. The solo home run in the fourth inning Sunday broke a 17-inning scoreless streak.
- In two games as the designated hitter this weekend, sophomore **Cade Cavalli** went 5-for-10 at the plate with two home runs. He hit a three-run homer on Saturday to open an 8-2 lead, and his two-run homer on Sunday made the score 5-1. He is the first Sooner to homer in back to back games since Kyler Murray did so against UCF last May. In his start on the mound Friday, he struck out seven and allowed no runs in 5.1 innings.
- Junior second baseman **Conor McKenna** batted .600 (9-for-15) in four games last week, driving in one run in each contest and scoring three runs. He was 8-for-11 in the series against Missouri State. In the seventh inning on Saturday he made all three plays including a diving stop for the second out, and then led off the bottom half with a triple.
- Sophomore outfielder **Jordan Vujovich** reached base in 12 straight plate appearances through Friday's game, in which he drew five walks. He singled in his final at bat last Sunday at Rice, then reached five times against UT Arlington on Tuesday and six times on Friday. During his streak he collected four hits, seven walks and was hit by a pitch once.
- Junior **Nathan Wiles** was very good on Saturday, striking out nine batters and allowing two runs, four hits and one walk in OU's bounce back win to even the series.
- Freshman **Ben Abram** pitched 6.0 innings on Tuesday, allowing one unearned run on three hits and one walk. The walk was his first of the season, snapping a 20-inning streak without allowing a base on balls.
- Sophomore first baseman **Tyler Hardman** went 9-for-18 and scored seven runs last week. Junior catcher **Brady Lindsly** went 5-for-10 with a double, a triple, four RBI, three runs scored and three walks.

About the Lobos...

- New Mexico is in its 12th year under head coach Ray Birmingham, who has led the Lobos to a 372-291-3 record and five NCAA postseason appearances.
- The Lobos dropped two of three games at Nevada last weekend and took two of three at home from Cal State Fullerton two weekends ago. UNM lost to Nevada 5-3 and 6-4 with a 9-3 win in the second game of the series. It beat Fullerton 6-4 and 18-11 before dropping the finale 13-7.
- New Mexico is hitting .313 as a team, and averaging 7.8 runs and 3.5 extra base hits per game. Jared Mang leads the team with a .403 batting average, 11 doubles, 17 extra base hits, 30 RBIs and 24 runs scored.
- The Lobos have a 5.31 team ERA and 118 strikeouts against 74 walks in 156.0 innings.

The OU and New Mexico Series...

- Oklahoma and New Mexico have played 16 times. The Sooners lead the series, 15-1 and have won eight straight meetings.
- The last meeting was a 10-8 OU win in 2013 at an early season tournament in Corpus Christi, Texas.
- The Sooners won all three games in a 2012 series in Albuquerque and four games in Norman during the 2011 season.
- The Lobos won 11-2 in 1988 in the second of two games in Norman, the first of which OU won 6-2.
- The teams first met in 1964 when Oklahoma won three games in Albuquerque. OU also won three meetings in 1977.

Big 12 Honors...

- **Tyler Hardman** and **Nathan Wiles** were named the Big 12 Player of the Week and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, on Feb. 25. **Levi Prater** was named Pitcher of the Week on March 11.
- Hardman batted .429 with two home runs and a triple, driving in nine runs at the Tony Gwynn Legacy tournament in San Diego. His seventh-inning grand slam gave the Sooners the lead, and he added a two-run double in the ninth inning. He hit a three-run home run on Sunday against Cal State Fullerton.
- Wiles pitched 7.0 shutout innings in a 1-0 win at San Diego State Feb. 23. He allowed just four hits and tied a career high with 10 strikeouts.
- Prater pitched a career-long 8.0 scoreless innings, matching a career high with nine strikeouts and allowing just three hits and one walks in OU's 6-0 win at Rice on March 10.

Replaced Production...

- Oklahoma replaced significant production both offensively and on the mound from 2018 for the 2019 season.
- Included were all three outfield positions held by juniors drafted in 2018, a four-year senior at second base and a total of eight pitchers.
- Oklahoma replaced 60 percent of its innings pitched (339 of 570), 67 percent of its starts (42 of 63), 61 percent of its strikeouts (370 of 608) and 63 percent of wins on the mound (24 of 38).
- Offensively, the Sooners replaced 56 percent of RBIs (197 of 354) and runs scored (215 of 386), 34 of their 47 home runs and 51 percent of hits (300 of 593).

The Newcomers...

- Oklahoma has 19 newcomers to its roster in 2019. Nine of those players are four-year or junior college transfers, and 10 are freshmen.
- The new class is versatile and athletic, and several players have the ability to play multiple positions on the field. The group is comprised of eight pitchers, seven players who can play infield, six who can play outfield and one who can catch.
- Two newcomers call Oklahoma home, eight come from Texas, two from California, and one each from Arkansas, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Minnesota, Nevada and Ontario.
- Of the transfers, three began their careers at four-year schools: **Brady Harlan** (Texas), **Jason Ruffcorn** (Texas A&M) and **Jordan Vujovich** (Oregon). Harlan and Ruffcorn transferred directly to OU, while Vujovich came via Delta College in California. Six others came to OU from junior colleges.

Big 12 Preseason Honors...

- Senior Brylie Ware and sophomore Levi Prater were named to the All-big 12 Preseason Team in a vote by the league's head coaches.
- With two preseason selections, Oklahoma tied for the third-most preseason all-conference honorees. Texas Tech had five selections, Baylor had four and Texas also had two, while Oklahoma State, Kansas, Kansas State, TCU and West Virginia each had one player on the preseason Big 12 team.
- The Sooners were picked to finish seventh in the preseason coaches poll.

Season Openers...

Since 1962, Oklahoma is 39-19 on opening day and 26-3 when playing the first game of the season at home, including 25-2 at L. Dale Mitchell Park. All-time in home openers, the Sooners are 51-6 going back to 1962, including 35-2 at Mitchell Park.

Opening Day Starters...

Right-hander **Cade Cavalli** started on the mound for the Sooners on opening day. He became the fifth sophomore to get the ball in game one in the last eight seasons. He also became the fifth consecutive righty to start on opening day following three years in a row of lefties getting the nod.

Oklahoma is Home...

The OU roster features 11 players from within the state's borders and nine from Texas. This is the third straight year the Sooners have featured more homegrown players on the roster than from Texas. Prior to the 2017 season, 2006 was the last year OU had more homegrown talent than Texas born players with 13 Sooners claiming Oklahoma as home.

2018 MLB Draft...

- Oklahoma had nine players selected in the 2018 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft.
- Five players were selected in the first 10 rounds, including three top-five round draft picks.
- Outfielder **Kyler Murray** was selected ninth overall by the Oakland Athletics, outfielder **Steele Walker** was drafted in the second round (46th overall) by the Chicago White Sox and pitcher **Jake Irvin** was taken in the fourth round (131st overall) by the Washington Nationals.
- Pitcher **Austin Hansen** was selected in the eighth round by the Houston Astros and outfielder **Cade Harris** was taken in the 10th round by the Colorado Rockies. Additionally, pitchers **Kyle Tyler** (20th round, Los Angeles Angels), **Lane Ramsey** (23rd round, White Sox), **Devon Perez** (26th round, White Sox) and **Connor Berry** (31st round, Boston Red Sox) were selected in the draft.
