- Oklahoma is at least 21-4 to start a season for the second time in three years. In 2017 – when **Skip Johnson** joined OU as pitching coach – the team started the season 22-4.
- OU ranks second in the country with a 2.42 team ERA. The Sooners rank sixth in the country in triples (12), seventh in shutouts (4) and fifth in double plays (26).
- Junior catcher **Brady Lindsly** is tied for fourth nationally - and first among catchers - with four triples. Sophomore first baseman Tyler Hardman ranks 20th nationally in hits (37) and 38th in RBIs (27). Sophomore outfielder Jordan **Vujovich** and junior shortstop **Brandon Zaragoza** rank 17th (23) and 33rd (21) in walks, respectively.

HEAD COACH SKIP JOHNSON

In his two full seasons in Norman, Skip Johnson has made an immediate impact on the Oklahoma baseball program. He was named the 10th head coach in program history in June 2017 after serving one year as the Sooners' pitching coach.

The OU pitching staffs in Johnson's two seasons have posted two of the top five strikeout totals in program history and lowered the team ERA each season.

In 2018, Johnson coached OU to the program's 38th NCAA Regional appearance and posted the program's highest win total (38) since 2013. The Sooners reached the finals of the Tallahassee Regional, and set a school record with 608 strikeouts. Nine players were drafted, including five in the first 10 rounds.

In 2017, Oklahoma pitchers surrendered the fewest home runs in the Big 12 Conference in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. The Sooners' 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions.

Prior to coming to Oklahoma, Johnson spent a 25-year coaching career in the state of Texas, including the most recent 10 years as an assistant and associate head coach at the University of Texas.

Prior to his time in Austin, Johnson was the head coach for 13 years at Navarro College of the NJCAA's Texas Eastern Athletic Conference. From 1994-2006, he guided the Bulldogs to 13 NJCAA Regionals, nine TEAC championships and four regional titles while compiling 450 wins.

Johnson has also mentored a number of players outside of those he coached at Navarro and UT. Johnson regularly works with three-time Cy Young Award winner Clayton Kershaw of the Los Angeles Dodgers and Homer Bailey of the Kansas City Royals. He's also worked with Chris Davis of the Baltimore Orioles, among others.

A standout baseball player at Denton High School, Johnson began his collegiate playing career at Ranger (Texas) College. After a two-year career there, Johnson moved on to play baseball at the University of North Texas in 1988 before the school dropped its baseball program. He completed his collegiate playing career at UT-Pan American, lettering for the Broncs in 1989 and receiving his bachelor's degree in 1990. Johnson earned a master's degree in education from UT-Tyler in 1993.

A native of Denton, Texas, Johnson and his wife, Cathy, have two sons, Tyler and Garrett.

About the Sooners...

- OU is in its second year under the direction of head coach **Skip Johnson**. Johnson is 59-29 as OU head coach, and led the Sooners to an NCAA regional appearance last season.
- Oklahoma won its 2,600th game in program history on Sunday. The Sooners are 2,600-1,501-12 (.634) all-time in their 119th season of competition.
- The Sooners have tallied at least 10 hits in nine of the last 11 games. An eight-game streak ended Friday night. In that span, OU has averaged 11.1 hits and 8.4 runs per game.
- OU has allowed three or fewer runs in 18 of 25 games this season, and allowed one or zero runs 11 times.
- OU is batting .293 as a team and averaging 6.96 runs per game, with 46 doubles, 12 triples and 13 home runs. The Sooners allow opponents 3.1 runs per game and a .225 batting average.
- The Sooners have a 2.42 team ERA with 217 strikeouts to 85 walks in 223.0 innings. The starting pitchers have a 1.68 ERA and have struck out 136 batters and allowed 104 hits in 139.1 innings.

OU Player Notes...

- Junior **Jason Ruffcorn** was named the Big 12 Newcomer of the Week. He appeared in all five games last week, earning three saves. He saved the games Saturday and Sunday, closing out the Sooners' series sweep of Kansas, holding a 4-3 lead Saturday and getting five outs on Sunday.
- Sophomore **Cade Cavalli** is on an 11-game hitting streak and a 13-game reached base streak. In his last eight games as DH, he has batted .457 (16-of-35) with 12 RBIs, 11 runs scored, five doubles and two home runs. He led OU with a .412 batting average last week, hitting four doubles and reaching base at a .474 clip. He drove in three runs and scored four, including two runs on Sunday. Friday night he pitched 6.2 shutout innings to open the Big 12 series with Kansas.
- Junior catcher **Brady Lindsly** hit two triples and a double on his way to batting .357 and slugging .714 last week. His four triples this season tie for fourth nationally and are the most of any catcher in the country.
- Sophomore outfielder **Jordan Vujovich** has reached base in 19 straight contests, dating back to Feb. 20 against Dallas Baptist. He has tallied 16 hits, 23 walks, been hit by a pitch seven times and scored 15 runs in that span. He reached base in 12 straight plate appearances from March 10-15.
- Junior second baseman **Conor McKenna** drove in a teamhigh six runs last week, batting .350 with a double and a triple. He also scored three runs and turned three of OU's six double plays last week.
- Sophomore **Levi Prater** struck out six batters over 5.0 innings and allowed one unearned run in Sunday's win over Kansas. He dropped his ERA to 0.98 for the season. He has allowed one earned run, and two overall, in 25.0 innings over his last four starts.
- Freshman **Ben Abram** pitched 6.0 innings last Tuesday at New Mexico, allowing one run on five hits and two walks with four strikeouts. It was his third straight start in which he pitched 6.0 innings.

About the Cowboys...

- Oklahoma State is in its seventh year under head coach Josh Holliday, who has led the Cowboys to a 246-139-1 record.
- The Cowboys swept Kansas State last weekend by scores of 11-4, 5-4 and 8-4, and fell at Dallas Baptist last week, 7-5.
- OSU is hitting .284 as a team, and averaging 6.6 runs and 3.1 extra base hits per game. Carson McCusker leads the team with a .333 batting average and 11 doubles. Collin Simpson has a team-high 21 RBIs.
- The Cowboys have a 3.44 team ERA and 200 strikeouts against 94 walks in 196.0 innings.

The OU and OSU Series...

- Oklahoma and Oklahoma State have played 305 times. The Cowboys lead the overall series, 163-142 and have won seven straight meetings.
- OSU won four meetings last season, 7-1 (Norman), 8-0 (Stillwater), and 10-1 and 9-2 (Tulsa). OU last defeated OSU in 2016 with a 3-1 victory in Tulsa.
- The series dates back to 1942.

Big 12 Honors...

- Tyler Hardman and Nathan Wiles were named the Big 12 Player of the Week and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, on Feb. 25. Levi Prater was named Pitcher of the Week on March 11. Jason Ruffcorn earned Newcomer of the Week honors on March 25.
- Hardman batted .429 with two home runs and a triple, driving in nine runs at the Tony Gwynn Legacy tournament in San Diego.
 His seventh-inning grand slam gave the Sooners the lead, and he added a two-run double in the ninth inning. He hit a three-run home run on Sunday against Cal State Fullerton.
- Wiles pitched 7.0 shutout innings in a 1-0 win at San Diego State Feb. 23. He allowed just four hits and tied a career high with 10 strikeouts.
- Prater pitched a career-long 8.0 scoreless innings, matching a career high with nine strikeouts and allowing just three hits and one walks in OU's 6-0 win at Rice on March 10.
- Ruffcorn appeared in all five games between March 19-24 and earned three saves, including the final two games of the series against Kansas.

Prater's 15 Strikeout Game

- Sophomore **Levi Prater** struck out a career-high 15 batters in 7.0 innings against Missouri State on March 17. He allowed one hit and one walk in seven innings. He struck out the side three times and twice struck out five in a row, including the final five batters of his outing.
- His 15 strikeouts tied for the fourth-most in school history. The last OU pitcher to strike out 15 batters in a game was Jared Hoerman in 1999 against Central Oklahoma. Jackson Todd also struck out 15 batters in seven innings against LSU in 1972.

Replaced Production...

- Oklahoma replaced significant production both offensively and on the mound from 2018 for the 2019 season.
- Included were all three outfield positions held by juniors drafted in 2018, a four-year senior at second base and a total of eight pitchers.
- Oklahoma replaced 60 percent of its innings pitched (339 of 570), 67 percent of its starts (42 of 63), 61 percent of its strikeouts (370 of 608) and 63 percent of wins on the mound (24 of 38).
- Offensively, the Sooners replaced 56 percent of RBIs (197 of 354) and runs scored (215 of 386), 34 of their 47 home runs and 51 percent of hits (300 of 593).

The Newcomers...

- Oklahoma has 19 newcomers to its roster in 2019. Nine of those players are four-year or junior college transfers, and 10 are freshmen.
- The new class is versatile and athletic, and several players have the ability to play multiple positions on the field. The group is comprised of eight pitchers, seven players who can play infield, six who can play outfield and one who can catch.
- Two newcomers call Oklahoma home, eight come from Texas, two from California, and one each from Arkansas, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Minnesota, Nevada and Ontario.
- Of the transfers, three began their careers at four-year schools:
 Brady Harlan (Texas), Jason Ruffcorn (Texas A&M) and Jordan Vujovich (Oregon). Harlan and Ruffcorn transferred directly to OU, while Vujovich came via Delta College in California. Six others came to OU from junior colleges.

Big 12 Preseason Honors...

- Senior Brylie Ware and sophomore Levi Prater were named to the All-big 12 Preseason Team in a vote by the league's head coaches.
- With two preseason selections, Oklahoma tied for the third-most preseason all-conference honorees. Texas Tech had five selections, Baylor had four and Texas also had two, while Oklahoma State, Kansas, Kansas State, TCU and West Virginia each had one player on the preseason Big 12 team.
- The Sooners were picked to finish seventh in the preseason coaches poll.

Season Openers...

Since 1962, Oklahoma is 39-19 on opening day and 26-3 when playing the first game of the season at home, including 25-2 at L. Dale Mitchell Park. All-time in home openers, the Sooners are 51-6 going back to 1962, including 35-2 at Mitchell Park.

Opening Day Starters...

Right-hander **Cade Cavalli** started on the mound for the Sooners on opening day. He became the fifth sophomore to get the ball in game one in the last eight seasons. He also became the fifth consecutive righty to start on opening day following three years in a row of lefties getting the nod.

Oklahoma is Home...

The OU roster features 11 players from within the state's borders and nine from Texas. This is the third straight year the Sooners have featured more homegrown players on the roster than from Texas. Prior to the 2017 season, 2006 was the last year OU had more homegrown talent than Texas born players with 13 Sooners claiming Oklahoma as home.

2018 MLB Draft...

- Oklahoma had nine players selected in the 2018 Major League Basebal First-Year Player Draft.
- Five players were selected in the first 10 rounds, including three top-five round draft picks.
- Outfielder Kyler Murray was selected ninth overall by the Oakland Athletics, outfielder Steele Walker was drafted in the seoond round (46th overall) by the Chicago White Sox and pitcher Jake Irvin was taken in the fourth round (131st overall) by the Washington Nationals.
- Pitcher Austin Hansen was selected in the eighth round by the Houston Astros and outfielder Cade Harris was taken in the 10th round by the Colorado Rockies. Additionally, pitchers Kyle Tyler (20th round, Los Angeles Angels), Lane Ramsey (23rd round, White Sox), Devon Perez (26th round, White Sox) and Connor Berry (31st round, Boston Red Sox) were selected in the draft.
