First Pitch...

• Oklahoma continues its 11-game road swing this weekend with a three-game non-conference series at Minnesota. Game times are set for 6:30 p.m. Friday, 2 p.m. Saturday and 11 a.m. Sunday.

• Saturday's game will be played at Target Field, home of the Minnesota Twins. The Friday and Sunday games will be played on campus at Siebert Field.

• This will be the second-ever meeting between Oklahoma and Minnesota in baseball. The teams met in the 1973 College World Series in a game the Golden Gophers won 1-0.

• This will be Oklahoma's first-ever baseball games played in Minnesota.

• The games will be available on Big Ten Network Plus and the Sooner Sports Radio Network.

• This April non-conference series is taking place during Oklahoma's Big 12 bye week as a result of the unbalanced schedule due to the odd number of baseball-playing schools in the Big 12.

Leading Off

• OU ranks 15th in the country with a 3.23 team ERA. The Sooners rank 14th in the country in double plays (34), 20th in triples (14), 19th in shutouts (4) and 11th in fielding percentage (.980). OU batters have drawn 203 walks, a total that ranks 16th nationally.

• Oklahoma is No. 39 in the most recent NCAA RPI rankings through April 14 games. The Sooners are 8-8 in road games and have seven wins in 16 games against opponents in the top 100 of the RPI rankings. OU is one of six Big 12 schools in the RPI top 50, joining Texas Tech (15), West Virginia (16), Oklahoma State (29), Texas (31) and Baylor (40). TCU (66) and Kansas State (86) both rank in the top 90 of the RPI.

• All 17 of Oklahoma's remaining regular season games are against teams currently ranked in the top 100 of the NCAA RPI, including nine games against teams in the RPI top 50. Four of those contests will be played at home, two at neutral sites and 10 will be played on the road.

HEAD COACH SKIP JOHNSON

In his two full seasons in Norman, Skip Johnson has made an immediate impact on the Oklahoma baseball program. He was named the 10th head coach in program history in June 2017 after serving one year as the Sooners' pitching coach.

The OU pitching staffs in Johnson's two seasons have posted two of the top five strikeout totals in program history and lowered the team ERA each season.

In 2018, Johnson coached OU to the program's 38th NCAA Regional appearance and posted the program's highest win total (38) since 2013. The Sooners reached the finals of the Tallahassee Regional, and set a school record with 608 strikeouts. Nine players were drafted, including five in the first 10 rounds.

In 2017, Oklahoma pitchers surrendered the fewest home runs in the Big 12 Conference in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. The Sooners' 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions.

Prior to coming to Oklahoma, Johnson spent a 25-year coaching career in the state of Texas, including the most recent 10 years as an assistant and associate head coach at the University of Texas.

Prior to his time in Austin, Johnson was the head coach for 13 years at Navarro College of the NJCAA's Texas Eastern Athletic Conference. From 1994-2006, he guided the Bulldogs to 13 NJCAA Regionals, nine TEAC championships and four regional titles while compiling 450 wins.

Johnson has also mentored a number of players outside of those he coached at Navarro and UT. Johnson regularly works with three-time Cy Young Award winner Clayton Kershaw of the Los Angeles Dodgers and Homer Bailey of the Kansas City Royals. He's also worked with Chris Davis of the Baltimore Orioles, among others.

A standout baseball player at Denton High School, Johnson began his collegiate playing career at Ranger (Texas) College. After a two-year career there, Johnson moved on to play baseball at the University of North Texas in 1988 before the school dropped its baseball program. He completed his collegiate playing career at UT-Pan American, lettering for the Broncs in 1989 and receiving his bachelor's degree in 1990. Johnson earned a master's degree in education from UT-Tyler in 1993.

A native of Denton, Texas, Johnson and his wife, Cathy, have two sons, Tyler and Garrett.

About the Sooners...

- OU is in its second year under the direction of head coach **Skip Johnson**. Johnson is 63-38 as OU head coach, and led the Sooners to an NCAA regional appearance last season.
- Oklahoma won its 2,600th game in program history on March 24. The Sooners are 2,604-1,510-12 (.633) all-time in their 119th season of competition.
- OU has allowed three or fewer runs in 22 of 38 games this season, and allowed one or zero runs 12 times.
- OU leads the Big 12 in ERA (3.23), fewest walks per nine innings (3.52) and double plays (34), and is tied for first in the league with a .980 fielding percentage. Offensively, OU is fourth in the conference in on base percentage (.384), first in triples (14) and second in doubles (72).
- OU is batting .271 as a team and averaging 5.9 runs per game, with 72 doubles, 14 triples and 18 home runs. The Sooners allow opponents 3.7 runs per game and a .238 batting average.
- The Sooners have a 3.23 team ERA with 324 strikeouts to 133 walks in 340.1 innings. The starting pitchers have a combined 2.78 ERA and have struck out 202 batters and allowed 184 hits in 210.1 innings.

OU Player Notes...

- Junior shortstop **Brandon Zaragoza** has reached base in each of the last 11 games and has a hit in the last five. He had two hits in each game last Saturday and Sunday (batting .455 in the series), and is fourth on the team this season with 11 multiple hit games. He has hit .389 in the last five contests.
- Sophomore outfielder **Jordan Vujovich** ranks 16th nationally averaging 1.0 walk per game and ranks 23rd with 33 walks on the season. He has reached base in 26 of the 28 games in which he has started this season. He ranks third in the Big 12 with a .478 on-base percentage.
- Sophomore first baseman **Tyler Hardman** leads the Sooners with 31 RBIs, five home runs, 10 doubles and a .506 slugging percentage. He also has a team-high 17 multiple hit games and seven multiple RBI contests, and has reached base in 10 consecutive games.
- Senior third baseman **Brylie Ware** has led OU with seven RBIs and four runs scored in the last five games. He has hit safely in five straight contests, and has 13 multiple hit games and seven multiple RBI games this season.
- Junior **Jason Ruffcorn** leads Big 12 and ranks 14th nationally in saves (8). He also leads the league and ranks eighth nationally with 22 appearances.
- Freshman **Wyatt Olds** ranks eighth nationally and is tied with Ruffcorn to lead the Big 12 with 22 appearances. He has pitched 18 scoreless outings in his 22 appearances this season.
- Freshman **Ben Abram** is one of two pitchers in the Big 12 with six wins, which ranks 22nd in the nation (leaders have eight victories). Junior **Nathan Wiles** ranks 32nd in K/BB ratio (5.9). and 25th walks allowed per nine innings (1.27) while Abram is 60th (5.1) and 63rd (1.61) in the respective categories.

About the Golden Gophers...

- Minnesota is in its 38th year under head coach John Anderson, who has led the Golden Gophers to a 1,288-860-3 record.
- Minnesota has won three national championships (1956, 1960, 1964) and hosted a regional in 2018, advancing to a Super Regional.
- UM is hitting .265 as a team, and averaging 5.2 runs and 2.9 extra base hits per game. Jordan Kozicky leads the team with seven home runs, 34 RBIs and 23 runs scored, and hits .276.
- The Golden Gophers have a 4.65 team ERA and 303 strikeouts against 153 walks in 296.0 innings.

The OU and Minnesota Series...

- Oklahoma and Minnesota have played once, in the 1973 College World Series.
- The Golden Gophers won that game 1-0.
- The winning pitcher for Minnesota was Baseball Hall of Famer Dave Winfield, who struck out 14 batters in a complete game, on his way to winning the MVP honors of the CWS.

Big 12 Honors...

- **Tyler Hardman** and **Nathan Wiles** were named the Big 12 Player of the Week and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, on Feb. 25. **Levi Prater** was the Pitcher of the Week on March 11. **Jason Ruffcorn** earned Newcomer of the Week honors on March 25.
- Hardman batted .429 with two home runs and a triple, driving in nine runs at the Tony Gwynn Legacy tournament in San Diego. His seventh-inning grand slam gave the Sooners the lead, and he added a two-run double in the ninth inning. He hit a three-run home run on Sunday against Cal State Fullerton.
- Wiles pitched 7.0 shutout innings in a 1-0 win at San Diego State Feb. 23. He allowed just four hits and tied a career high with 10 strikeouts.
- Prater pitched a career-long 8.0 scoreless innings, matching a career high with nine strikeouts and allowing just three hits and one walk in OU's 6-0 win at Rice on March 10.
- Ruffcorn appeared in all five games between March 19-24 and earned three saves, including the final two games of the series against Kansas.

Prater's 15 Strikeout Game

- Sophomore **Levi Prater** struck out a career-high 15 batters in 7.0 innings against Missouri State on March 17. He allowed one hit and one walk in seven innings. He struck out the side three times and twice struck out five in a row, including the final five batters of his outing.
- His 15 strikeouts tied for the fourth-most in school history. The last OU pitcher to strike out 15 batters in a game was Jared Hoerman in 1999 against Central Oklahoma. Jackson Todd also struck out 15 batters in seven innings against LSU in 1972.

Replaced Production...

- Oklahoma replaced significant production both offensively and on the mound from 2018 for the 2019 season.
- Included were all three outfield positions held by juniors drafted in 2018, a four-year senior at second base and a total of eight pitchers.
- Oklahoma replaced 60 percent of its innings pitched (339 of 570), 67 percent of its starts (42 of 63), 61 percent of its strikeouts (370 of 608) and 63 percent of wins on the mound (24 of 38).
- Offensively, the Sooners replaced 56 percent of RBIs (197 of 354) and runs scored (215 of 386), 34 of their 47 home runs and 51 percent of hits (300 of 593).

The Newcomers...

- Oklahoma has 19 newcomers to its roster in 2019. Nine of those players are four-year or junior college transfers, and 10 are freshmen.
- OU is one of just 12 programs nationally with at least 10 freshmen on the roster, and one of 13 programs with 19 newcomers this season.
- The new class is versatile and athletic, and several players have the ability to play multiple positions on the field. The group is comprised of eight pitchers, seven players who can play infield, six who can play outfield and one who can catch.

- Two newcomers call Oklahoma home, eight come from Texas, two from California, and one each from Arkansas, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Minnesota, Nevada and Ontario.

- Of the transfers, three began their careers at four-year schools:

Brady Harlan (Texas), **Jason Ruffcorn** (Texas A&M) and **Jordan Vujovich** (Oregon). Harlan and Ruffcorn transferred directly to OU, while Vujovich came via Delta College in California. Six others came to OU from junior colleges.

Two Former Sooners on 2019 MLB Opening Day Rosters...

- Two former Sooners were on Major League Baseball Opening Day rosters in 2019: Jon Gray with the Colorado Rockies and Chase Anderson with the Milwaukee Brewers.
- OU is one of six Big 12 programs with multiple alumni on big league rosters. A total of 15 Big 12 alumni were on Opening Day rosters, including a pair of Skip Johnson pupils in Brandon Workman and Corey Knebel from Texas.

Season Openers...

Since 1962, Oklahoma is 39-19 on opening day and 26-3 when playing the first game of the season at home, including 25-2 at L. Dale Mitchell Park. All-time in home openers, the Sooners are 51-6 going back to 1962, including 35-2 at Mitchell Park.

Opening Day Starters...

Right-hander **Cade Cavalli** started on the mound for the Sooners on opening day. He became the fifth sophomore to get the ball in game one in the last eight seasons. He also became the fifth consecutive righty to start on opening day following three years in a row of lefties getting the nod.

Big 12 Preseason Honors...

- Senior Brylie Ware and sophomore Levi Prater were named to the All-big 12 Preseason Team in a vote by the league's head coaches.
- With two preseason selections, Oklahoma tied for the third-most preseason all-conference honorees. Texas Tech had five selections, Baylor had four and Texas also had two, while Oklahoma State, Kansas, Kansas State, TCU and West Virginia each had one player on the preseason Big 12 team.
- The Sooners were picked to finish seventh in the conference preseason poll, voted by the league's head coaches.

Oklahoma is Home...

The OU roster features 11 players from within the state's borders and nine from Texas. This is the third straight year the Sooners have featured more homegrown players on the roster than from Texas. Prior to the 2017 season, 2006 was the last year OU had more homegrown talent than Texas born players with 13 Sooners claiming Oklahoma as home.
