- OU ranks 15th in the country with a 3.26 team ERA. The Sooners rank 17th in the country in double plays (38), 25th in triples (14), 21st in shutouts (4) and 14th in fielding percentage (.980). OU batters have drawn 216 walks, a total that ranks 28th nationally.
- Oklahoma is No. 39 in the most recent NCAA RPI rankings through April 24 games. The Sooners are 11-9 in road games and have 12 wins in 22 games against opponents in the top 100 of the RPI rankings. OU is one of six Big 12 schools in the RPI top 50, joining Texas Tech (17), West Virginia (19), Oklahoma State (21), Baylor (33) and Texas (42). With Kansas State (71), TCU (76), and Kansas (95), every Big 12 school ranks in the top 100 of the RPI.
- All 12 of Oklahoma's remaining regular season games are against teams currently ranked in the top 100 of the NCAA RPI, including nine games against teams in the RPI top 50. Four of those contests will be played at home, two at neutral sites and six will be played on the road.

HEAD COACH SKIP JOHNSON

In his two full seasons in Norman, Skip Johnson has made an immediate impact on the Oklahoma baseball program. He was named the 10th head coach in program history in June 2017 after serving one year as the Sooners' pitching coach.

The OU pitching staffs in Johnson's two seasons have posted two of the top five strikeout totals in program history and lowered the team ERA each season.

In 2018, Johnson coached OU to the program's 38th NCAA Regional appearance and posted the program's highest win total (38) since 2013. The Sooners reached the finals of the Tallahassee Regional, and set a school record with 608 strikeouts. Nine players were drafted, including five in the first 10 rounds.

In 2017, Oklahoma pitchers surrendered the fewest home runs in the Big 12 Conference in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. The Sooners' 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions.

Prior to coming to Oklahoma, Johnson spent a 25-year coaching career in the state of Texas, including the most recent 10 years as an assistant and associate head coach at the University of Texas.

Prior to his time in Austin, Johnson was the head coach for 13 years at Navarro College of the NJCAA's Texas Eastern Athletic Conference. From 1994-2006, he guided the Bulldogs to 13 NJCAA Regionals, nine TEAC championships and four regional titles while compiling 450 wins.

Johnson has also mentored a number of players outside of those he coached at Navarro and UT. Johnson regularly works with three-time Cy Young Award winner Clayton Kershaw of the Los Angeles Dodgers and Homer Bailey of the Kansas City Royals. He's also worked with Chris Davis of the Baltimore Orioles, among others.

A standout baseball player at Denton High School, Johnson began his collegiate playing career at Ranger (Texas) College. After a two-year career there, Johnson moved on to play baseball at the University of North Texas in 1988 before the school dropped its baseball program. He completed his collegiate playing career at UT-Pan American, lettering for the Broncs in 1989 and receiving his bachelor's degree in 1990. Johnson earned a master's degree in education from UT-Tyler in 1993.

A native of Denton, Texas, Johnson and his wife, Cathy, have two sons, Tyler and Garrett.

About the Sooners...

- OU is in its second year under the direction of head coach **Skip Johnson**. Johnson is 66-39 as OU head coach, and led the Sooners to an NCAA regional appearance last season.
- Oklahoma won its 2,600th game in program history on March 24. The Sooners are 2,607-1,511-12 (.633) all-time in their 119th season of competition.
- OU has allowed three or fewer runs in 23 of 42 games this season, and allowed one or zero runs 13 times.
- OU ranks second in the Big 12 in fewest walks per nine innings (3.69) and ERA (3.26; leader WVU is at 3.22). Offensively, OU leads the conference in triples (14) and ranks third in doubles (80).
- OU is batting .266 as a team and averaging 5.8 runs per game, with 80 doubles, 14 triples and 19 home runs. The Sooners allow opponents 3.7 runs per game and a .234 batting average.
- The Sooners have a 3.26 team ERA with 358 strikeouts to 154 walks in 375.1 innings. The starting pitchers have a combined 2.94 ERA and have struck out 219 batters and allowed 199 hits in 229.1 innings.

OU Player Notes...

- Junior shortstop **Brandon Zaragoza** is on the watch list for the Brooks Wallace Award, given by the College Baseball Foundation to the nation's top shortstop. He is batting .272 with a team-high 35 runs scored and is third on the team with 25 RBIs. He has totaled seven doubles and 30 walks and posted a .960 fielding percentage in 173 chances. He is on a nine-game hitting streak and has reached base in each of his last 15 contests.
- Sophomore **Cade Cavalli** is on the midseason watch list for the John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year award and the National Pitcher of the Year award, which are presented by the College Baseball Foundation. On the mound, he is 5-2 with a 3.10 ERA in 10 starts, with 49 strikeouts and a .244 opponent batting average in 52.1 innings. At the plate, he is batting .319 with five doubles, four home runs, two triples, 17 RBIs, 16 runs scored and nine walks in 72 at bats.
- Freshman **Ben Abram** is also on National Pitcher of the Year award watch list. He is 6-1 with a 3.10 ERA in 10 starts, with 47 strikeouts to 10 walks and a .234 opponent batting average in 52.1 innings.
- Junior **Jason Ruffcorn** is on the Stopper of the Year award mideseason update. He earned saves in both the Saturday and Sunday wins last week at Minnesota. He leads the Big 12 and ranks seventh nationally in saves (10). He also leads the league and ranks ninth nationally with 24 appearances.
- Junior outfielder **Brady Harlan** hit his first collegiate home run on Sunday a three-run shot that gave the Sooners a 3-2 lead in the fifth inning. He then drove in three runs in OU's 9-4 win at Wlchita State on Tuesday. He has 17 RBIs on the season, six of which have come in the last two games. Harlan, a December 2018 graduate of the University of Texas who is playing his first season since 2016, did not homer in his one season playing at UT. He only hit one home run in high school.
- Sophomore first baseman **Tyler Hardman** has reached base in 14 straight games. He leads the Sooners with a .320 batting average, 33 RBIs, five home runs, 11 doubles, 17 multiple hit games and eight multiple RBI games.
- Freshman **Wyatt Olds** also ranks ninth nationally and is tied with Ruffcorn in the Big 12 with 24 appearances. He has pitched 20 scoreless outlings in his 24 appearances this season.
- Sophomore outfielder **Tanner Tredaway** hit two RBI doubles at Wichita State on Tuesday, doubling his total of two-base hits for the season. He leads the team with six stolen bases and has a hit in three of his last four starts.

About the Wildcats...

- Kansas State is in its first year under head coach Pete Hughes, who has led the Wildcats to a 20-22 record this season. Hughes is the former head coach at Oklahoma, where he posted a 128-107-1 record from 2014-17.
- Kansas State has won seven of its last 10 games, including two of three games each of the last two weekends at Texas and at home against TCU. KSU won 9-2 at Omaha on Tuesday.
- KSU is hitting .261 as a team, and averaging 4.95 runs and 2.8 extra base hits per game. Zach Kokoska leads the team with a .329 batting average and has six home runs, 26 RBIs and 28 runs scored. Will Brennan is hitting .306 with 13 doubles, 24 RBIs and 29 runs scored.
- The Wildcats have a 5.21 team ERA and 353 strikeouts against 180 walks in 366.0 innings.

Big 12 Honors...

- Tyler Hardman and Nathan Wiles were named the Big 12 Player of the Week and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, on Feb. 25. Levi Prater was the Pitcher of the Week on March 11. Jason Ruffcorn earned Newcomer of the Week honors on March 25.
- Hardman batted .429 with two home runs and a triple, driving in nine runs at the Tony Gwynn Legacy tournament in San Diego. His seventh-inning grand slam gave the Sooners the lead, and he added a two-run double in the ninth inning. He hit a three-run home run on Sunday against Cal State Fullerton.
- Wiles pitched 7.0 shutout innings in a 1-0 win at San Diego State Feb. 23. He allowed just four hits and tied a career high with 10 strikeouts
- Prater pitched a career-long 8.0 scoreless innings, matching a career high with nine strikeouts and allowing just three hits and one walks in OU's 6-0 win at Rice on March 10.
- Ruffcorn appeared in all five games between March 19-24 and earned three saves, including the final two games of the series against Kansas.

Award Watch Lists

- Sophomore **Cade Cavalli** and freshman **Ben Abram** are on the midseason watch list for the National Pitcher of the Year award. Cavalli is also on the watch list for the John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year award, and shortstop **Brandon Zaragoza** is on the Brooks Wallace Award watch list, for the top shortstop in the nation. Junior **Jason Ruffcorn** was named on the Stopper of the Year midseason update.
- The John Olerud award, Brooks Wallace award and National Pitcher of the Year award are presented by the College Baseball Foundation and College Baseball Hall of Fame. The Stopper of the Year award is presented by the National College Baseball Writers Association.
- Senior Brylie Ware is a nominee for the Bobby Bragan Collegiate Slugger Award, which is open to all Division I baseball programs in Texas, Oklahoma, Arkansas, Louisiana and New Mexico. Ware was also announced as a candidate for the Senior CLASS Award, which accounts for athletic performance, academics, character, community service and leadership.

Prater's 15 Strikeout Game

- Sophomore **Levi Prater** struck out a career-high 15 batters in 7.0 innings against Missouri State on March 17. He allowed one hit and one walk in seven innings. He struck out the side three times and twice struck out five in a row, including the final five batters of his outing.
- His 15 strikeouts tied for the fourth-most in school history. The last 0U pitcher to strike out 15 batters in a game was Jared Hoerman in 1999 against Central Oklahoma. Jackson Todd also struck out 15 batters in seven innings against LSU in 1972.

Replaced Production...

- Oklahoma replaced significant production both offensively and on the mound from 2018 for the 2019 season.
- Included were all three outfield positions held by juniors drafted in 2018, a four-year senior at second base and a total of eight pitchers.
- Oklahoma replaced 60 percent of its innings pitched (339 of 570), 67 percent of its starts (42 of 63), 61 percent of its strikeouts (370 of 608) and 63 percent of wins on the mound (24 of 38).
- Offensively, the Sooners replaced 56 percent of RBIs (197 of 354) and runs scored (215 of 386), 34 of their 47 home runs and 51 percent of hits (300 of 593).

The Newcomers...

- Oklahoma has 19 newcomers to its roster in 2019. Nine of those players are four-year or junior college transfers, and 10 are freshmen
- OU is one of just 12 programs nationally with at least 10 freshmen on the roster, and one of 13 programs with 19 newcomers this season.
- The new class is versatile and athletic, and several players have the ability to play multiple positions on the field. The group is comprised of eight pitchers, seven players who can play infield, six who can play outfield and one who can catch.
- Two newcomers call Oklahoma home, eight come from Texas, two from California, and one each from Arkansas, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Minnesota, Nevada and Ontario.
- Of the transfers, three began their careers at four-year schools: **Brady Harlan** (Texas), **Jason Ruffcorn** (Texas A&M) and **Jordan Vujovich** (Oregon). Harlan and Ruffcorn transferred directly to OU, while Vujovich came via Delta College in California. Six others came to OU from junior colleges.

Two Former Sooners on 2019 MLB Opening Day Rosters...

- Two former Sooners were on Major League Baseball Opening Day rosters in 2019: Jon Gray with the Colorado Rockies and Chase Anderson with the Milwaukee Brewers.
- OU is one of six Big 12 programs with multiple alumni on big league rosters. A total of 15 Big 12 alumni were on Opening Day rosters, including a pair of Skip Johnson pupils in Brandon Workman and Corey Knebel from Texas.

Oklahoma is Home...

The OU roster features 11 players from within the state's borders and nine from Texas. This is the third straight year the Sooners have featured more homegrown players on the roster than from Texas. Prior to the 2017 season, 2006 was the last year OU had more homegrown talent than Texas born players with 13 Sooners claiming Oklahoma as home.

Season Openers...

Since 1962, Oklahoma is 39-19 on opening day and 26-3 when playing the first game of the season at home, including 25-2 at L. Dale Mitchell Park. All-time in home openers, the Sooners are 51-6 going back to 1962, including 35-2 at Mitchell Park.

Opening Day Starters...

Right-hander **Cade Cavalli** started on the mound for the Sooners on opening day. He became the fifth sophomore to get the ball in game one in the last eight seasons. He also became the fifth consecutive righty to start on opening day following three years in a row of lefties getting the nod.
