- Oklahoma returns home to the friendly confines of L. Dale Mitchell Park this weekend for the first time since April 9, as the Sooners play host to Texas Tech for an important threegame Big 12 series. Game times are 6:30 p.m. Friday, 2 p.m. Saturday and 1 p.m. Sunday at Mitchell Park.
- OU leads the overall series against Texas Tech, including a 26-12-1 advantage in Norman.
- · Oklahoma is coming off an 11-game road swing with trips to Baylor, Oral Roberts, Minnesota, Wichita State and Kansas State. OU went 6-5 on the road swing, and is 13-10 overall in away games this season. The Sooners will play their next six games in the state of Oklahoma.

Leading Off

- Oklahoma is No. 36 in the most recent NCAA RPI rankings through May 1 games. The Sooners are 13-10 in road games and have 14 wins in 25 games against opponents in the top 100 of the RPI rankings. OU is one of six Big 12 schools in the RPI top 50, joining Texas Tech (13), West Virginia (15), Baylor, (23), Oklahoma State (24), and Texas (48). With Kansas State (76), TCU (87), and Kansas (89), every Big 12 school ranks in the top 90 of the RPI.
- · All nine of Oklahoma's remaining are against teams currently ranked in the top 50 of the NCAA RPI. Four of those remaining games will be play at OU's home ballpark, beginning this weekend against Texas Tech. Of its final 32 games of the regular season, 28 are against teams ranked in the top 100 of the RPI, including 18 against the RPI top 50.

HEAD COACH SKIP JOHNSON

In his two full seasons in Norman, Skip Johnson has made an immediate impact on the Oklahoma baseball program. He was named the 10th head coach in program history in June 2017 after serving one year as the Sooners' pitching coach.

The OU pitching staffs in Johnson's two seasons have posted two of the top five strikeout totals in program history and lowered the team ERA each season.

In 2018, Johnson coached OU to the program's 38th NCAA Regional appearance and posted the program's highest win total (38) since 2013. The Sooners reached the finals of the Tallahassee Regional, and set a school record with 608 strikeouts. Nine players were drafted, including five in the first 10 rounds.

In 2017, Oklahoma pitchers surrendered the fewest home runs in the Big 12 Conference in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. The Sooners' 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions.

Prior to coming to Oklahoma, Johnson spent a 25-year coaching career in the state of Texas, including the most recent 10 years as an assistant and associate head coach at the University of Texas.

Prior to his time in Austin, Johnson was the head coach for 13 years at Navarro College of the NJCAA's Texas Eastern Athletic Conference. From 1994-2006, he guided the Bulldogs to 13 NJCAA Regionals, nine TEAC championships and four regional titles while compiling 450 wins.

Johnson has also mentored a number of players outside of those he coached at Navarro and UT. Johnson regularly works with three-time Cy Young Award winner Clayton Kershaw of the Los Angeles Dodgers and Homer Bailey of the Kansas City Royals. He's also worked with Chris Davis of the Baltimore Orioles, among others.

A standout baseball player at Denton High School, Johnson began his collegiate playing career at Ranger (Texas) College. After a two-year career there, Johnson moved on to play baseball at the University of North Texas in 1988 before the school dropped its baseball program. He completed his collegiate playing career at UT-Pan American, lettering for the Broncs in 1989 and receiving his bachelor's degree in 1990. Johnson earned a master's degree in education from UT-Tyler in 1993.

A native of Denton, Texas, Johnson and his wife, Cathy, have two sons, Tyler and Garrett.

About the Sooners...

- OU is in its second year under the direction of head coach **Skip Johnson**. Johnson is 68-40 as OU head coach, and led the Sooners to an NCAA regional appearance last season.
- Oklahoma won its 2,600th game in program history on March 24. The Sooners are 2,609-1,512-12 (.633) all-time in their 119th season of competition.
- 0U has allowed three or fewer runs in 24 of 45 games this season, and allowed one or zero runs 13 times.
- OU ranks 13th nationally in ERA (3.31), 13th in double plays (41), 37th in triples (14), eighth in sacrifice bunts (40) and 21st in fielding percentage (.979). OU batters have drawn 230 walks, a total that ranks 29th nationally.
- OU leads the Big 12 in team ERA and fewest walks per nine innings (3.58), and ranks third in opponent batting average (.235). The Sooners lead the conference in runners picked off (seven), paced by a league-high five runners picked off by **Levi Prater**.
- OU is batting .268 as a team and averaging 5.7 runs per game, with 85 doubles, 14 triples and 20 home runs. The Sooners allow opponents 3.7 runs per game and a .235 batting average.
- The Sooners have a 3.31 team ERA with 388 strikeouts to 160 walks in 402.1 innings. The starting pitchers have a combined 3.06 ERA and have struck out 237 batters and allowed 218 hits in 246.2 innings.

OU Player Notes...

- Freshman **Jaret Godman** was superb in 7.1 innings over two relief appearances last week. He pitched 5.0 scoreless innings, striking out five batters and allowed a run on three hits and one walk to earn the win Tuesday at Wichita State. On Sunday at Kansas State, he held the Wildcats scoreless over 2.1 frames. In his last four outings, Godman has allowed one run over 12.0 innings, with nine strikeouts, two walks and seven hits allowed.
- Junior **Jason Ruffcorn** earned the win with 2.0 scoreless innings on Sunday at K-State. He is listed on the Stopper of the Year midseason update by the NCBWA, and ranks 11th nationally and first in the Big 12 with 10 saves. He also leads the league and ranks 13th nationally with 25 appearances.
- Freshman outfielder **Diego Muniz** hit his third home run of the season on Sunday in the 10th inning at K-State. His two-run homer gave OU a 5-3 lead on its way to a 6-3 win. He tallied three RBIs in the game, also knocking a run-scoring single as part of the three-run eighth inning rally. He collected four hits, four RBIs and scored two runs in the series last weekend.
- Sophomore outfielder **Tanner Tredaway** batted .538 (7-13) last week with three doubles, five RBIs and four runs scored, and also laid down three sacrifice bunts. He went 2-for-3 with two RBI doubles at Wichita State, then drove in a run each game at K-State, totaling five hits and four runs in the series. He singled in OU's first run Sunday, then singled ahead of Muniz's gamewinning home run.
- Junior outfielder **Brady Harlan** batted .400 (4-10) last week with two doubles, four walks, three RBIs and four runs scored. He was especially productive at Wichita State, going 2-for-5 with a double, three RBIs and two runs scored his second straight three-RBI contest. He also had two hits and scored a run in the series opener at K-State.
- Junior shortstop **Brandon Zaragoza** is on the watch list for the Brooks Wallace Award, given by the College Baseball Foundation to the nation's top shortstop, and is on a 12-game hitting streak and an 18-game reached base streak. He batted .400 at K-State last weekend, and went 2-for-5 on Sunday, walking to begin the eighth inning rally.
- Freshman **Wyatt Olds** ranks 13th nationally and is tied with Ruffcorn to lead the Big 12 with 25 appearances. He has pitched 20 scoreless outings in his 25 appearances this season, and struck out 33 batters in 23.1 innings.

About the Red Raiders...

- Texas Tech is in its seventh year under head coach Tim Tadlock, who has led the Red Raiders to a 269-146 record and three College World Series appearances. Tadlock was an assistant coach at Oklahoma from 2006-11.
- Texas Tech has won seven of its last 10 games, including its last two series against Baylor (2-1) and Oklahoma State (3-0). The Raiders split a midweek set against UT Rio Grande Valley, falling 6-3 and winning 19-11.
- TTU is hitting .306 as a team, and averaging 8.0 runs and 3.6 extra base hits per game. Brian Klein, who is one of seven Raiders hitting .300 or better with a .355 average, Josh Jung (.338, eight home runs, 14 doubles, 44 RBIs), Dylan Neuse (.335, eight home runs, six triples, 43 RBIs) and Cameron Warren (.325, 11 home runs, 12 doubles, 56 RBIs) lead the Raiders offensively.
- The Red Raiders pitching staff has a 4.16 team ERA and 392 strikeouts against 176 walks in 389.1 innings, and allow opponents to hit .260.

The OU and Texas Tech Series...

- Oklahoma and Texas Tech have played 87 times. OU leads the series, 48-38-1.
- In the last six years, dating to 2013, the Sooners and Red Raiders have won each series on their home field.
- OU has won each of the last eight series played in Norman, dating back to the 2003 season. The last series in Norman that TTU won was in 1999. In 2001, the teams split the first two games and the third contest ended in a tie.

Big 12 Honors...

- Tyler Hardman and Nathan Wiles were named the Big 12 Player of the Week and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, on Feb. 25. Levi Prater was the Pitcher of the Week on March 11. Jason Ruffcorn earned Newcomer of the Week honors on March 25.
- Hardman batted .429 with two home runs and a triple, driving in nine runs at the Tony Gwynn Legacy tournament in San Diego. His seventh-inning grand slam gave the Sooners the lead, and he added a two-run double in the ninth inning. He hit a three-run home run on Sunday against Cal State Fullerton.
- Wiles pitched 7.0 shutout innings in a 1-0 win at San Diego State Feb. 23. He allowed just four hits and tied a career high with 10 strikeouts.
- Prater pitched a career-long 8.0 scoreless innings, matching a career high with nine strikeouts and allowing just three hits and one walks in OU's 6-0 win at Rice on March 10.
- Ruffcorn appeared in all five games between March 19-24 and earned three saves, including the final two games of the series against Kansas.

Award Watch Lists

- Sophomore **Cade Cavalli** and freshman **Ben Abram** are on the midseason watch list for the National Pitcher of the Year award. Cavalli is also on the watch list for the John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year award, and shortstop **Brandon Zaragoza** is on the Brooks Wallace Award watch list, for the top shortstop in the nation. Junior **Jason Ruffcorn** was named on the Stopper of the Year midseason update.
- The John Olerud award, Brooks Wallace award and National Pitcher of the Year award are presented by the College Baseball Foundation and College Baseball Hall of Fame. The Stopper of the Year award is presented by the National College Baseball Writers Association.
- Senior **Brylie Ware** is a nominee for the Bobby Bragan Collegiate Slugger Award, which is open to all Division I baseball programs in Texas, Oklahoma, Arkansas, Louisiana and New Mexico. Ware

was also announced as a candidate for the Senior CLASS Award, which accounts for athletic performance, academics, character, community service and leadership.

Prater's 15 Strikeout Game

- Sophomore **Levi Prater** struck out a career-high 15 batters in 7.0 innings against Missouri State on March 17. He allowed one hit and one walk in seven innings. He struck out the side three times and twice struck out five in a row, including the final five batters of his outing.
- His 15 strikeouts tied for the fourth-most in school history. The last 0U pitcher to strike out 15 batters in a game was Jared Hoerman in 1999 against Central Oklahoma. Jackson Todd also struck out 15 batters in seven innings against LSU in 1972.

Replaced Production...

- Oklahoma replaced significant production both offensively and on the mound from 2018 for the 2019 season.
- Included were all three outfield positions held by juniors drafted in 2018, a four-year senior at second base and a total of eight pitchers.
- Oklahoma replaced 60 percent of its innings pitched (339 of 570), 67 percent of its starts (42 of 63), 61 percent of its strikeouts (370 of 608) and 63 percent of wins on the mound (24 of 38).
- Offensively, the Sooners replaced 56 percent of RBIs (197 of 354) and runs scored (215 of 386), 34 of their 47 home runs and 51 percent of hits (300 of 593).

The Newcomers...

- Oklahoma has 19 newcomers to its roster in 2019. Nine of those players are four-year or junior college transfers, and 10 are freshmen.
- OU is one of just 12 programs nationally with at least 10 freshmen on the roster, and one of 13 programs with 19 newcomers this season.
- The new class is versatile and athletic, and several players have the ability to play multiple positions on the field. The group is comprised of eight pitchers, seven players who can play infield, six who can play outfield and one who can catch.
- Two newcomers call Oklahoma home, eight come from Texas, two from California, and one each from Arkansas, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Minnesota, Nevada and Ontario.
- Of the transfers, three began their careers at four-year schools: **Brady Harlan** (Texas), **Jason Ruffcorn** (Texas A&M) and **Jordan Vujovich** (Oregon). Harlan and Ruffcorn transferred directly to OU, while Vujovich came via Delta College in California. Six others came to OU from junior colleges.

Two Former Sooners on 2019 MLB Opening Day Rosters...

- Two former Sooners were on Major League Baseball Opening Day rosters in 2019: Jon Gray with the Colorado Rockies and Chase Anderson with the Milwaukee Brewers.
- OU is one of six Big 12 programs with multiple alumni on big league rosters. A total of 15 Big 12 alumni were on Opening Day rosters, including a pair of Skip Johnson pupils in Brandon Workman and Corey Knebel from Texas.

Oklahoma is Home...

The OU roster features 11 players from within the state's borders and nine from Texas. This is the third straight year the Sooners have featured more homegrown players on the roster than from Texas. Prior to the 2017 season, 2006 was the last year OU had more homegrown talent than Texas born players with 13 Sooners claiming Oklahoma as home.
