- · Bedlam. Oklahoma and Oklahoma State have met more than 300 times on the diamond, and the in-state foes renew their annual rivalry played across the state this weekend.
- The Sooners and Cowboys face off at 7 p.m. Friday at ONEOK Field in Tulsa, 7 p.m. Saturday at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark in Oklahoma City, and conclude the Bedlam Series in Norman, with a 2 p.m. contest at L. Dale Mitchell Park.
- Sunday is Senior Day for three Sooners: Blake Brewster, Ryan Madden and Brylie Ware. The seniors will be honored in a pregame ceremony on the field.
- At 8-10 in Big 12 play, the Sooners are tied for fifth place in the league standings with six games to play. The Cowboys are 10-8 in the Big 12 and in third place in the standings.
- OSU leads the overall series against OU, 164-142.

- The games will air on Sportstalk 1400 AM/99.3 FM and the Sooner Sports Network with Toby Rowland and Ross Hubbard on the call.
- The games on Friday and Saturday in Tulsa and Oklahoma City will be live streamed via SoonerSports.tv.

Leading Off

- Oklahoma is No. 43 in the most recent NCAA RPI rankings through May 8 games. The Sooners are 13-10 in road games and have 14 wins in 28 games against opponents in the top 100 of the RPI rankings. OU is one of five Big 12 schools in the RPI top 50, joining Texas Tech (8), West Virginia (15). Oklahoma State (11), West Virginia (15) and Baylor (27). With Texas (54), Kansas State (71), TCU (73), and Kansas (78), every Big 12 school ranks in the top 80 of the RPI.
- All six of Oklahoma's remaining are against teams currently ranked in the top 100 of the NCAA RPI. Only Sunday's game will be played at OU's home ballpark, while two will be at neutral sites with OU as the home team and three will be on the road. Of its final 32 games of the regular season, 28 are against teams ranked in the top 100 of the RPI, including 13 against the RPI top 50.

HEAD COACH SKIP JOHNSON

In his two full seasons in Norman, Skip Johnson has made an immediate impact on the Oklahoma baseball program. He was named the 10th head coach in program history in June 2017 after serving one year as the Sooners' pitching coach.

The OU pitching staffs in Johnson's two seasons have posted two of the top five strikeout totals in program history and lowered the team ERA each season.

In 2018, Johnson coached OU to the program's 38th NCAA Regional appearance and posted the program's highest win total (38) since 2013. The Sooners reached the finals of the Tallahassee Regional, and set a school record with 608 strikeouts. Nine players were drafted, including five in the first 10 rounds.

In 2017, Oklahoma pitchers surrendered the fewest home runs in the Big 12 Conference in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. The Sooners' 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions.

Prior to coming to Oklahoma, Johnson spent a 25-year coaching career in the state of Texas, including the most recent 10 years as an assistant and associate head coach at the University of Texas.

Prior to his time in Austin, Johnson was the head coach for 13 years at Navarro College of the NJCAA's Texas Eastern Athletic Conference. From 1994-2006, he guided the Bulldogs to 13 NJCAA Regionals, nine TEAC championships and four regional titles while compiling 450 wins.

Johnson has also mentored a number of players outside of those he coached at Navarro and UT. Johnson regularly works with three-time Cy Young Award winner Clayton Kershaw of the Los Angeles Dodgers and Homer Bailey of the Kansas City Royals. He's also worked with Chris Davis of the Baltimore Orioles, among others.

A standout baseball player at Denton High School, Johnson began his collegiate playing career at Ranger (Texas) College. After a two-year career there, Johnson moved on to play baseball at the University of North Texas in 1988 before the school dropped its baseball program. He completed his collegiate playing career at UT-Pan American, lettering for the Broncs in 1989 and receiving his bachelor's degree in 1990. Johnson earned a master's degree in education from UT-Tyler in 1993.

A native of Denton, Texas, Johnson and his wife, Cathy, have two sons, Tyler and Garrett.

About the Sooners...

- OU is in its second year under the direction of head coach **Skip Johnson**. Johnson is 68-43 as OU head coach, and led the Sooners to an NCAA regional appearance last season.
- Oklahoma won its 2,600th game in program history on March 24. The Sooners are 2,609-1,515-12 (.632) all-time in their 119th season of competition.
- OU has allowed three or fewer runs in 24 of 48 games this season, and allowed one or zero runs 13 times.
- OU ranks 24th nationally in ERA (3.58), 20th in double plays (43), 55th in triples (14), ninth in sacrifice bunts (41) and 19th in fielding percentage (.979). OU batters have drawn 251 walks, a total that ranks 27th nationally.
- OU leads the Big 12 in team ERA and fewest walks per nine innings (3.73), and ranks fourth in opponent batting average (.242). The Sooners lead the conference in runners picked off (seven), paced by a league-high five runners picked off by **Levi Prater**.
- OU is batting .267 as a team and averaging 5.6 runs per game, with 87 doubles, 14 triples and 22 home runs. The Sooners allow opponents 4.0 runs per game and a .242 batting average.
- The Sooners have a 3.58 team ERA with 412 strikeouts to 178 walks in 429.1 innings.

OU Player Notes...

- Senior third baseman **Brylie Ware** has totaled 185 hits, 103 RBIs and 100 runs scored in his three-year career at 0U. He is the 41st player in Oklahoma baseball history to total at least 100 hits, 100 RBIs and 100 runs scored in his career. Ware is a career .300 hitter at 0U with 10 home runs and 40 doubles. His 40 doubles rank 21st in program history.
- Junior catcher **Brady Lindsly** leads OU with 16 RBIs and seven extra base hits during Big 12 play. He hit .462 (6-13) with two home runs, six RBIs, three runs scored and a 1.423 OPS last week against Texas Tech. He hit two-run home runs on Friday and Saturday, and added a two-run single on Friday.
- Sophomore outfielder **Tanner Tredaway** leads the Sooners with a .333 batting average in Big 12 play. He has hit safely in seven of his last 10 games, and is hitting .382 (13-34) with three doubles, five RBIs and six runs scored in his last 10 contests. He hit .364 (4-11) and scored three runs last week against Texas Tech.
- Sophomore **Levi Prater** allowed one run on three hits over 6.0 innings last Saturday. It was his eighth time in 12 starts this season to last at least 6.0 innings (and fourth in a row), and the sixth time he has allowed one run or fewer. It was also the eighth time he has averaged at least one strikeout per inning in a start this season. He is averaging 10.9 K/9 IP this season, best among OU starters.
- Junior shortstop **Brandon Zaragoza** is on the watch list for the Brooks Wallace Award, given by the College Baseball Foundation to the nation's top shortstop. He has reached base safely in 21 consecutive games. He is batting .295 (23-78) in that span with 11 runs scored, eight RBIs and 12 walks in that span.
- Sophomore first baseman **Tyler Hardman** has reached base safely in 20 straight games and hit safely in his last four contests.
- Junior **Jason Ruffcorn** is listed on the Stopper of the Year midseason update by the NCBWA, and ranks 21st nationally and first in the Big 12 with 10 saves. He also leads the league and ranks 12th nationally with 27 appearances.

About the Cowboys...

- Oklahoma State is in its seventh year under head coach Josh Holliday, who has led the Cowboys to a 259-148-1 record.
- The Cowboys have won seven of its last 10 games, including a road sweep at Oregon State last weekend.
- OSU is hitting .275 as a team, and averaging 6.6 runs and 3.5 extra base hits per game. Carson McCusker leads the team with a .328 batting average and 14 doubles. Trevor Boone has a team-high 16 home runs and 42 RBIs.
- The Cowboys pitching staff has a 4.13 team ERA and 379 strikeouts against 194 walks in 390.1 innings, and allows opponents to hit .251.

The OU and OSU Series...

- Oklahoma and Oklahoma State have played 306 times. The Cowboys lead the overall series, 164-142 and have won eight straight meetings.
- OSU won 6-5 back on March 26 in Stillwater, and four meetings last season, 7-1 (Norman), 8-0 (Stillwater), and 10-1 and 9-2
- OU last defeated OSU in 2016 with a 3-1 victory in Tulsa.
- The series dates back to 1942.

Bia 12 Honors...

- Tyler Hardman and Nathan Wiles were named the Big 12 Player of the Week and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, on Feb. 25. Levi Prater was the Pitcher of the Week on March 11. Jason **Ruffcorn** earned Newcomer of the Week honors on March 25.
- Hardman batted .429 with two home runs and a triple, driving in nine runs at the Tony Gwynn Legacy tournament in San Diego. His seventh-inning grand slam gave the Sooners the lead, and he added a two-run double in the ninth inning. He hit a three-run home run on Sunday against Cal State Fullerton.
- Wiles pitched 7.0 shutout innings in a 1-0 win at San Diego State Feb. 23. He allowed just four hits and tied a career high with
- Prater pitched a career-long 8.0 scoreless innings, matching a career high with nine strikeouts and allowing just three hits and one walks in OU's 6-0 win at Rice on March 10.
- · Ruffcorn appeared in all five games between March 19-24 and earned three saves, including the final two games of the series against Kansas.

Award Watch Lists

- Sophomore Cade Cavalli and freshman Ben Abram are on the midseason watch list for the National Pitcher of the Year award. Cavalli is also on the watch list for the John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year award, and shortstop **Brandon Zaragoza** is on the Brooks Wallace Award watch list, for the top shortstop in the nation. Junior **Jason Ruffcorn** was named on the Stopper of the Year midseason update.
- · The John Olerud award, Brooks Wallace award and National Pitcher of the Year award are presented by the College Baseball Foundation and College Baseball Hall of Fame. The Stopper of the Year award is presented by the National College Baseball Writers Association.
- Senior Brylie Ware is a nominee for the Bobby Bragan Collegiate Slugger Award, which is open to all Division I baseball programs in Texas, Oklahoma, Arkansas, Louisiana and New Mexico. Ware was also announced as a candidate for the Senior CLASS Award. which accounts for athletic performance, academics, character, community service and leadership.

Prater's 15 Strikeout Game

- · Sophomore Levi Prater struck out a career-high 15 batters in 7.0 innings against Missouri State on March 17. He allowed one hit and one walk in seven innings. He struck out the side three times and twice struck out five in a row, including the final five batters of his outing.
- · His 15 strikeouts tied for the fourth-most in school history. The last OU pitcher to strike out 15 batters in a game was Jared Hoerman in 1999 against Central Oklahoma. Jackson Todd also struck out 15 batters in seven innings against LSU in 1972.

Replaced Production...

 Oklahoma replaced significant production both offensively and on the mound from 2018 for the 2019 season.

- Included were all three outfield positions held by juniors drafted in 2018, a four-year senior at second base and a total of eight
- Oklahoma replaced 60 percent of its innings pitched (339 of 570), 67 percent of its starts (42 of 63), 61 percent of its strikeouts (370 of 608) and 63 percent of wins on the mound (24 of 38).
- Offensively, the Sooners replaced 56 percent of RBIs (197 of 354) and runs scored (215 of 386), 34 of their 47 home runs and 51 percent of hits (300 of 593).

The Newcomers...

- Oklahoma has 19 newcomers to its roster in 2019. Nine of those players are four-year or junior college transfers, and 10 are freshmen.
- OU is one of just 12 programs nationally with at least 10 freshmen on the roster, and one of 13 programs with 19 newcomers this season.
- The new class is versatile and athletic, and several players have the ability to play multiple positions on the field. The group is comprised of eight pitchers, seven players who can play infield, six who can play outfield and one who can catch.
- Two newcomers call Oklahoma home, eight come from Texas, two from California, and one each from Arkansas, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Minnesota, Nevada and Ontario.
- Of the transfers, three began their careers at four-year schools: Brady Harlan (Texas), Jason Ruffcorn (Texas A&M) and Jordan Vujovich (Oregon). Harlan and Ruffcorn transferred directly to OU, while Vujovich came via Delta College in California. Six others came to OU from junior colleges.

Two Former Sooners on 2019 MLB Opening Day Rosters...

- · Two former Sooners were on Major League Baseball Opening Day rosters in 2019: Jon Gray with the Colorado Rockies and Chase Anderson with the Milwaukee Brewers.
- OU is one of six Big 12 programs with multiple alumni on big league rosters. A total of 15 Big 12 alumni were on Opening Day rosters, including a pair of Skip Johnson pupils in Brandon Workman and Corey Knebel from Texas.

Oklahoma is Home...

The OU roster features 11 players from within the state's borders and nine from Texas. This is the third straight year the Sooners have featured more homegrown players on the roster than from Texas. Prior to the 2017 season, 2006 was the last year OU had more homegrown talent than Texas born players with 13 Sooners claiming Oklahoma as home.

Season Openers...

Since 1962, Oklahoma is 39-19 on opening day and 26-3 when playing the first game of the season at home, including 25-2 at L. Dale Mitchell Park, All-time in home openers, the Sooners are 51-6 going back to 1962, including 35-2 at Mitchell Park.

Opening Day Starters...

Right-hander **Cade Cavalli** started on the mound for the Sooners on opening day. He became the fifth sophomore to get the ball in game one in the last eight seasons. He also became the fifth consecutive righty to start on opening day following three years in a row of lefties getting the nod.
