- Oklahoma is No. 44 in the most recent NCAA RPI rankings through May 14 games. The Sooners are 13-10 in road games and have 16 wins in 31 games against opponents in the top 100 of the RPI rankings. OU is one of five Big 12 schools in the RPI top 50, joining Texas Tech (9), Oklahoma State (11), West Virginia (18), and Baylor (27). With Texas (54), Kansas State (73), Kansas (75) and TCU (77), every Big 12 school ranks in the top 80 of the RPI.
- Of Oklahoma's final 32 regular season games, 29 will have come against opponents ranked in the top 100 of the RPI, including 12 against the RPI top 50. Only 12 of those contests were played at home while 18 will have been on the road and two played at neutral sites.

HEAD COACH SKIP JOHNSON

In his two full seasons in Norman, Skip Johnson has made an immediate impact on the Oklahoma baseball program. He was named the 10th head coach in program history in June 2017 after serving one year as the Sooners' pitching coach.

The OU pitching staffs in Johnson's two seasons have posted two of the top five strikeout totals in program history and lowered the team ERA each season.

In 2018, Johnson coached OU to the program's 38th NCAA Regional appearance and posted the program's highest win total (38) since 2013. The Sooners reached the finals of the Tallahassee Regional, and set a school record with 608 strikeouts. Nine players were drafted, including five in the first 10 rounds.

In 2017, Oklahoma pitchers surrendered the fewest home runs in the Big 12 Conference in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. The Sooners' 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions.

Prior to coming to Oklahoma, Johnson spent a 25-year coaching career in the state of Texas, including the most recent 10 years as an assistant and associate head coach at the University of Texas.

Prior to his time in Austin, Johnson was the head coach for 13 years at Navarro College of the NJCAA's Texas Eastern Athletic Conference. From 1994-2006, he guided the Bulldogs to 13 NJCAA Regionals, nine TEAC championships and four regional titles while compiling 450 wins.

Johnson has also mentored a number of players outside of those he coached at Navarro and UT. Johnson regularly works with three-time Cy Young Award winner Clayton Kershaw of the Los Angeles Dodgers and Homer Bailey of the Kansas City Royals. He's also worked with Chris Davis of the Baltimore Orioles, among others.

A standout baseball player at Denton High School, Johnson began his collegiate playing career at Ranger (Texas) College. After a two-year career there, Johnson moved on to play baseball at the University of North Texas in 1988 before the school dropped its baseball program. He completed his collegiate playing career at UT-Pan American, lettering for the Broncs in 1989 and receiving his bachelor's degree in 1990. Johnson earned a master's degree in education from UT-Tyler in 1993.

A native of Denton, Texas, Johnson and his wife, Cathy, have two sons, Tyler and Garrett.

About the Sooners...

- OU is in its second year under the direction of head coach **Skip Johnson**. Johnson is 69-45 as OU head coach, and led the Sooners to an NCAA regional appearance last season.
- Oklahoma won its 2,600th game in program history on March 24. The Sooners are 2,610-1,517-12 (.632) all-time in their 119th season of competition.
- OU has allowed three or fewer runs in 25 of 51 games this season, and allowed one or zero runs 13 times.
- OU ranks 31st nationally in ERA (3.68), eighth in double plays (50), 10th in sacrifice bunts (42), 30th in sacrifice flies (28) and 18th in fielding percentage (.979). OU batters have drawn 259 walks, a total that ranks 34th nationally.
- OU leads ranks second in the Big 12 in fewest walks per nine innings (3.74) and third in ERA (3.68). The Sooners lead the conference in runners picked off (seven), paced by a league-high five runners picked off by **Levi Prater**.
- OU is batting .264 as a team and averaging 5.5 runs per game, with 90 doubles, 14 triples and 23 home runs. The Sooners allow opponents 4.1 runs per game and a .242 batting average.
- The Sooners have a 3.68 team ERA with 444 strikeouts to 190 walks in 457.1 innings.

OU Player Notes...

- Sophomore **Levi Prater** was honored as part of the 2019 class of <u>Wilma Rudolph Student-Athlete Achievement Award</u> winners by the National Association of Academic and Student-Athlete Development Professionals (N4A), honoring student-athletes who have overcome great personal, academic and/or emotional odds to achieve academic success while participating in intercollegiate athletics. He leads the team with 90 strikeouts and a .207 opponent batting average and is second with 73.2 innings pitched. He has pitched at least six innings in eight starts and has allowed one run or fewer six times this season.
- Senior third baseman **Brylie Ware** needs just 11 hits to top the 200-hit plateau in his three-year OU career. He is the 41st Sooner to total 100 hits, 100 RBIs and 100 runs in his career. He led the team with a .333 batting average last week, and has hit safely in five consecutive games.
- Freshman **Jaret Godman** was outstanding in relief Saturday night, striking out seven batters over 4.2 innings and retiring 10 of his final 11 batters faced in the outing. In his last seven appearances, he has posted a 1.86 ERA and struck out 19 batters in 19.1 innings, allowing just four runs, six walks, 13 hits (0.98 WHIP) and a .191 opponent batting average. He also earned the victory in 5.0 innings at Wichita State.
- Sophomore **Cade Cavalli** was excellent in his first start since April 19 on Saturday night. He struck out five batters and allowed no hits and three walks in 3.0 scoreless innings before he reached his pitch limit for the outing. Cavalli, an All-America candidate and on the watch list for the John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year award, is 5-2 with a 2.93 ERA in 11 starts and 55.1 innings this season on the mound. At the plate he has compiled a .319 batting average with 11 extra base hits, 17 RBIs and 16 runs scored in 24 games.
- Sophomore catcher **Justin Mitchell** provided the game-winning hit in the bottom of the 10th inning Saturday night, singling home sophomore outfielder **Tanner Tredaway**. It was OU's second walkoff hit of the season (April 5 vs. TCU) and second extra-inning victory (April 28 at Kansas State). The Sooners are 2-2 in extra frames this season and have won each of the last two games that went past nine innings.
- Tredaway leads OU in Big 12 play with a .327 batting average, 12 runs scored and a .431 on-base percentage. He has recorded a hit in 12 of 16 Big 12 starts and reached base in 14 of 18 Big 12 contests in which he has played.
- Junior catcher **Brady Lindsly** leads OU with 16 RBIs, 24 hits and eight extra base hits during Big 12 play. He has hit .286 and leads OU with 24 hits in conference games. Overall, he leads the team with four triples and is second with four home runs.

- Junior shortstop **Brandon Zaragoza** is on the watch list for the Brooks Wallace Award, given by the College Baseball Foundation to the nation's top shortstop. He has reached base safely in 23 of his last 24 games.
- Junior Jason Ruffcorn is listed on the Stopper of the Year midseason update by the NCBWA, and ranks 24th nationally and first in the Big 12 with 10 saves. He also leads the league and ranks 27th nationally with 28 appearances.

About the Longhorns...

- Texas is in its third year under head coach David Pierce, who has led the Longhorns to a 107-72 record.
- The Longhorns are hitting .250 as a team, and averaging 5.5 runs and 2.1 extra base hits per game. Eric Kennedy leads the team with a .310 batting average and 38 runs scored while Austin Todd has a team-high 37 RBIs, 10 doubles and 35 runs scored.
- The Texas pitching staff has a 4.23 team ERA and 415 strikeouts against 235 walks in 444.2 innings, and allows opponents to hit .239.

Big 12 Honors...

- Tyler Hardman and Nathan Wiles were named the Big 12 Player of the Week and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, on Feb. 25. Levi Prater was the Pitcher of the Week on March 11. Jason Ruffcorn earned Newcomer of the Week honors on March 25.
- Hardman batted .429 with two home runs and a triple, driving in nine runs at the Tony Gwynn Legacy tournament in San Diego. His seventh-inning grand slam gave the Sooners the lead, and he added a two-run double in the ninth inning. He hit a three-run home run on Sunday against Cal State Fullerton.
- Wiles pitched 7.0 shutout innings in a 1-0 win at San Diego State Feb. 23. He allowed just four hits and tied a career high with 10 strikeouts
- Prater pitched a career-long 8.0 scoreless innings, matching a career high with nine strikeouts and allowing just three hits and one walks in OU's 6-0 win at Rice on March 10.
- Ruffcorn appeared in all five games between March 19-24 and earned three saves, including the final two games of the series against Kansas.

Award Watch Lists

- Sophomore **Cade Cavalli** and freshman **Ben Abram** are on the midseason watch list for the National Pitcher of the Year award. Cavalli is also on the watch list for the John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year award, and shortstop **Brandon Zaragoza** is on the Brooks Wallace Award watch list, for the top shortstop in the nation. Junior **Jason Ruffcorn** was named on the Stopper of the Year midseason undate
- The John Olerud award, Brooks Wallace award and National Pitcher of the Year award are presented by the College Baseball Foundation and College Baseball Hall of Fame. The Stopper of the Year award is presented by the National College Baseball Writers Association.
- Senior Brylie Ware is a nominee for the Bobby Bragan Collegiate Slugger Award, which is open to all Division I baseball programs in Texas, Oklahoma, Arkansas, Louisiana and New Mexico. Ware was also announced as a candidate for the Senior CLASS Award, which accounts for athletic performance, academics, character, community service and leadership.

Prater's 15 Strikeout Game

- Sophomore **Levi Prater** struck out a career-high 15 batters in 7.0 innings against Missouri State on March 17. He allowed one hit and one walk in seven innings. He struck out the side three times and twice struck out five in a row, including the final five batters of his outing.
- His 15 strikeouts tied for the fourth-most in school history. The last OU pitcher to strike out 15 batters in a game was Jared Hoerman in 1999 against Central Oklahoma. Jackson Todd also struck out 15 batters in seven innings against LSU in 1972.

Replaced Production...

- Oklahoma replaced significant production both offensively and on the mound from 2018 for the 2019 season.
- Included were all three outfield positions held by juniors drafted in 2018, a four-year senior at second base and a total of eight pitchers.
- Oklahoma replaced 60 percent of its innings pitched (339 of 570), 67 percent of its starts (42 of 63), 61 percent of its strikeouts (370 of 608) and 63 percent of wins on the mound (24 of 38).
- Offensively, the Sooners replaced 56 percent of RBIs (197 of 354) and runs scored (215 of 386), 34 of their 47 home runs and 51 percent of hits (300 of 593).

The Newcomers...

- Oklahoma has 19 newcomers to its roster in 2019. Nine of those players are four-year or junior college transfers, and 10 are freshmen.
- OU is one of just 12 programs nationally with at least 10 freshmen on the roster, and one of 13 programs with 19 newcomers this season
- The new class is versatile and athletic, and several players have the ability to play multiple positions on the field. The group is comprised of eight pitchers, seven players who can play infield, six who can play outfield and one who can catch.
- Two newcomers call Oklahoma home, eight come from Texas, two from California, and one each from Arkansas, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Minnesota. Nevada and Ontario.
- Of the transfers, three began their careers at four-year schools:
 Brady Harlan (Texas), Jason Ruffcorn (Texas A&M) and Jordan Vujovich (Oregon). Harlan and Ruffcorn transferred directly to OU, while Vujovich came via Delta College in California. Six others came to OU from junior colleges.

Two Former Sooners on 2019 MLB Opening Day Rosters...

- Two former Sooners were on Major League Baseball Opening Day rosters in 2019: Jon Gray with the Colorado Rockies and Chase Anderson with the Milwaukee Brewers.
- OU is one of six Big 12 programs with multiple alumni on big league rosters. A total of 15 Big 12 alumni were on Opening Day rosters, including a pair of Skip Johnson pupils in Brandon Workman and Corev Knebel from Texas.

Oklahoma is Home...

The OU roster features 11 players from within the state's borders and nine from Texas. This is the third straight year the Sooners have featured more homegrown players on the roster than from Texas. Prior to the 2017 season, 2006 was the last year OU had more homegrown talent than Texas born players with 13 Sooners claiming Oklahoma as home.

Season Openers...

Since 1962, Oklahoma is 39-19 on opening day and 26-3 when playing the first game of the season at home, including 25-2 at L. Dale Mitchell Park. All-time in home openers, the Sooners are 51-6 going back to 1962, including 35-2 at Mitchell Park.

Opening Day Starters...

Right-hander **Cade Cavalli** started on the mound for the Sooners on opening day. He became the fifth sophomore to get the ball in game one in the last eight seasons. He also became the fifth consecutive righty to start on opening day following three years in a row of lefties getting the nod.
